



• Overall, 12 Project were submitted under FAS to the RA and 7 projects were accepted.



HRP revision 2023 and key priorities by the FAS.

• FSA programming will focus on earthquake-affected people in HCT response areas in Aleppo, Latakia, and Homs/Hama, and in Idleb and Aleppo areas reached through cross-border operations. It aims to ensure food assistance support to people hosted in and outside shelters, to ensure access and availability to bread, distribute ready to eat kits, and scale up GFA in-kind or other response modality to meet the target
