1. Sudan Crisis Situation Update & Response Plan	Next Steps / Action points
<p>UNHCR updated on the South Sudan Emergency Response for the Crisis in Sudan highlighting on:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Planning assumptions: UN operations stopped in Sudan, market collapsed, impact on South Sudan - increasing severity of needs. • Planning Figures: 60,000 Refugees from Sudan, 180,000 South Sudanese Returnees, 10,00 Third country nationals • Coordination Model: Response by population group. Refugees to be relocated to existing camps, no new camps will be set up. South Sudanese returnees - assistance based on vulnerability criteria (Protection vulnerability category) • Response Plan: For returnees based on their plan some cash provided for transportation and integrated in existing HRP. • Food Security Response: At border points, providing ready to eat food, hot meals in collaboration with WFP <p>Launch of UNHCR-IOM Border Monitoring Dashboard - https://bit.ly/SouthSudanBorderMonitoringDashboard Click here to download this presentation</p>	<p>Updated information to be shared with FSLC partners.</p>
2. CRSF/SSHF Allocation Update	Next Steps / Action points
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A multisectoral famine prevention fund that will be provided by CERF/SSHF in six counties (Akobo, Fangak, Canal-Pigi, Leer, Mayandit, Kapoeta East). However, there is no clear breakdown for what would be allocated for each cluster. • Total envelope is USD 32 M: 16 M for CERF and 16 M for SSHF. • Focus on implementing Multi-Purpose Cash/Cash component as much as possible. 	<p>Updated information to be shared.</p>

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Duration for CERF – 6 months starting from May or June and SSHF – May 2023 to April 2024 • FSLC to provide more information on partners who will be able to apply based on OCHA eligibility criteria.
