

Q: can the FSAS approve localities in the propopsal?

A: The FSAS has provided priority districts. Localities and cohort should be justified in the proposal.

Q: If we opt to follow the WFP release of people/elibility lists and areas, do we instead submit a broad proposal document without this information? Instead we state our capacity and current areas so we will redesian later?

A: WFP assessed and unserved lists of beneficiaries is an option that could be used as the only way of targeting, or as a tool to complement your current list of assessed beneficiaries.

Q: Has the FSAS mapped where they have already group organisations to cover the activities and areas? Could this be shared so we are not duplicating?

A: The FSAS has shared the list of NGOs and coverage for those NGOs who submitted the EOI.

Q: The FSAS released a list for organisations in Tripoli and Akkar separately, does this mean they no longer want a mix over these areas?
