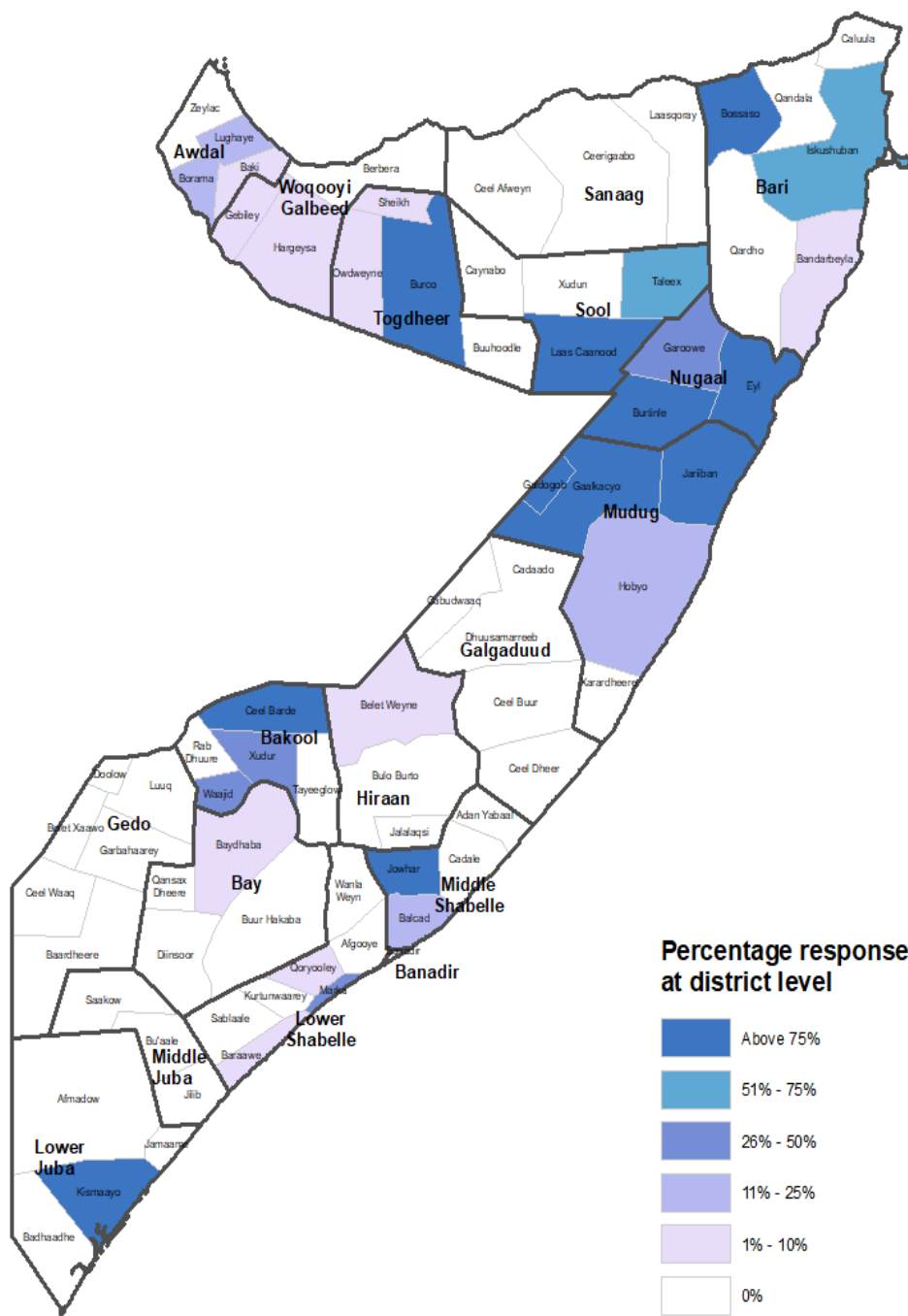
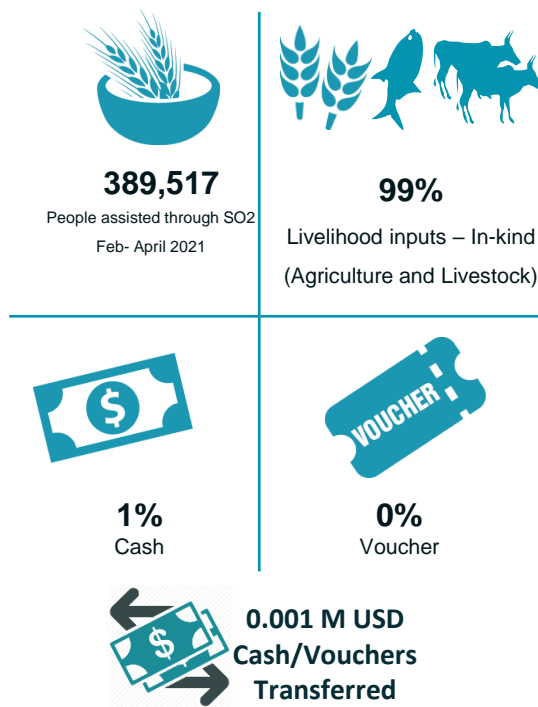


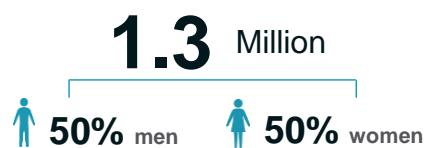
NUMBER OF BENEFICIARIES TARGETED VS ASSISTED BY DISTRICT

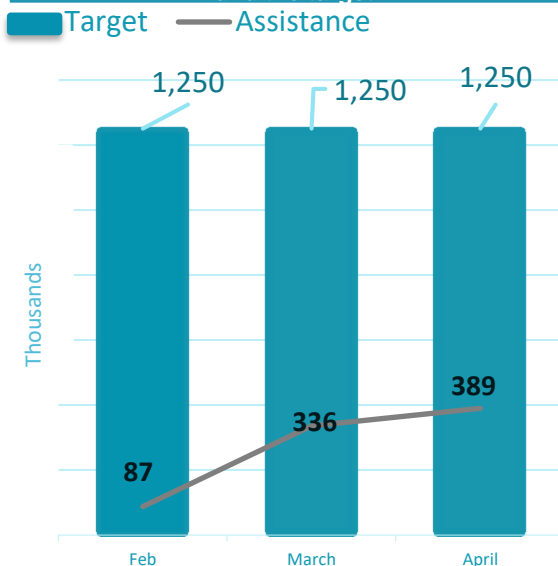
Strategic objective 2 update



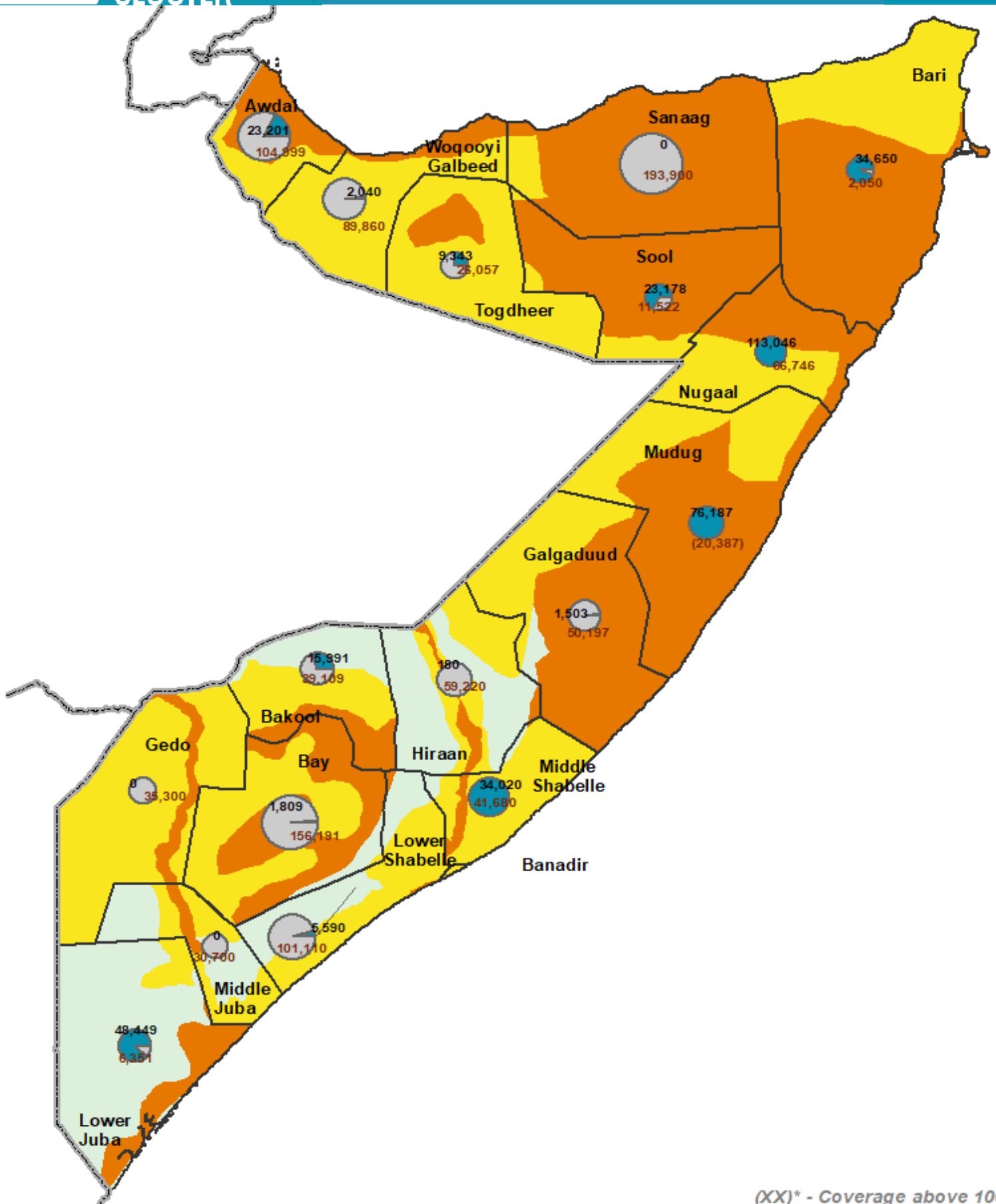

Cumulatively starting February, **389,517** beneficiaries have been reached (**31%**) of the seasonal target of 1.25 million. The season began in February and will run up to July 2021. Without additional resources, approximately 900,000 people in IPC 3 and 4 will not receive the emergency seasonal livelihood inputs they need, undermining production and worsening the impact of dry/lean seasons.

Monthly response trend: Beneficiaries assisted and the target



Objective 2 (Provision of seasonal livelihood inputs & Livestock asset protection). In April, a total of **53,475** beneficiaries have been assisted with farm inputs, animal restocking, livestock treatment and CAHWs trainings.
