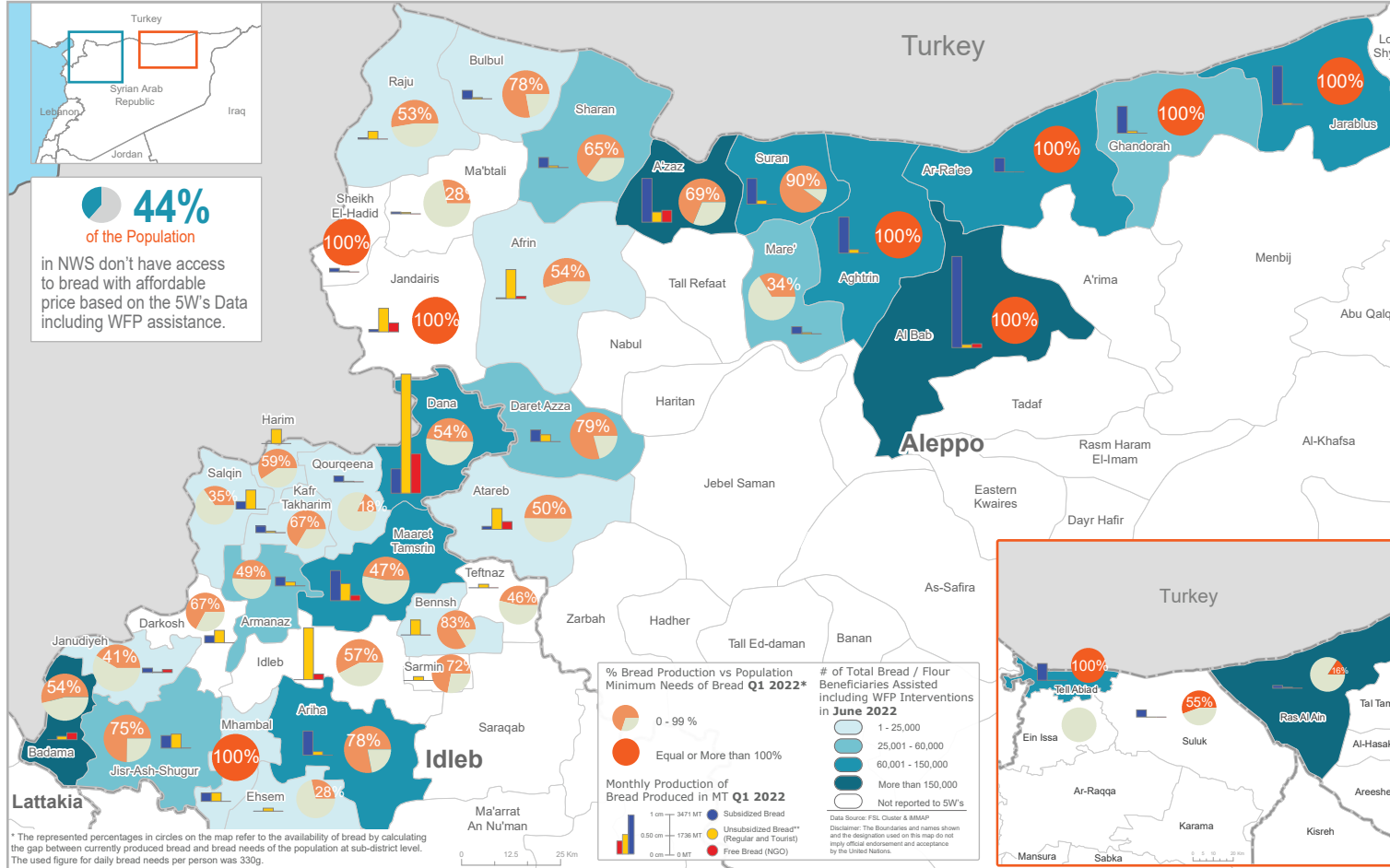

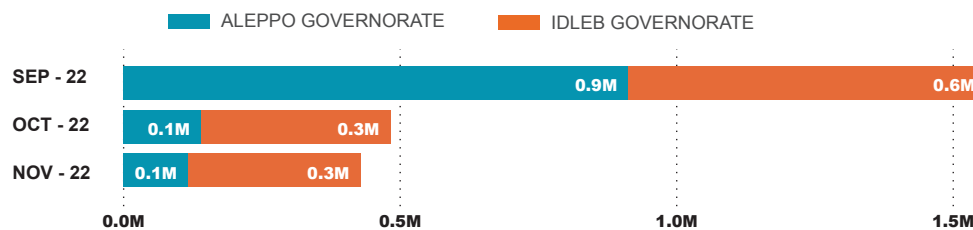

SITUATION UPDATE

- **2.5M** people received bread from **24 FSL partners** in NW Syria, including **WFP partners** in **June 2022**. Compared to the previous report, the geographical coverage shrunk with 3 sub-districts (Sheikh El-Hadid, Ma'tbali, and Jandairis) not being assisted by partners.
- **21 FSL partners** submitted plans on bread distribution to assist **1.5M beneficiaries** in **September**. Reduction of bread assistance is expected to be **0.8M** in both October 2022 and November 2022 (without WFP intervention).

PLANNED # OF BENEFICIARIES BY FSL PARTNERS FOR UPCOMING 3 MONTHS



*WFP Cooperating Partners distributed 15 kg of flour (100 grams bread per person/day) to people. The number of WFP beneficiaries amounts to 0.45M people that is equivalent to 30% of the total caseload, as the amount of bread distributed meets about 30% minimum daily requirement (330 grams bread per person/day).
