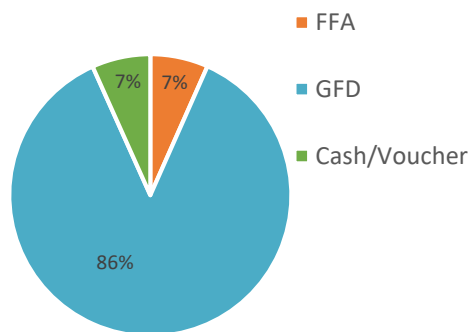


### COUNTRY RESPONSE UPDATE

In October, FSL cluster assisted about **1.3 million** people for cluster objective 1 (CO1) with activities aimed at improving access to food through different modalities in all States of South Sudan. 92% of beneficiaries received in-kind food assistance while 8% received Cash and Vouchers.

Based on the September IPC analysis, the October - December 2018 Catastrophe (IPC phase 5) outcomes are expected in Leer and Mayendit (former Unity state), Pibor (former Jonglei state), Panyikang (former Upper Nile state) and Greater Baggari in Wau (former Western Bahr El Ghazal state). In January - March 2019, Catastrophe is expected in Pibor and Canal/ Pigi (former Jonglei state) and Leer and Mayendit (former Unity state). 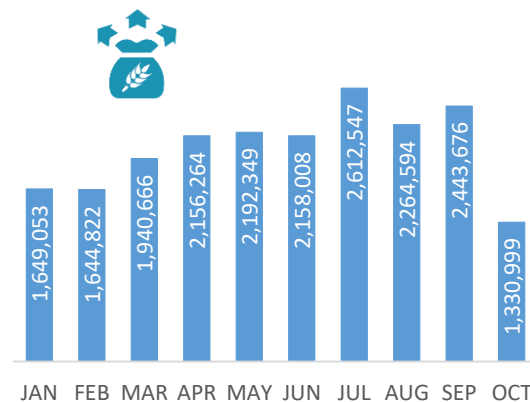

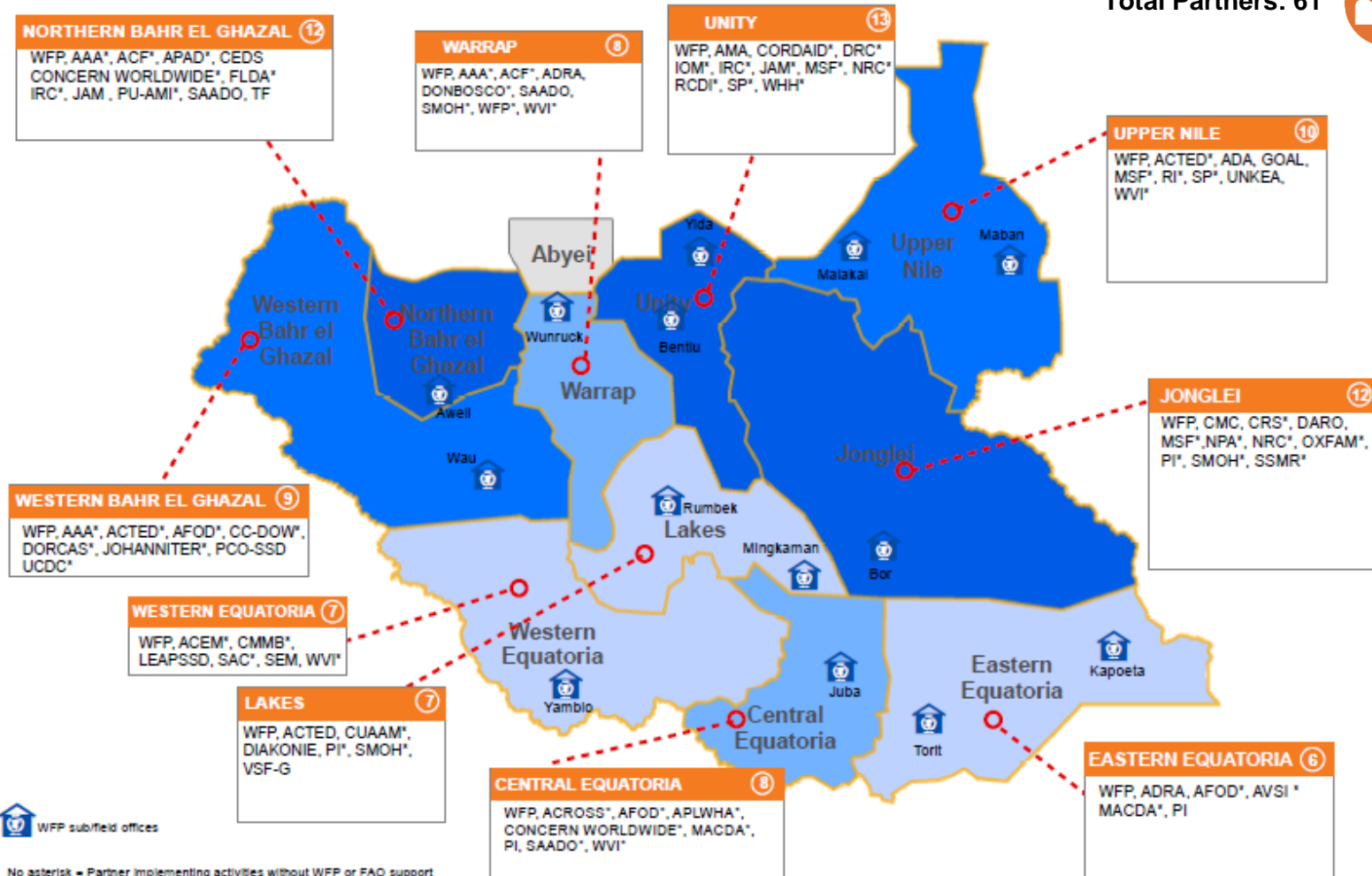

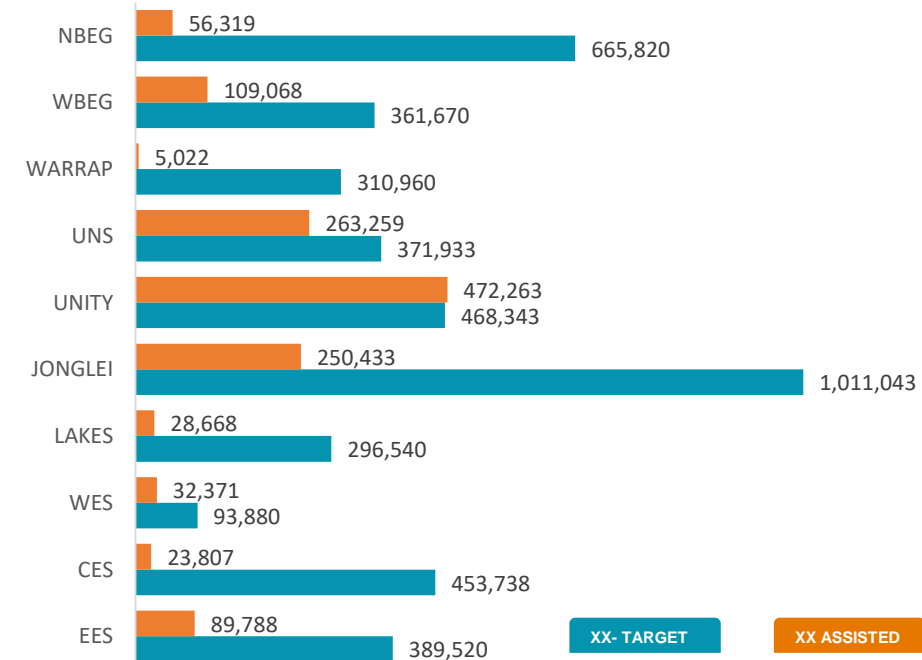
