


Under objective 1 (Improving Access to Food through Conditional and Unconditional Transfers (Cash, Vouchers and In-Kind), FSC partners assisted 2,388,638 people out of 2,826,500 targeted (85% achievement).

In July, WFP responses constituted 64%, Qatar Charity 9%, SCI 8%, CARE 5%, ACTED 4%, Human Appeal 3%, QRCs 2% and the remaining 7% was provided by FAO, ACF, NRC, IRC, SIF, Mercy Corps, SOS, WVI, Candlelight, AADSOM, WHH, CODHNET, ADO and ASEP combined. Responses in Awdal, Lower Shabelle and Middle Juba are less than 30% of the target.


Notably, people assisted with unconditional transfers are mostly those in IPC 3 or worse who experience significant consumption gaps.

Monthly response Jan-July 2021: Beneficiaries assisted







## Strategic objective 2 update

Objective 2 (Provision of seasonal livelihood inputs & Livestock asset protection). In July, a total of 53,328 beneficiaries were reached.

Out of this, FAO responses constituted 85%, Mercy Corps 9%, NAPAD 2% and the remaining 4% was provided by SIF, ADO, AVSI, Candlelight and ACF combined. Cumulatively starting February, 1,013,723 beneficiaries have been assisted with farm inputs, animal restocking, Community Animal Health Workers and Good Agricultural Practices training, livestock treatment and CCPP vaccination. This translates to (81%) of the seasonal target (1,250,300). It is worth noting that July was the last month of the Gu seasonal inputs distribution.




