Counties of concern

Aweil East (NBeG State)

- An estimated 1,126 HHs refugees have returned to South Sudan from South Darfur and South Kordofan in Sudan, since October 2022.
- An IRNA assessment in March found a proxy GAM rate of 30.4% (9.5% SAM and 20.9%) in Manger Amole Returnee camps.

Pibor (GPAA)

- According to the IPC analysis in October 2022, it was projected that the FSL situation in Pibor would improve between the April to July period, with the 5% P5 population moving into P4.
- Given the attacks in December/January, and the continuing impact on livelihoods, it is unlikely that the FSL situation has improved as projected.

Twic/Abyei (Warrap State, AAA)

- Recent assessment findings in Twic County found proxy GAM rates in camp settings ranging from 18% in Ajak Kuac, to 28% Nyin Deng Ayuel.
- More information is needed to understand how the ongoing conflict has affected populations in Abyei

Malakal

- Estimated 14000 IDPs in Malakal town. Continued arrivals from Kodok with IDPs being admitted to the IDP site. There is a large population of IDPs from central/northern Jonglei who have not been admitted to the camp.
