
Total People Reached

Since the fighting broke out in Sudan on 15 April 2023, Food Security and Livelihoods Cluster partners are providing food assistance (hot meals, dry ration, high energy biscuits and cash) to South Sudan returnees and Sudan refugees and third country citizens at border points and transit centers. According to IOM/UNHCR, by 22 July 2023, 193,000 people have arrived in South Sudan since teh start of the the conflict.


