# **COUNTRY RESPONSE UPDATE**

As of November 2020, FSL cluster reached 45,161 households with livelihood kits (fishing, vegetable & crop kits) to improve food production. A total of 32,362 beneficiaries recieved different types of trainings to build their capacity and reduce dependancy on food and agricultural assistance.

In the HRP 2020, a total of 8.0 million animals have been targeted for vaccination and treatment. As of end of November 6 million animals have been vaccinated/treated by FAO and FSL partners benefitting 252,888 households.




