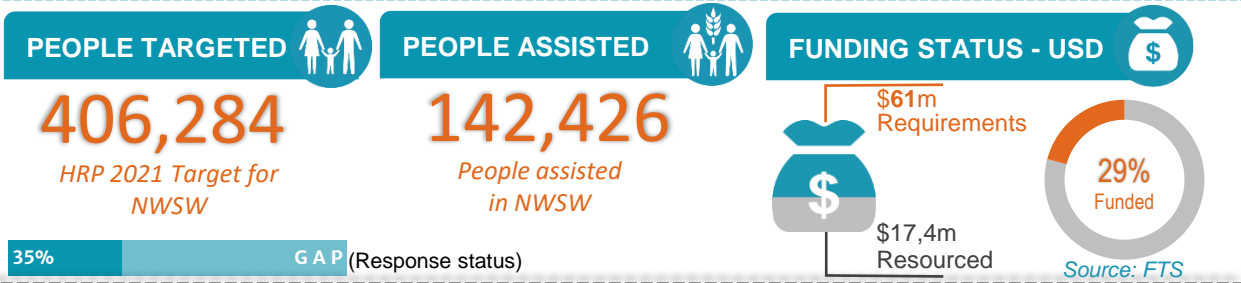


As of December, 26 partners collectively assisted 142,426 people with emergency food, agriculture, and livelihoods humanitarian assistance. This means a 85 percent gap is recorded based on the People in Need (HRP 2021). Out of the total beneficiaries, about 79 percent received food assistance and 28 percent of the total beneficiaries received assistance through cash and voucher modalities. WFP South-West assisted out of 55,000, 31,238 beneficiaries planned in both Meme and Manyu. The main reason for drop in performance was the suspension of activities following food diversion in some subdivisions in Meme. FAO monitored 300HHs for setting up of market gardening plots in 4 production basins as well as the distribution of materials for the construction of 225 mini poultry production units in NWSW. The cluster provided technical guidance to partners submitting their projects for the HRP 2022 and published the interactive dashboard.

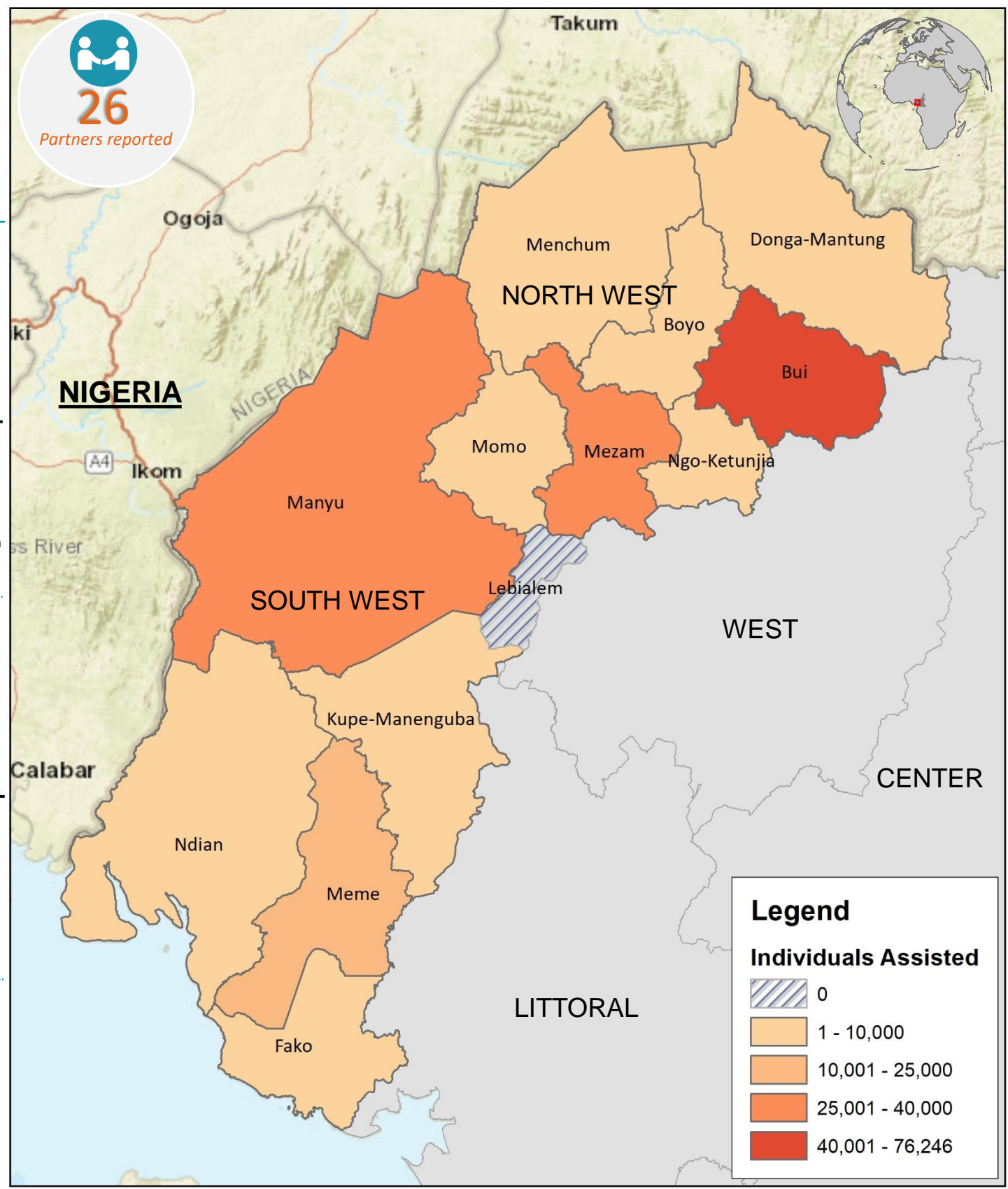
