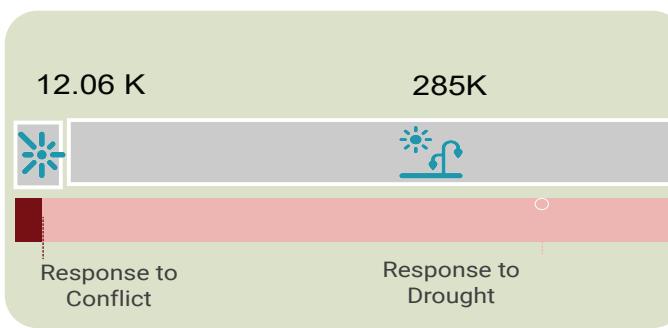
OVERVIEW

In 2023 the agriculture cluster task force continued supporting the affected population in Oromia region, with in the reporting period the cluster has supported 274,896 vulnerable people to start recovering from crisis and natural hazards, through targeted programming. This means the achievement is not fully addressed the need of affected population as per the plan due to grossly underfunding of national agriculture cluster at 13% of the \$ 276 million funding required. And other significant reasons on the ground.

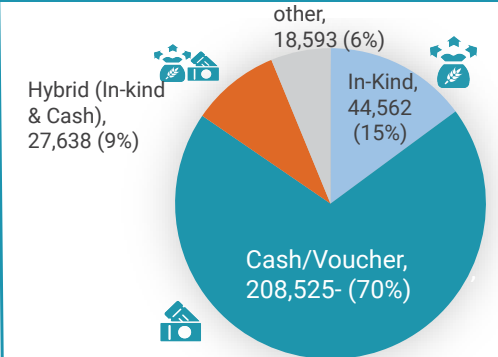

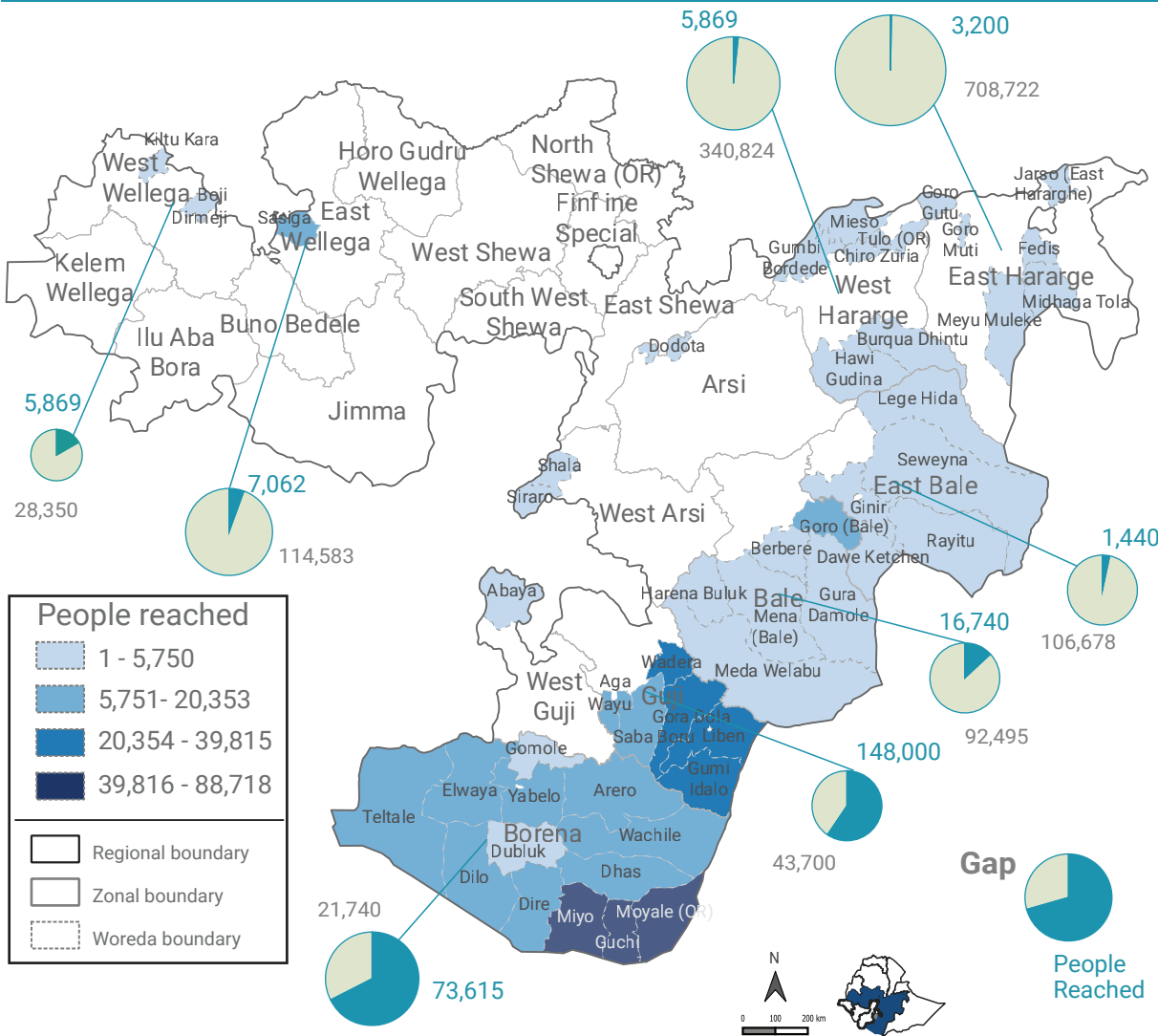
BENEFICIARIES REACHED BY CRISIS



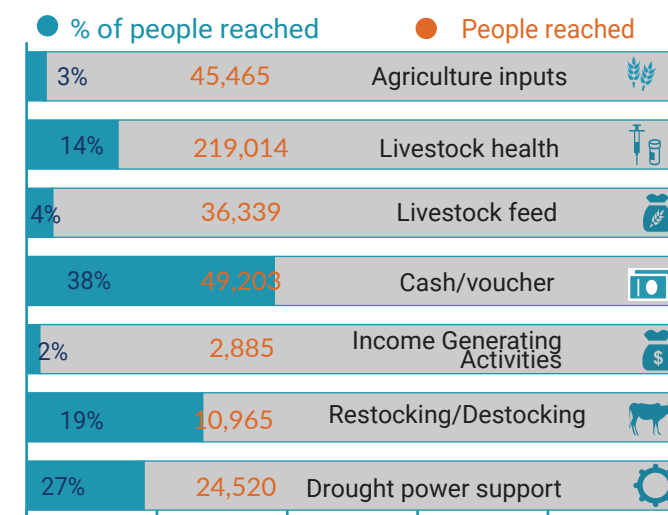
BENEFICIARIES REACHED BY MODALITY

PEOPLE REACHED BY ACTIVITY

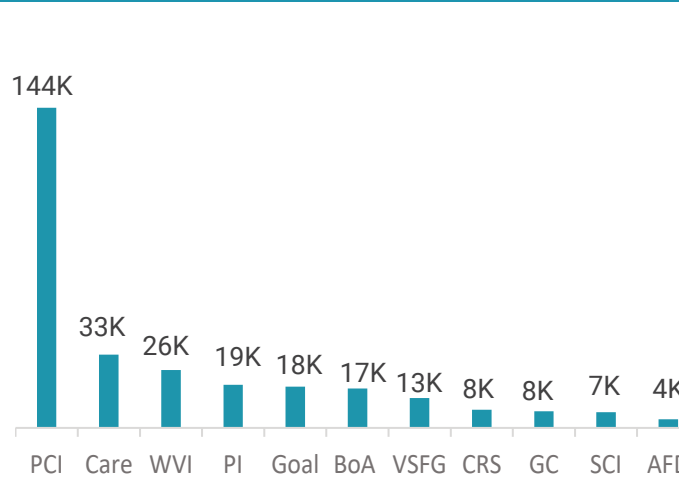

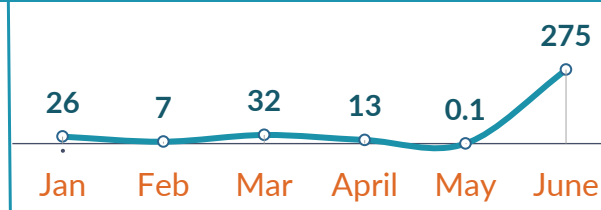

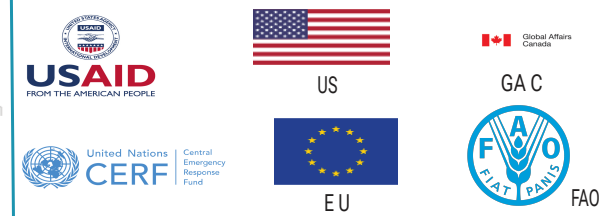
