

Tigray, Ethiopia: Partners Response Dashboard

January-December 2023

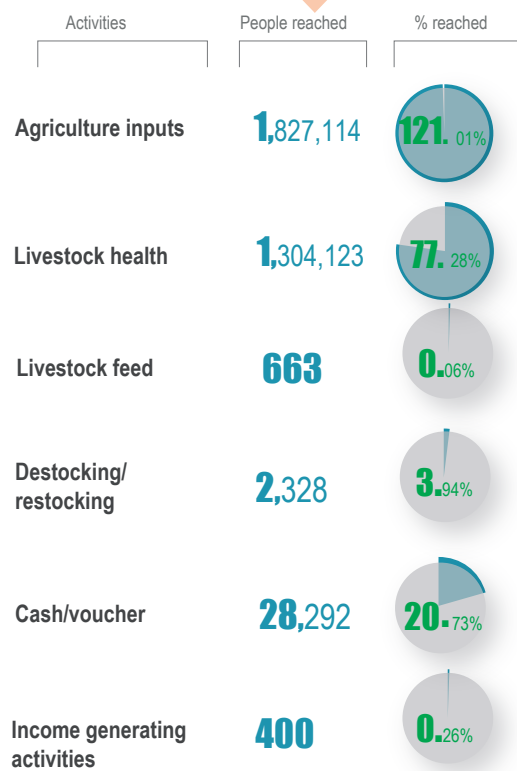


Agriculture sector is the main source of livelihoods for Tigray region and key for rebuilding lives and livelihoods of conflict-affected population. Following the peace agreement, about **1.2 million** people have returned to their areas of origin and are in urgent need of livelihood support. The DRM-ATF partners have continued to assist the vulnerable farmers with appropriate agricultural inputs (crop kits, tools, fertilizers, and draught power) to produce adequate food that will last their families for **12 months** after the harvest. The DRM-ATF and Bureau of Agriculture have reached **1.6 million** people in the period January 2023 to July 2023. The main season response has been affected by several challenges including shortage of improved seeds (only **12%** received), shortage of fertilizers (**18%** delivered), migratory pests and drier than usual conditions in the Eastern and Southern part of the region. These challenges will most likely negatively affect the total production and productivity. A large proportion of the response (over **60%** percent) has been delivered to the Southern and Eastern part of the region while huge gaps still exist in the Northwest and Central parts of the Region. Livestock diseases including zoonotic diseases continue to be reported in the region.

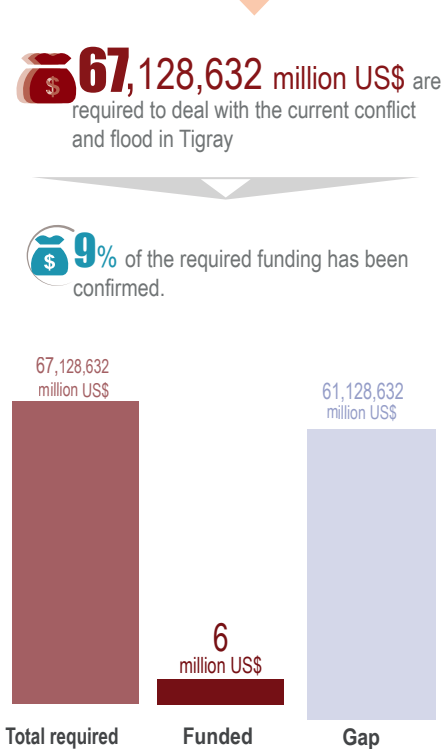

People Reached: **3,134,458**

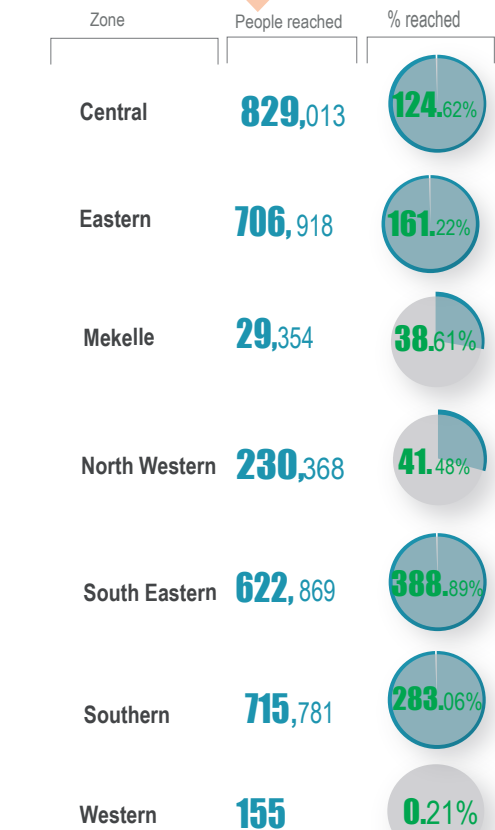
People Reached by Activities



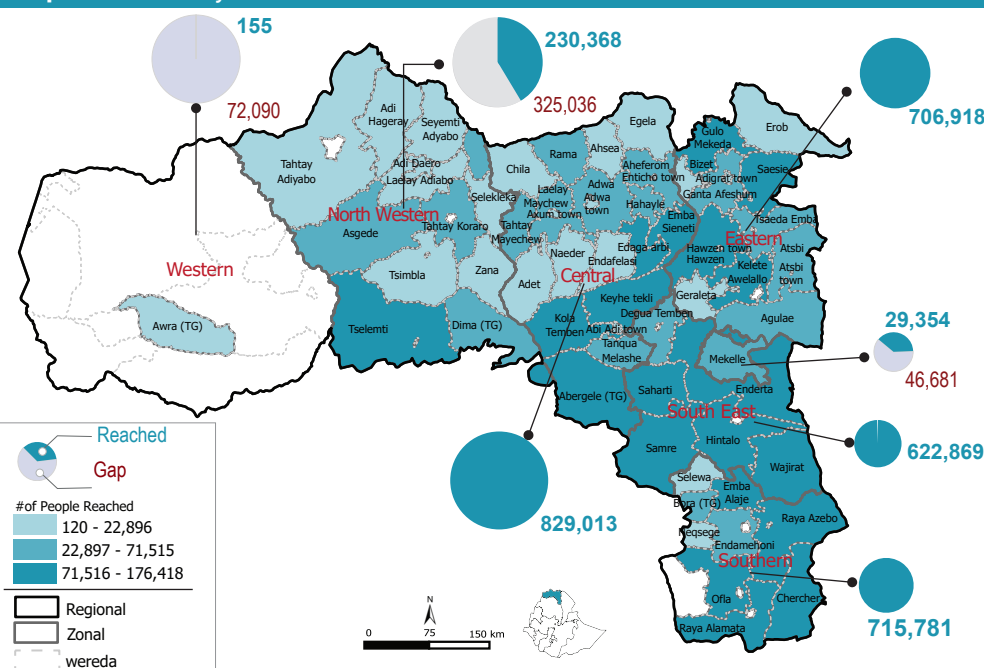
Total Funding Required
