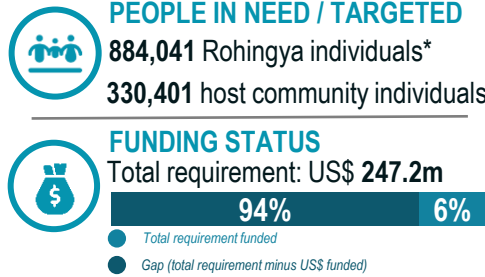


Rohingya and host communities remain vulnerable, with overall vulnerability of both populations increasing in 2021 (WFP REVA4). Food Security Sector (FSS) partners are targeting 100% of Rohingya population living inside the camps and 330,401 host community individuals in Ukhiya and Teknaf Upazila to improve communities' food security and resilience. In June, a new Fresh Food Corner (FFC) was rolled out in one camp location and sale of live chicken and fish was introduced in 3 camp locations, increasing the total number of FFCs to 16 across the camps. 18% of Rohingya population who are most vulnerable received fresh food voucher assistance (\$3 top up) to purchase additional food from FFCs. In host community, food assistance was provided to 29,871 households in Ukhiya and Teknaf as COVID-19 response.

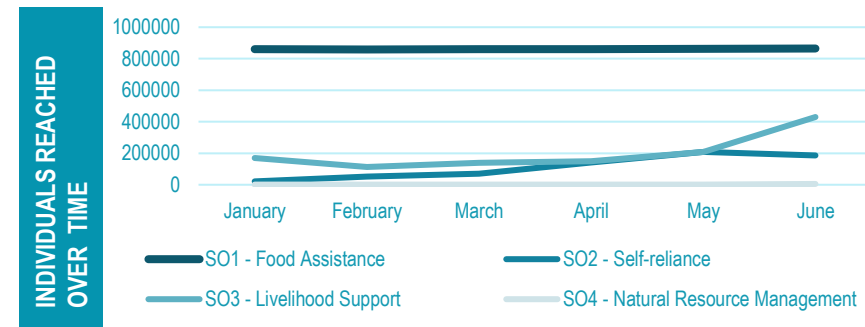

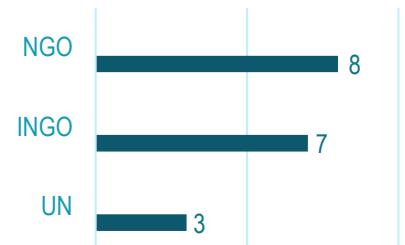
## JOINT RESPONSE PLAN MAP

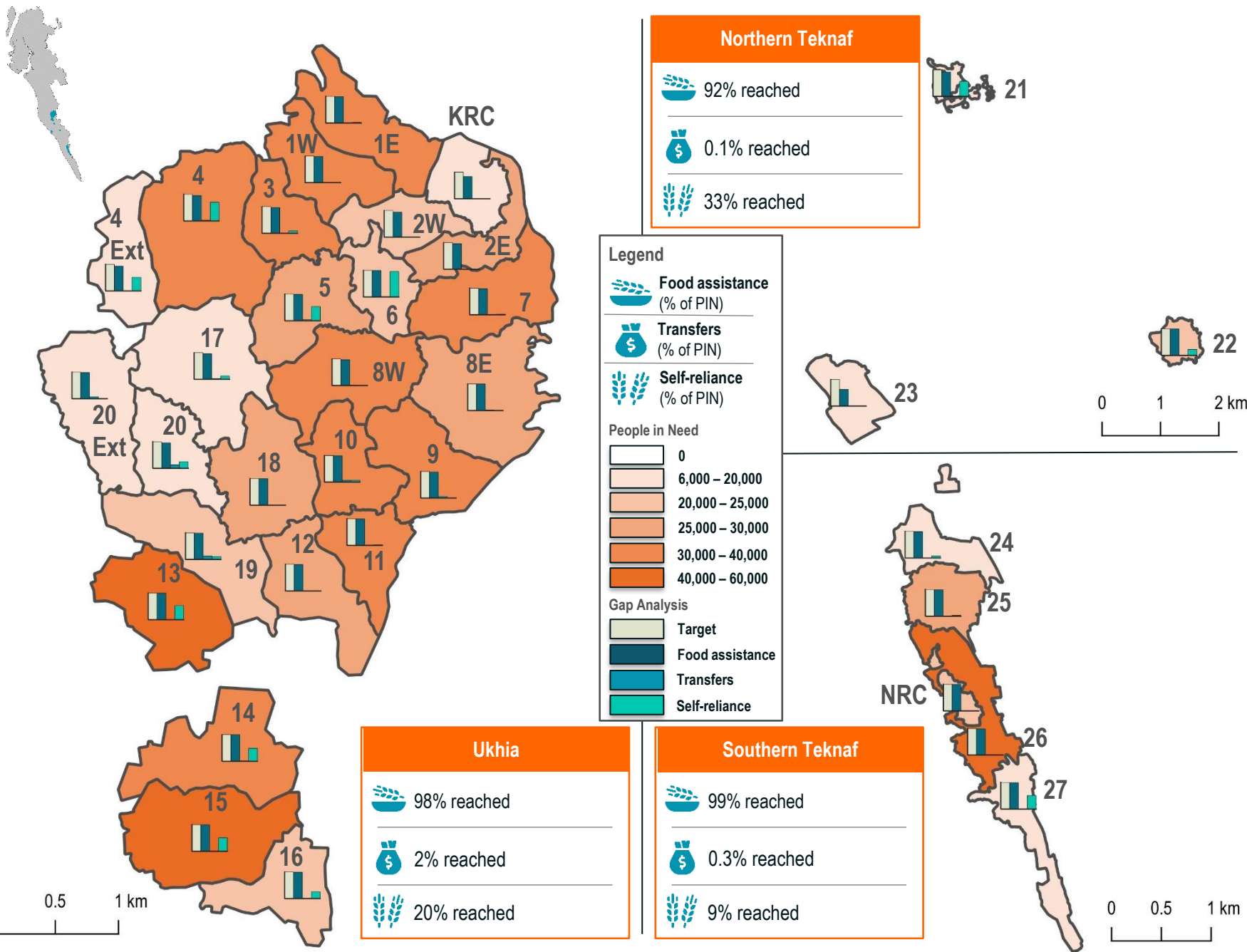

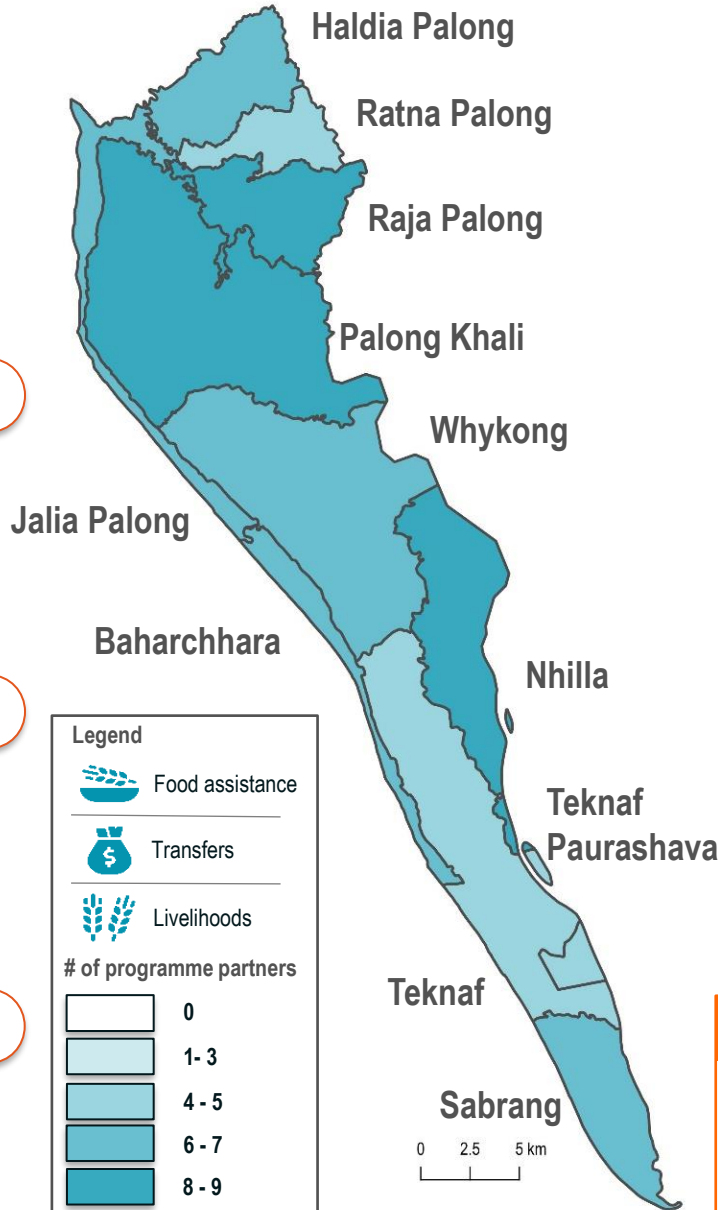

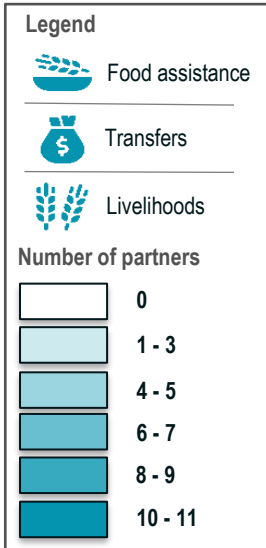
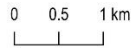

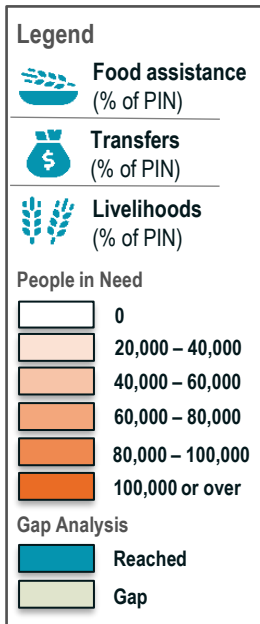
