Project Background

- VSF Suisse in partnership with VSF Germany are implemented a two (2) years project World Organisation for Animal Health (WOAH, founded as OIE) and VSF International Join project.
- The project aims to identify and assess the main CAHW training and implementation models worldwide.
- This assessment will enable WOAH and associated experts to develop competency and curricula guidelines for CAHWs.
- In addition, the project will identify success and failure factors of CAHW programmes, through a global literature review on the one hand, and through field-based case studies in 4 Asian and African countries on the other hand.

Objectives of the action

 The CAHW Case Study aims to asses and document the factors contributing to the long-term sustainability of CAHWs services in 4 pre-identified countries that includes Burundi, Cambodia, Niger, South Sudan.

- CAHWS Lists: Lists for the targeted areas were updated and submitted to VSF Int.
- Recruitment of Consultant: This is concluded internally (VSF Consultant) – Contract signed and finalizing TOR requirements.

- Enumerators: A total 6 Research Assistants/Data collector/Enumerators were trained and deployment underway.
- Inception Workshop: Was conducted and attended by pioneers of the CAHWs and Animal Health Services in the Country.


