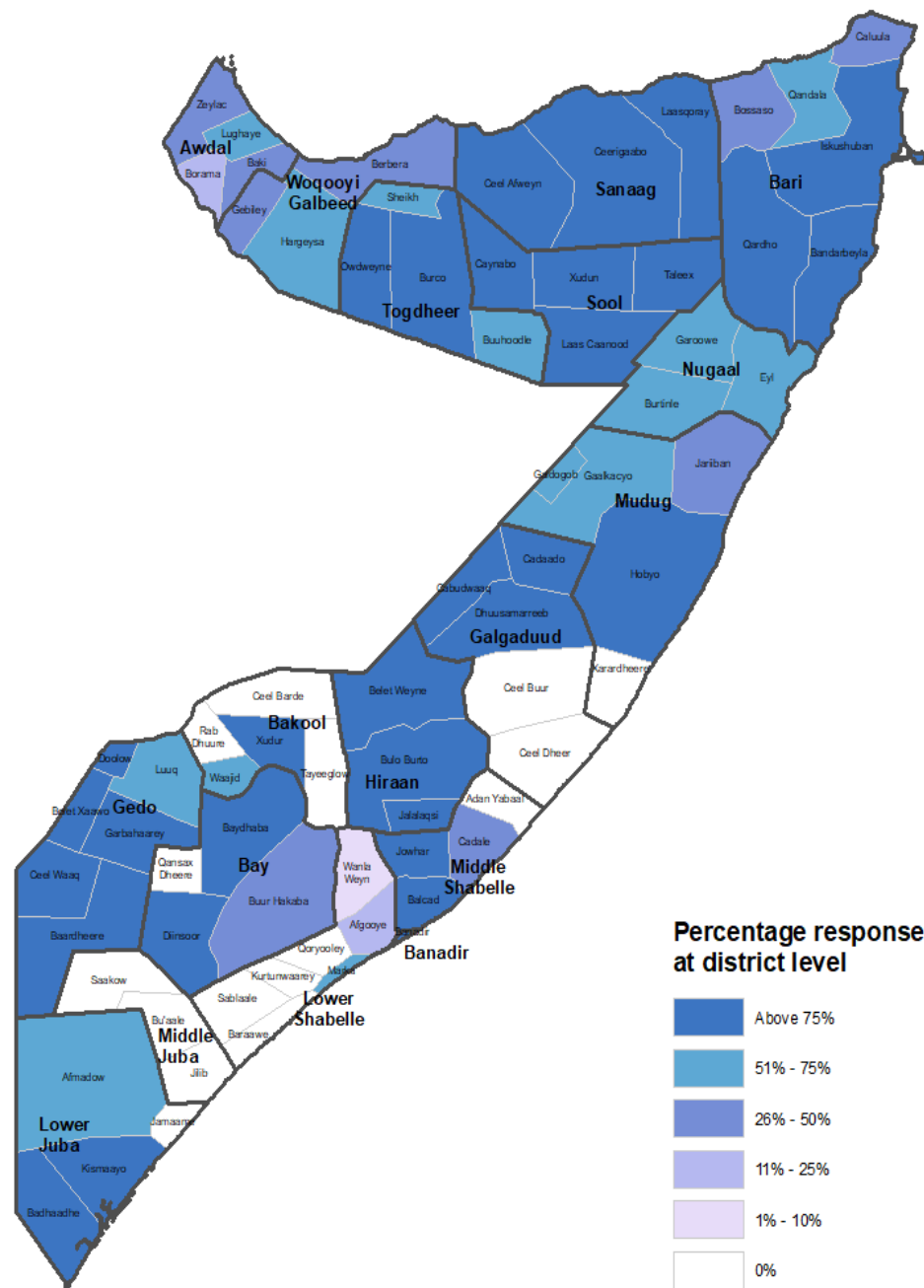
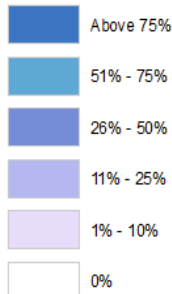


NUMBER OF BENEFICIARIES TARGETED VS ASSISTED BY DISTRICT

Strategic objective 1 update

In July, WFP responses constituted 64%, Qatar Charity 9%, SCI 8%, CARE 5%, ACTED 4%, Human Appeal 3%, QRCs 2% and the remaining 7% was provided by FAO, ACF, NRC, IRC, SIF, Mercy Corps, SOS, WVI, Candlelight, AADSOM, WHH, CODHNET, ADO and ASEP combined. Responses in Awdal, Lower Shabelle and Middle Juba are less than 30% of the target. Notably, people assisted with unconditional transfers are mostly those in IPC 3 or worse who experience significant consumption gaps.

Under objective 1 (Improving Access to Food through Conditional and Unconditional Transfers (Cash, Vouchers and In-Kind), FSC partners assisted 2,388,638 people out of 2,826,500 targeted (85% achievement).

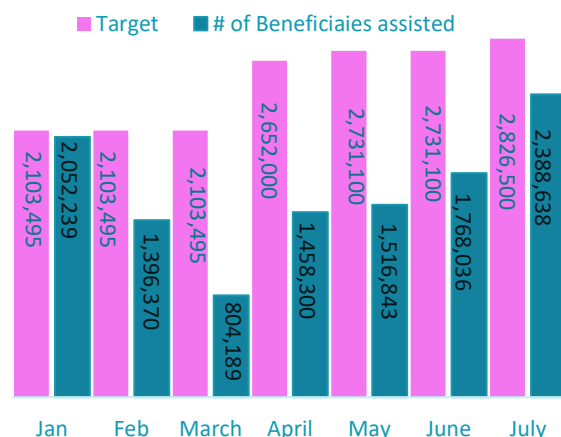

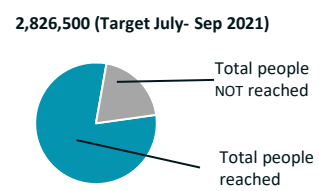

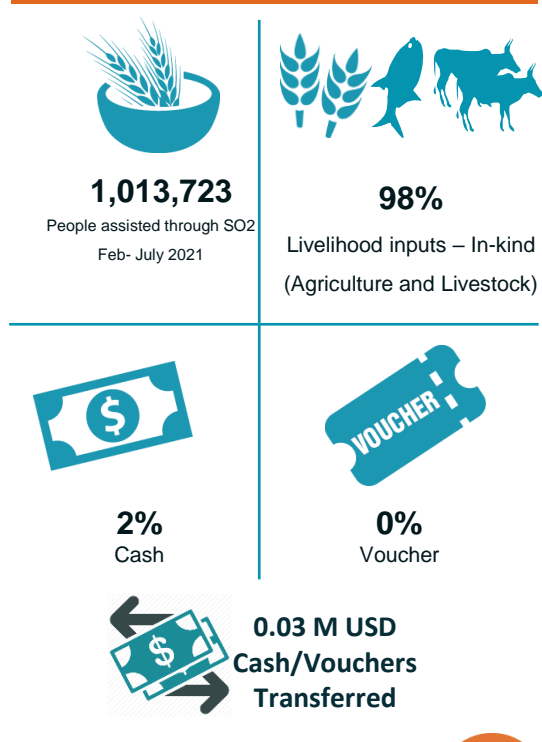

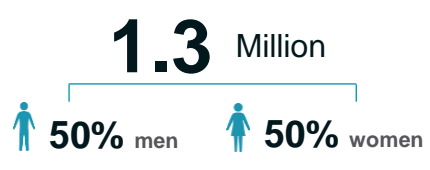

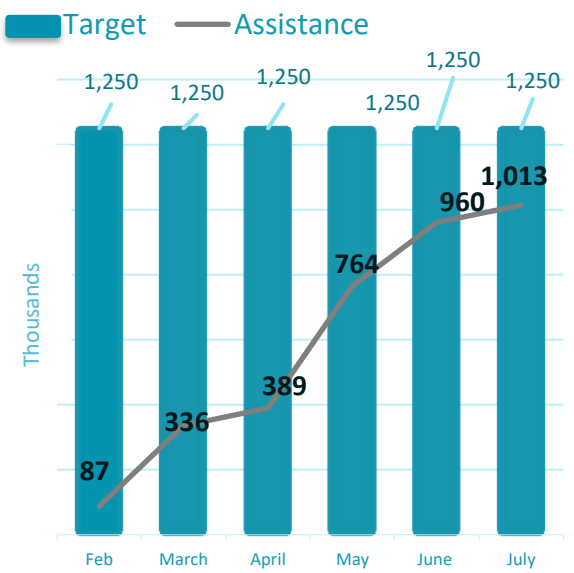
Strategic objective 2 update

Monthly response trend: Beneficiaries assisted and the target Feb-July 2021

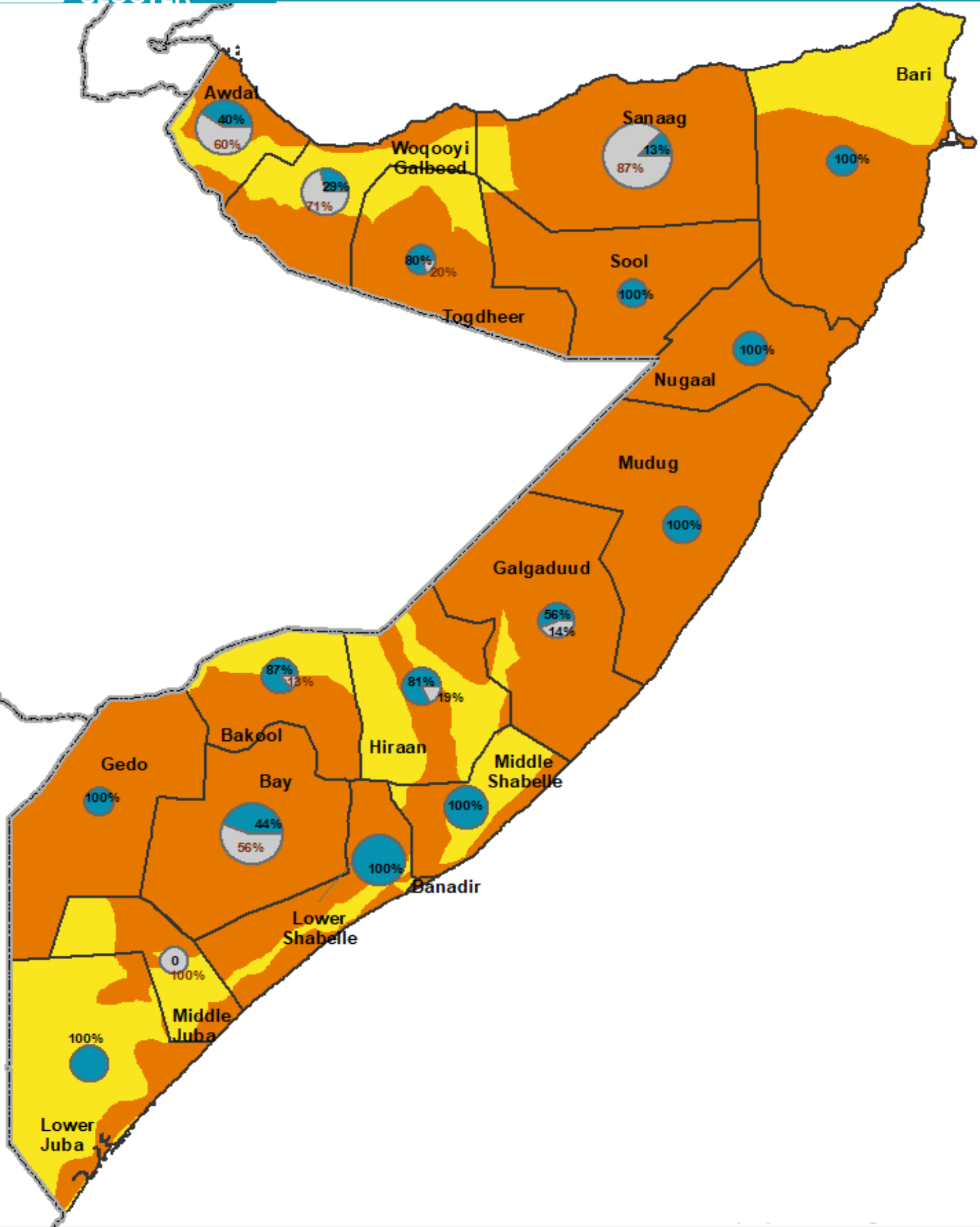

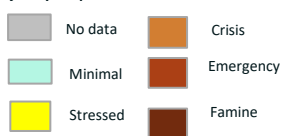
Out of this, FAO responses constituted 85%, Mercy Corps 9%, NAPAD 2% and the remaining 4% was provided by SIF, ADO, AVSI, Candlelight and ACF combined. Cumulatively starting February, **1,013,723** beneficiaries have been assisted with farm inputs, animal restocking, Community Animal Health Workers and Good Agricultural Practices training, livestock treatment and CCPP vaccination. This translates to **(81%)** of the seasonal target **(1,250,300)**. It is worth noting that July was the last month of the Gou seasonal inputs distribution.



Objective 2 (Provision of seasonal livelihood inputs & Livestock asset protection). In July, a total of **53,328** beneficiaries were reached.
