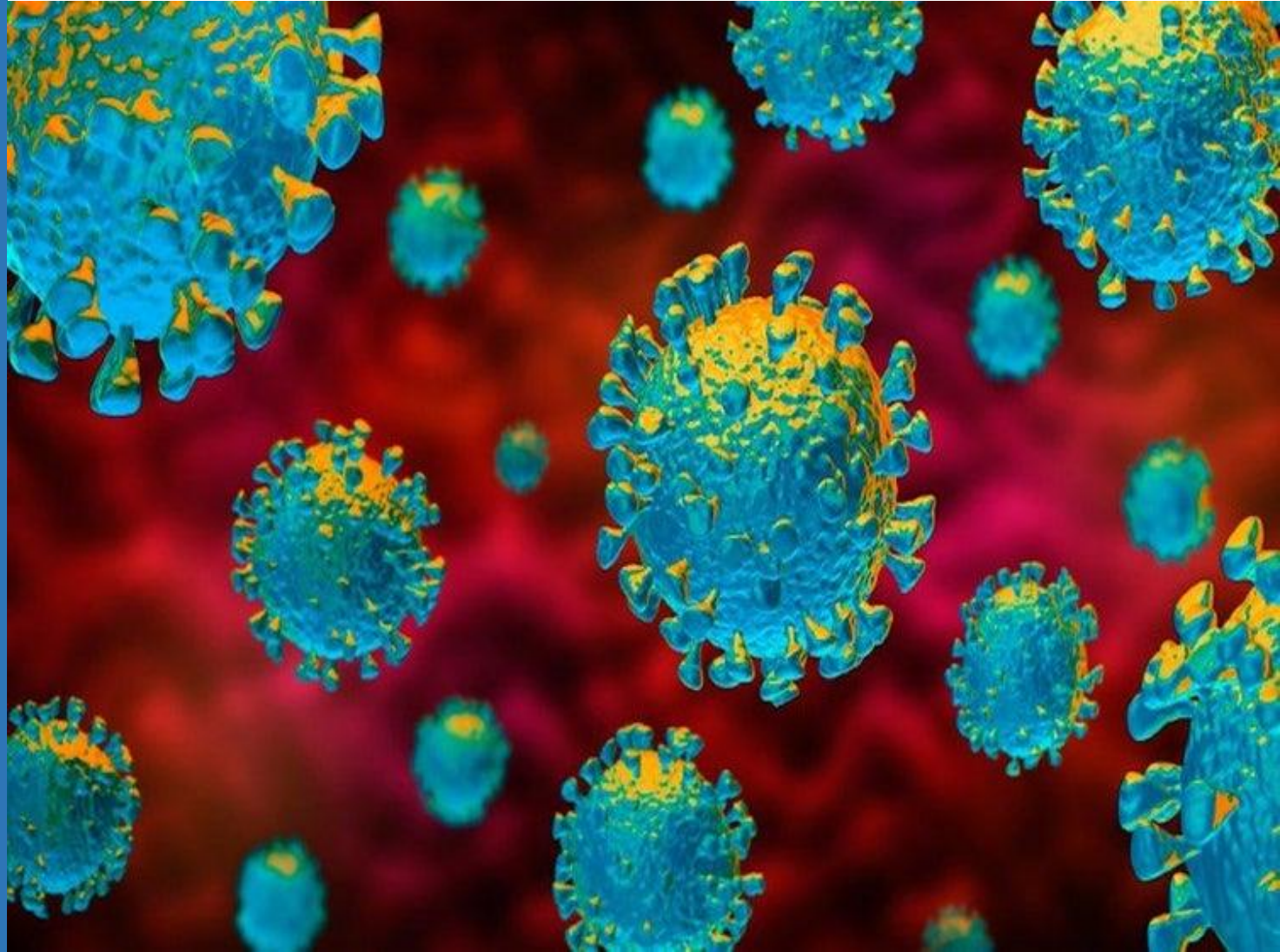


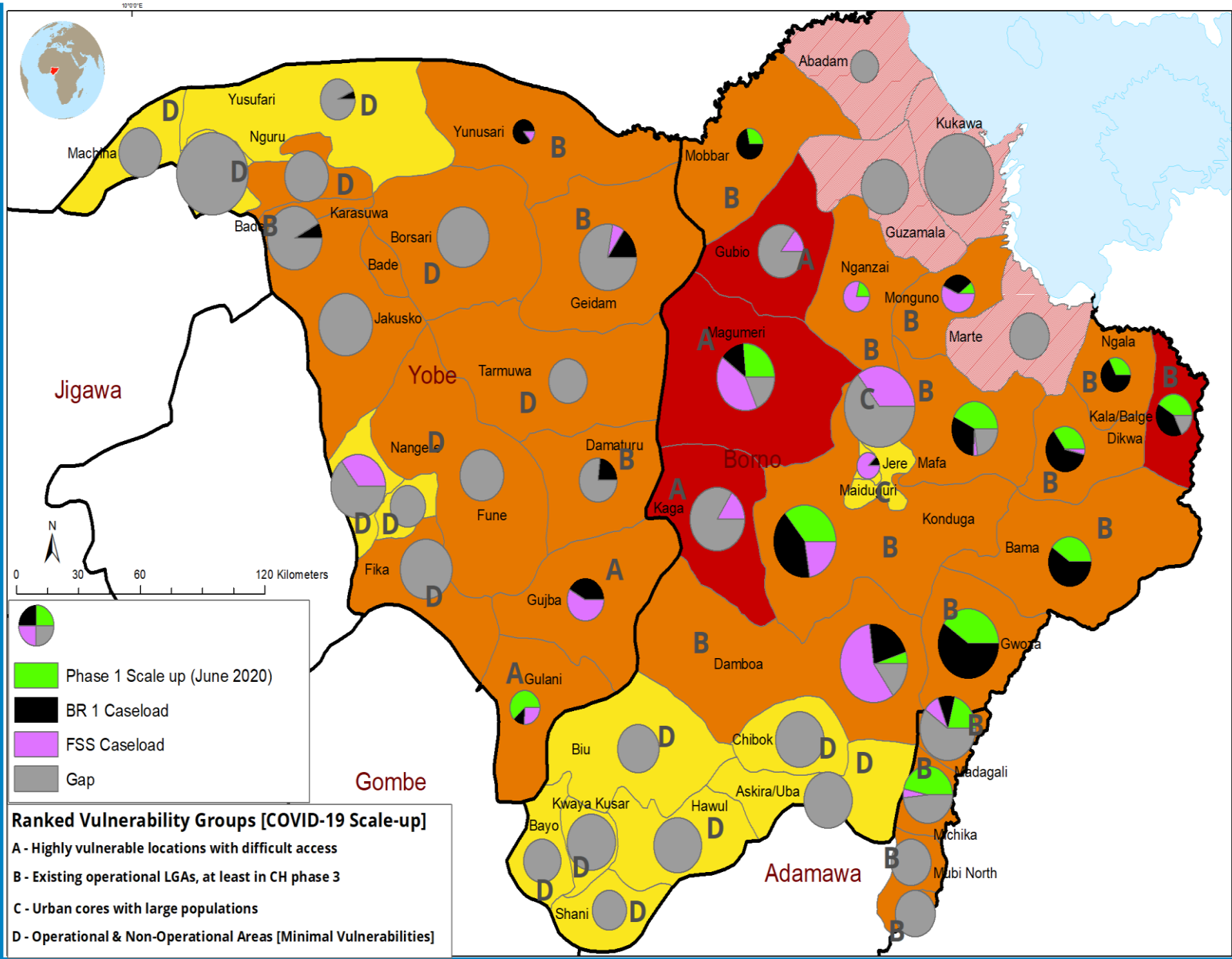

Targeting Criteria

Targeting criteria

- Female headed households (HHs) with no income support.
- HH with chronically ill/sick member (1 to 2, 3 and above members).
- Head of household with disability
- HH's that have not been able engage in livelihood activities for an extended period of time, due to lock down or COVID restrictions.
- Elderly (above 60+) or child headed households.
- HH's with no livelihood activity/source or HH's that are reliant mainly on begging a means of sustenance.
- HH's heavily reliant on unskilled labour, handicraft, daily labour, petty trade etc.

Secondary Criteria

- Newly displaced HH's;
- Farming HHs that have lost access to their farmland or would have lower yield due to lock down and COVID-19 related restrictions;
- HH with one- or two-members elder (ages 60 and above);
- HH's with large number of dependents;
- HH's with high reliance on food aid (from relatives, friends etc), remittances etc;
- Households reliant mainly on firewood/grass gathering;
- House quarantined and social stigmatized households and families may not have enough to eat and are restricted from movement temporarily.



Implementation arrangement

Implementation arrangement

- **Tier 1 : All the 653,130 from phase 1 to phase 3**
 - Number of ration : One off single full ration
 - Transfer modality : in-kind, e-voucher or cash depending on the location
 - Phase IV : Not included in the plan
 - Timeline :
 - Phase 1 : August
 - Phase 2 : September
 - Phase 3 : October
- **Tier 2 : 42% of 653,130 (335,635)**
 - Number of ration : one off single 70% ration
 - Timeline : After October
