





Southern zones in November.

FOOD ASSISTANCE COVERAGE IN TIGRAY IN NOVEMBER 2022




PEOPLE ASSISTED BY WEEK WITH SUPPLIES BROUGHT IN SINCE APRIL



* More than 27,300 MT of food was brought into Tigray as of 30 November since humanitarian corridors reopened in mid-November









FOOD DISTRIBUTED IN NOVEMBER

Due to stock shortage, 479,084 people received wheat only instead of a balanced three-commodity basket (15 KG of cereals, 1.5 KG of pulses and 0.45 L of vegetable oil per person per round of six weeks) in November.
