

# Afar: Agriculture Cluster Partners' Response Dashboard

January-June 2023



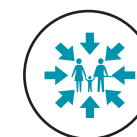
Agriculture partners in Afar continue to scale up their response. However, resources and low partners presence remain to be a major problem and priority to address all targeted population in the region. Conflict, flood and drought have had a devastating impact on the farming and pastoralist populations in the area, resulting in livestock deaths, a lack of milk production, loss of income, and crop failure. In 2023, DRM-ATF targeted 202,922 people who needed emergency agriculture and livelihoods assistance. As of June 30, 2023, the DRM-ATF cluster partners reached 127,967 people through various interventions.

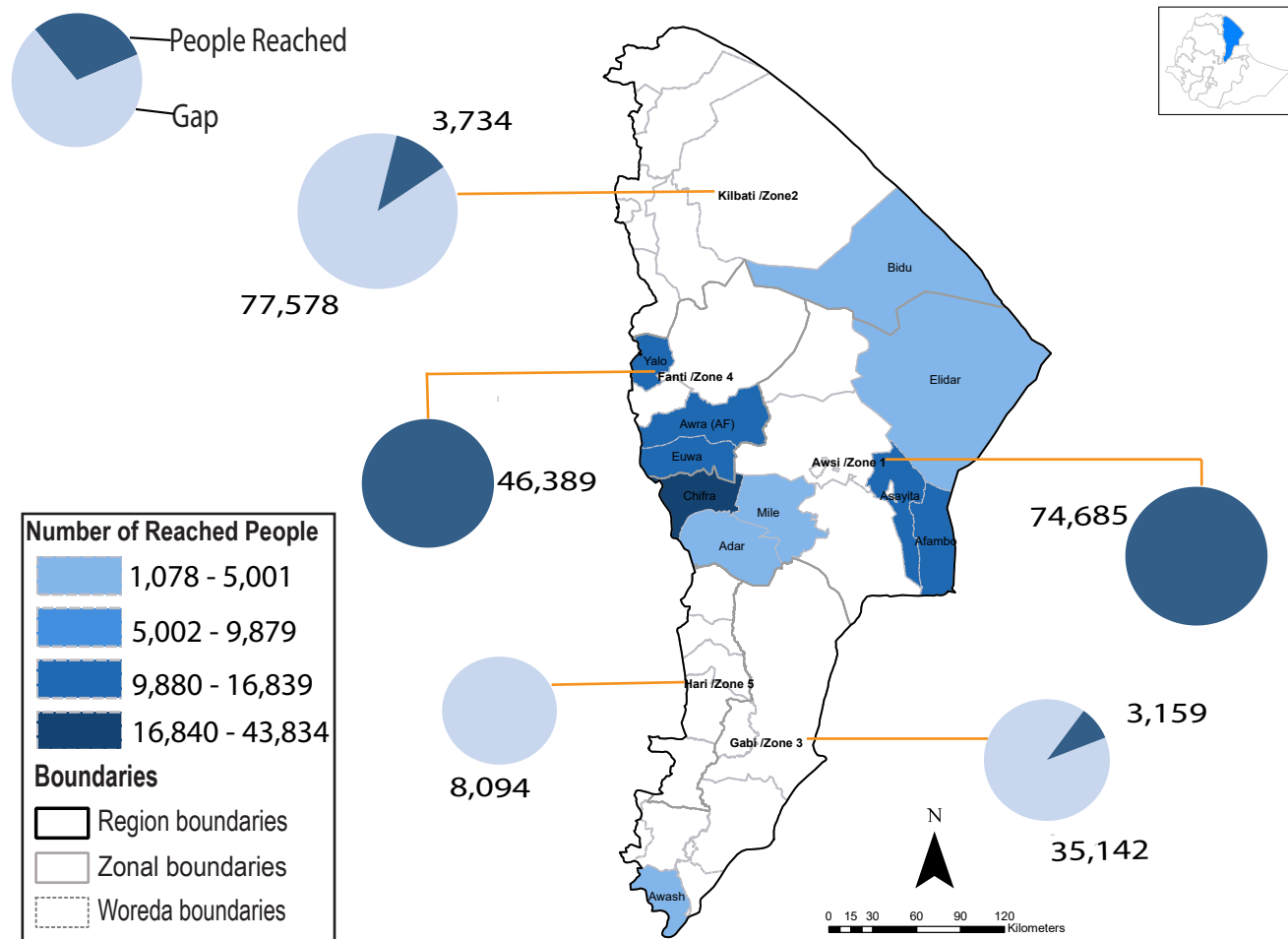

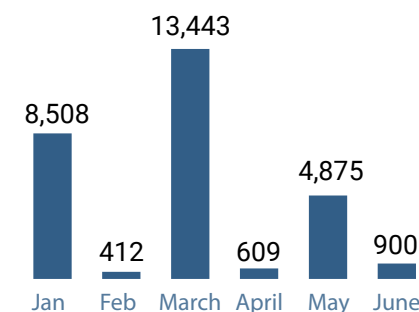

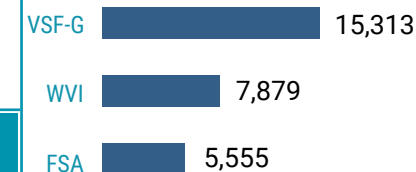
