Objectives of the action

 The CAHW Case Study aims to asses and document the factors contributing to the long-term sustainability of CAHWs services in 4 pre-identified countries that includes Burundi, Cambodia, Niger, South Sudan.



Background - Animal Health Services Delivery

- Between 1970s and early 1980s, animal health services were provided by the Government.
- Between 1989 and 1993, Operation Lifeline Sudan, a consortium of UN agencies and NGOs started to provide AHS.
- Around 1993 2005, Community Based Animal Health Program was establishment.



Background cont.

- From 2005 2011, CPA was signed and Southern Sudan become an autonomous state. Ministry of Animal Resources and Fisheries was established up to States and County levels.
- 2011 Date, South Sudan gained independence and Ministry of Livestock and Fisheries with various units and structure was established.

Key Activities and Achievements

- Planning and coordination meetings: Series of meetings were conducted and attended including CAHWs Working Group meetings.
- CAHWS Lists: Lists for the targeted areas were updated and submitted to VSF Int.
- Data collectors and consultants recruited:

- Enumerators: A total 6 Research Assistants/Data collector/Enumerators identified and trained.
- Inception Workshop: With key stakeholders conducted – Academia, line ministries counterpart agencies.
- Kobo Tool box: Currently being pre-tested.




