

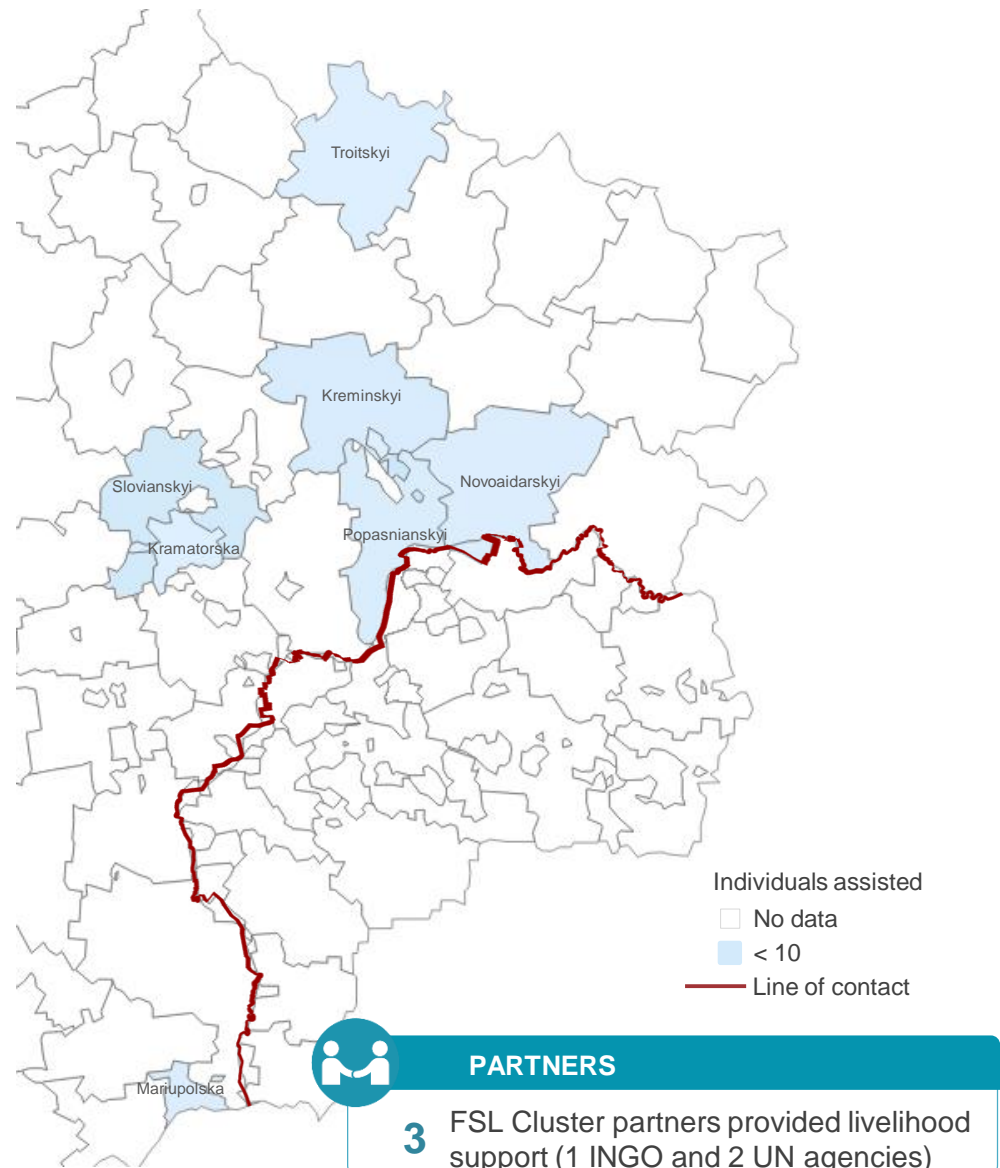
## CO3. IMPROVE ACCESS TO EMPLOYMENT AND INCOME GENERATING OPPORTUNITIES



During April–June, FSLC partners assisted **175** people (or 2%) out of the revised target of 9,213 people. Despite a slight increase in June, the response was substantially below the targeted for Eastern Ukraine. Cumulatively, **899** beneficiaries were assisted throughout January–June 2020, or 10% of the total people targeted. UNDP contributed 80% of the total number of people targeted in the first quarter of 2020, IOM 13%, and DRC 7%.

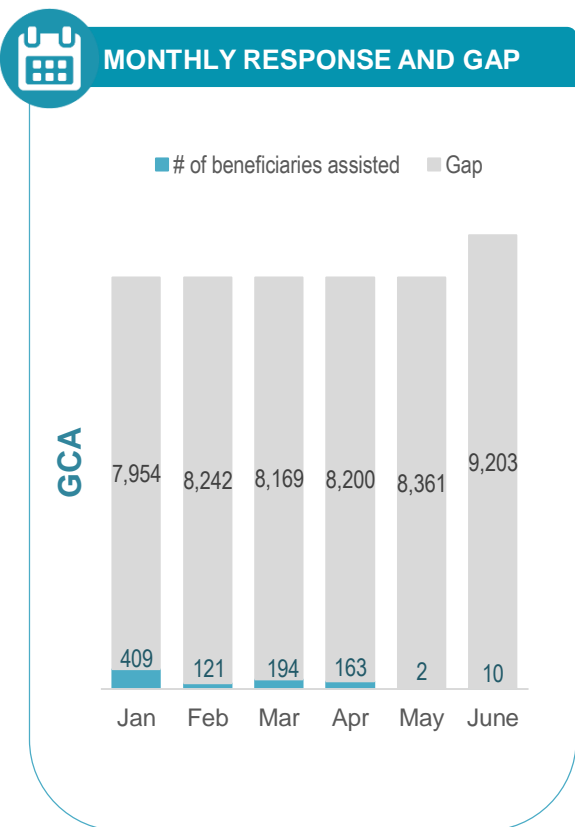
Under the COVID-19 development and quarantine measures, the need to scale up activities under this response objective remains which include support to small and micro-enterprise, job creation, and life scale training to reduce the threat on food security of the vulnerable households.
