



Combined: FSS Bi-Weekly Update #42 and Fire Updates # 6 | 19 April 2021

Fire Response:

- To respond to the needs of households who lost their food and belongings in the fire from 22 March, 1,300,000 hot meals (lunch and dinner) have been distributed. Hot food kitchens were established in and around the camps to provide fresh cooked meals. Following the distribution of kitchen sets and LPG, households have redeemed their monthly April e-voucher assistance and been reintegrated into regular food assistance programming. The provision of hot meals has been discontinued since 11 April.
- Partners have distributed over 60,000 dry food snacks to fire affected households to complement main assistance.
- As many people lost essential documents in the fire, SCOPECARDS have been printed and distributed for all affected households in camps 9, 8E and 8W. SCOPECARDS have been distributed at NFI distribution points together with kitchen kits, hygiene kits, facemasks, and dignity kits.
- Food security and child protection partners coordinated to provide high energy biscuits to over 60 temporary Child Friendly Spaces.
- Over 120 host community households affected by the fire received in-kind food and livelihoods support. WFP-MEAL and IOM-NPM conducted a joint needs assessment of host community households affected by the fire and presented [PRELIMINARY FINDINGS](#)
- FSS and WASH Sector are working on a joint guidance note for solid waste management in emergency food responses, this guidance note is built on lessons learned from the fire response and will serve to support potential future emergency responses.
- EETWG partners gathered field samples and data to support the joint environmental assessment for fire-affected areas, including a damaged tree catalogue for site management action.
- EETWG published an [ADVOCACY NOTE](#) that outlined environmental and disaster risk mitigation recommendations for the fire-affected camps.
- EETWG coordinated with FAO to develop planting guidance in fire-affected areas and source required planting materials.
