3. AA & Food Security



- **gFSC Strategic Plan for 2023-2025** endorsed
 - outlines **priority pillars**, which cluster partners will be leading over the next three years, at local, regional, and global levels
 - dedicated **Anticipatory Action pillar** (as well as Localization, HDP Nexus, Communication / Advocacy and a section for cross-cutting themes)
- **Anticipating Food Crisis – Workshop Outcomes** (June 2023)
 - Outlines **common principles** to address four challenges relating to Anticipatory Action looking at Evidence, Acute Food Insecurity Projections, Protracted Crises and the HDP Nexus.
- **Joint FAO-WFP Anticipatory Action Strategy** (September 2023)
 - Outlines **collaboration** and **comparative advantages** aiming for a more structured, systematic and strategic approach to joint Anticipatory Action between the two agencies

2. Definition & Core Components of AA



“Anticipatory action is defined as **acting ahead of predicted hazards to prevent or reduce acute humanitarian impacts** before they fully unfold ”



3. Working Group ToR (1)



- Creation of a Technical WG on AA - September 2023
- 3 chairs: 2 UN agencies (FAO & WFP) & one NGO (elected)
- [Webpage](#) - dedicated space for the AA working group
- **Why a working group:** facilitate and support AA in the food security sector in close coordination with other clusters and platforms.
- **What it is:** a platform for members to discuss about AA in food security crisis, share technical guidelines to improve the quality and timeliness of AA, implement the recommendations from global discussions and provide technical support to each other.

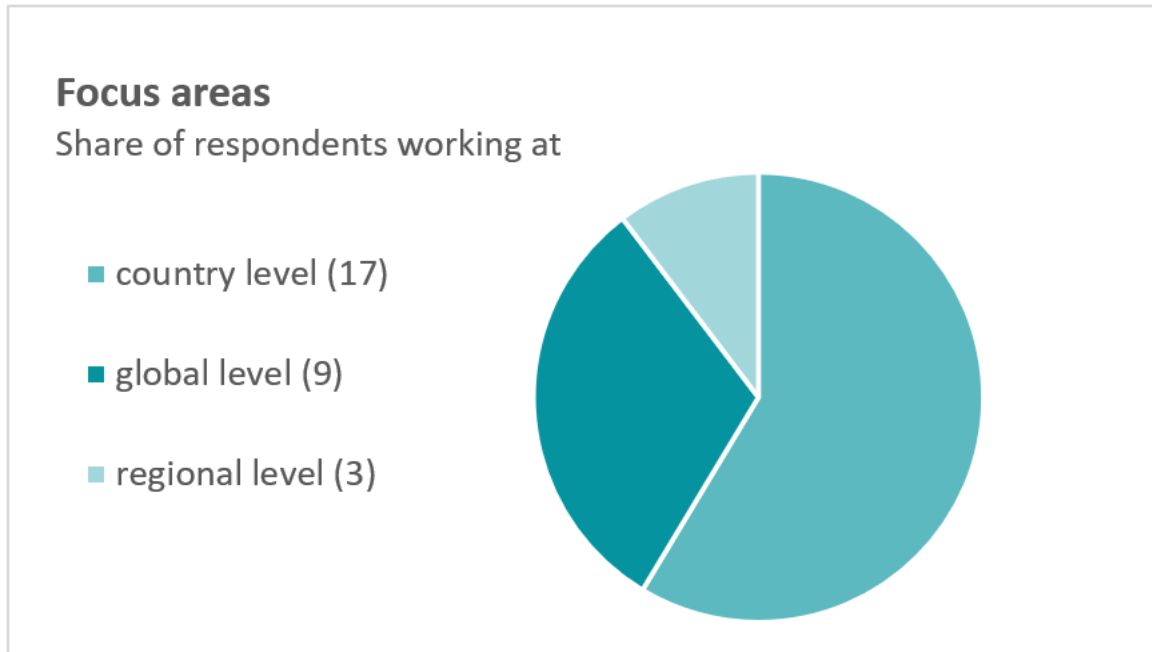
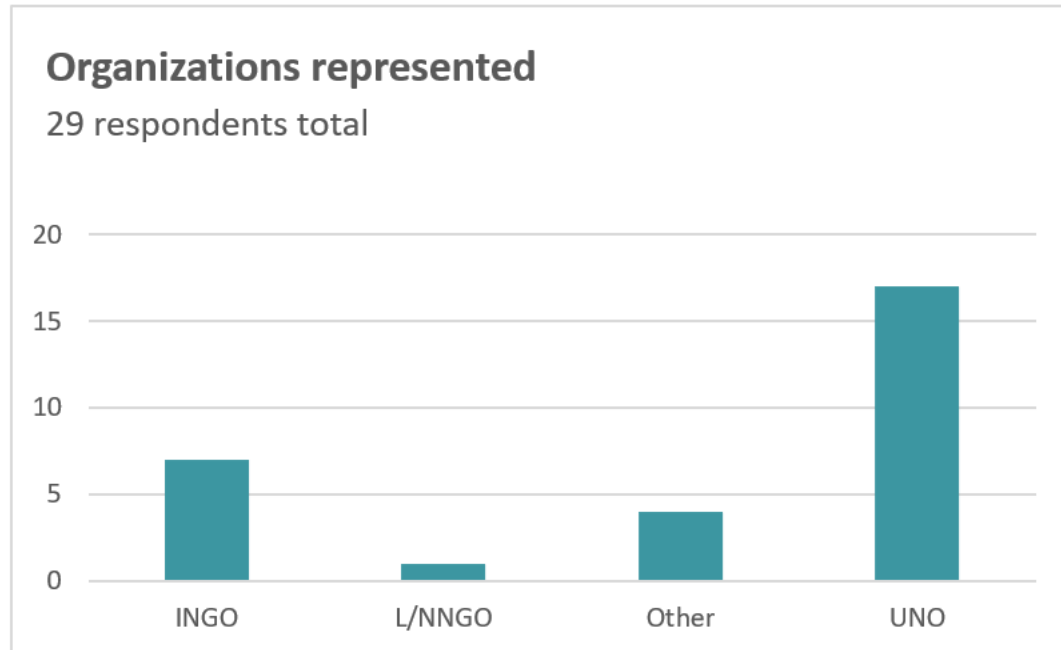
3 Objectives

- ✓ **Objective 1:** To support alignment of AA operational approaches as well as guiding principles to address the complexity of food crises through coordinated anticipatory action.
- ✓ **Objective 2:** To provide technical Support and Capacity Building to FSC members, country FSC and to all FSC stakeholders to engage in AA planning and implementation together with broader HCT, including mainstreaming in HRPs and associated financing.
- ✓ **Objective 3:** To support the FSCs to ensure accountability of food-security related AA at country level.

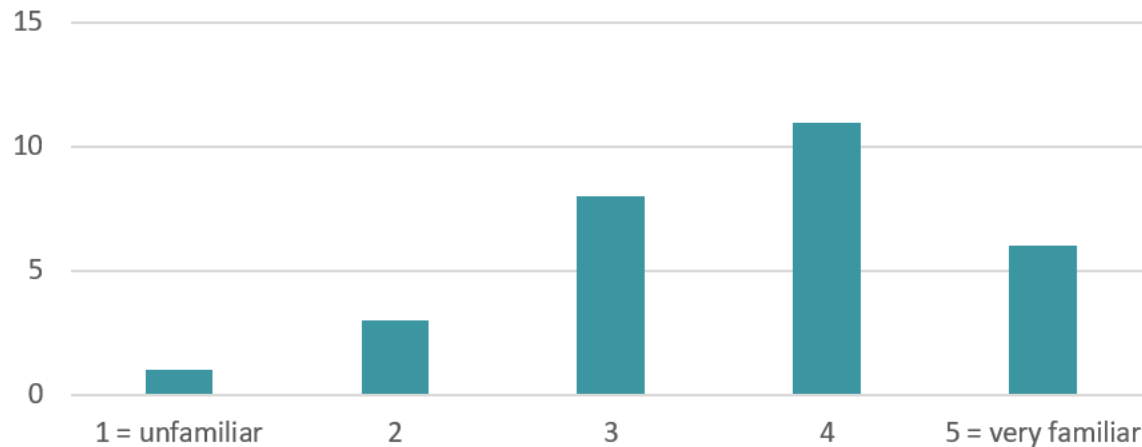


Exposure to (involvement in) AA (programming)

Self-assessment:

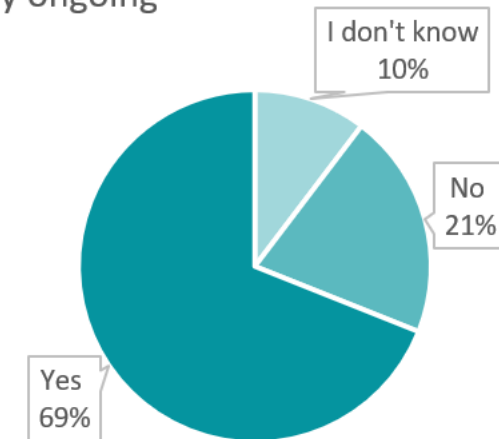
Already relatively high degree of familiarity with AA concept

AA work already ongoing?

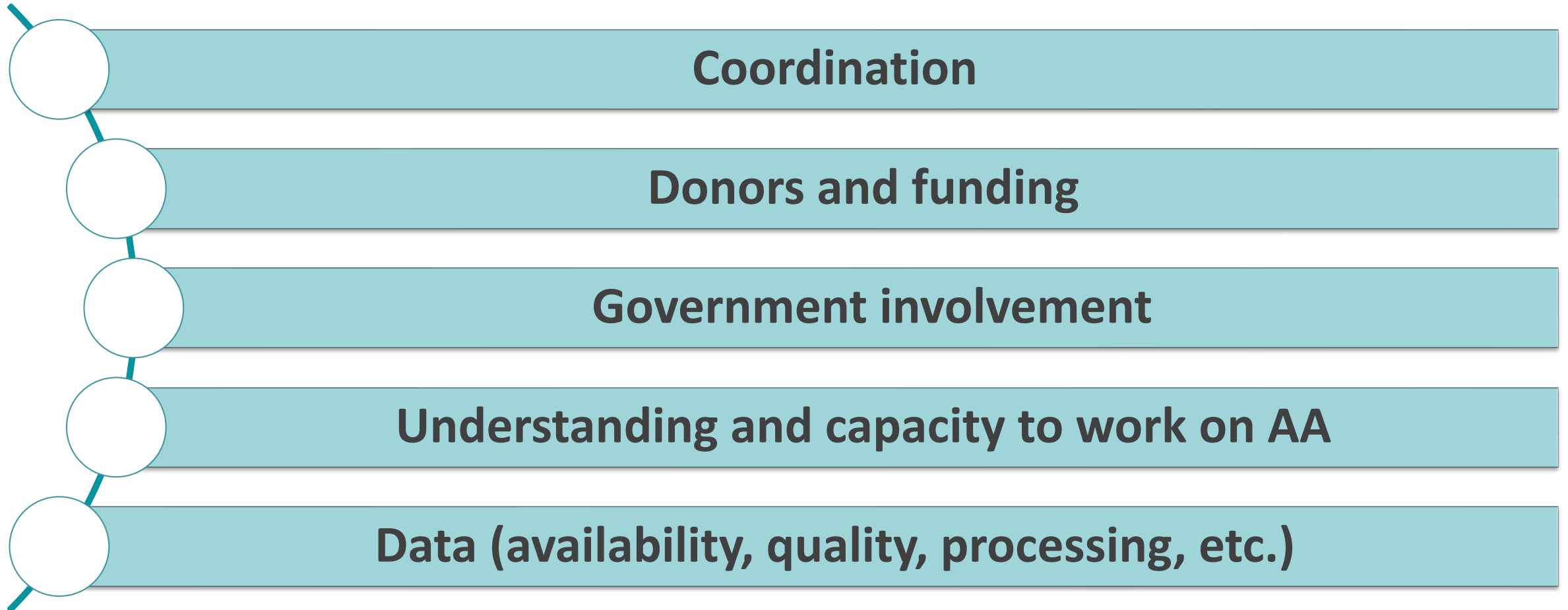
In most of the countries that respondents cover AA work is already ongoing
