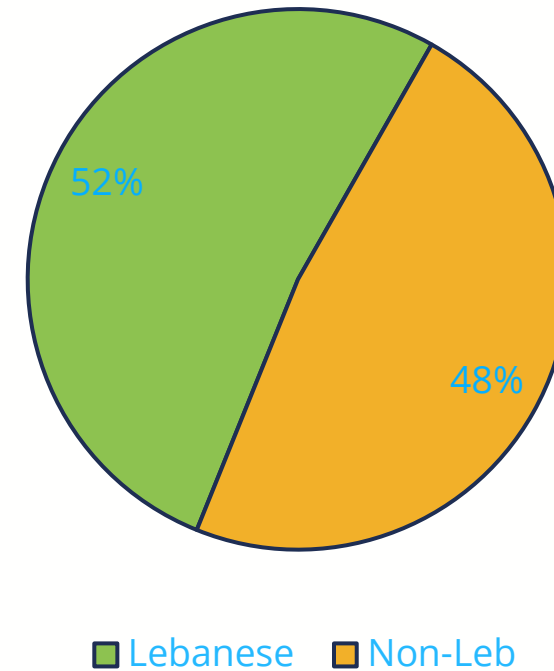
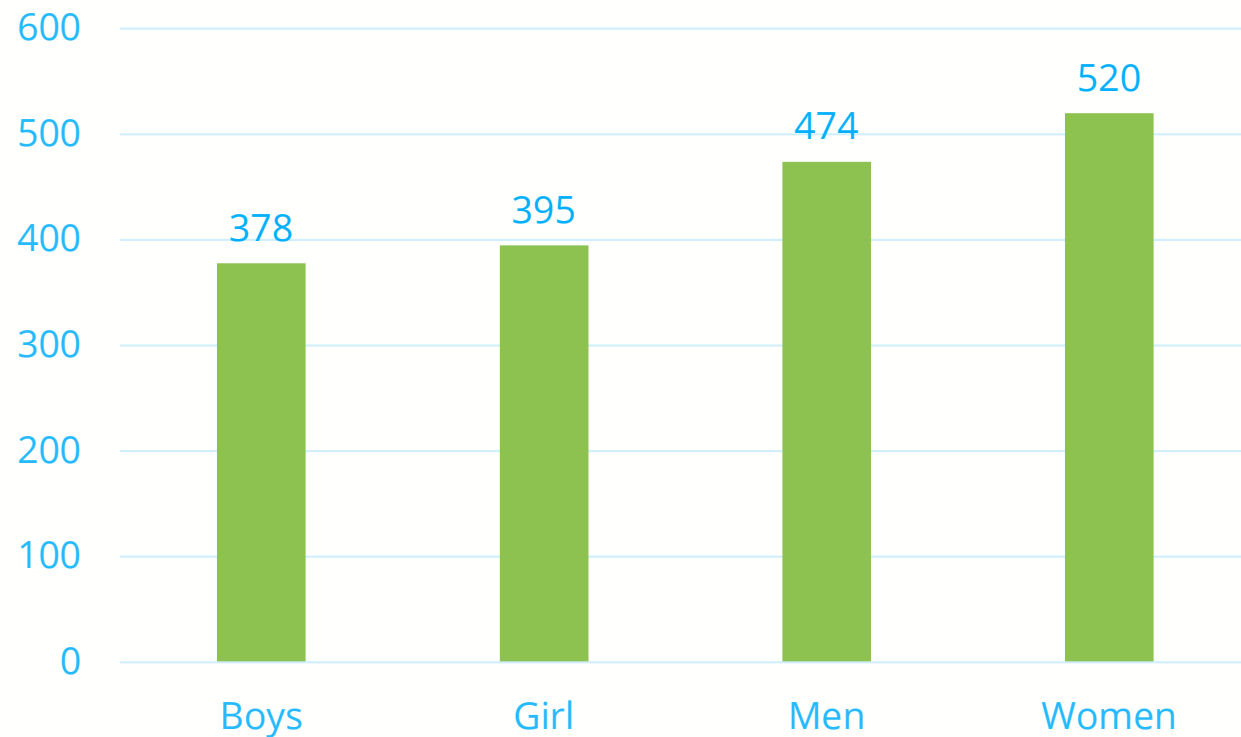

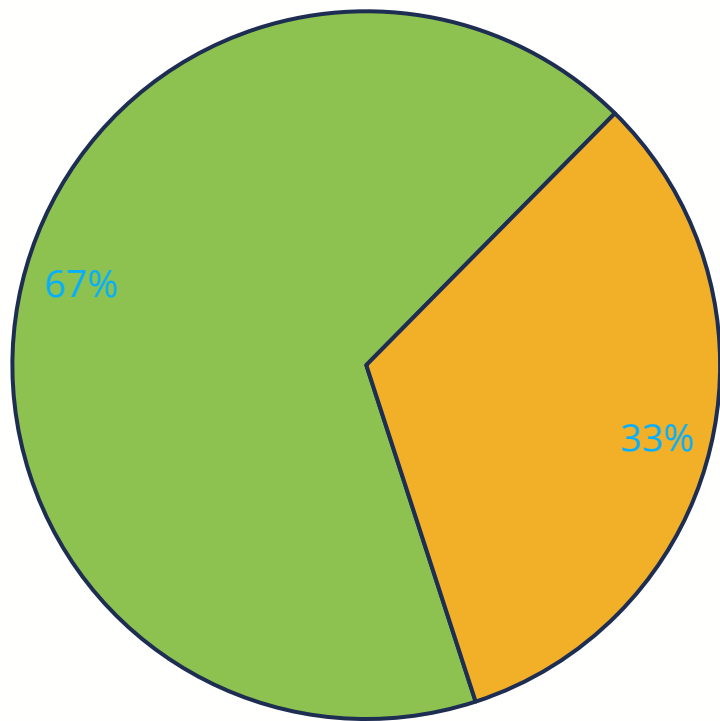
Beneficiaries receiving in-kind food parcels: **1,767**



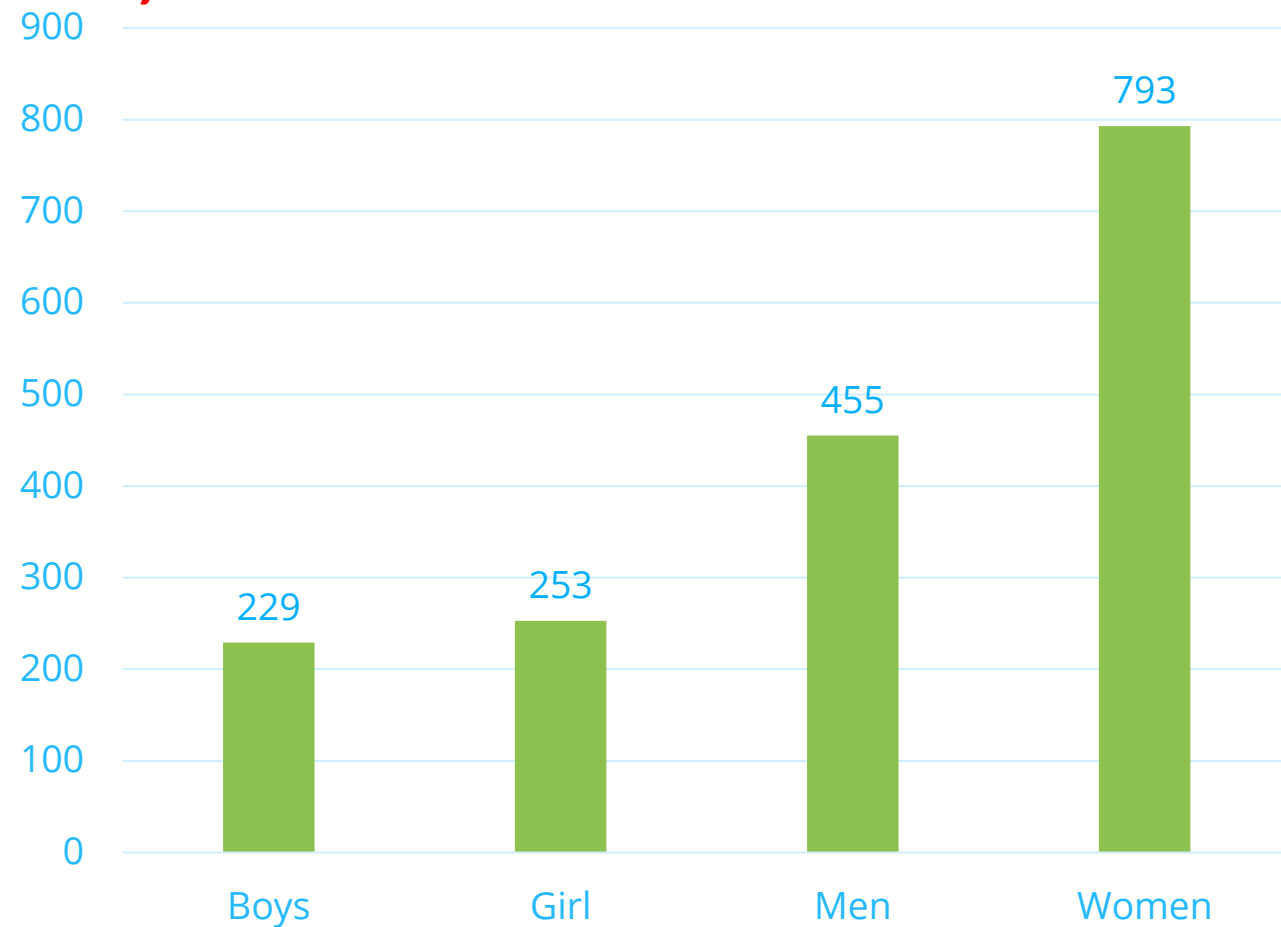

Beneficiaries receiving multipurpose cash assistance: **386**

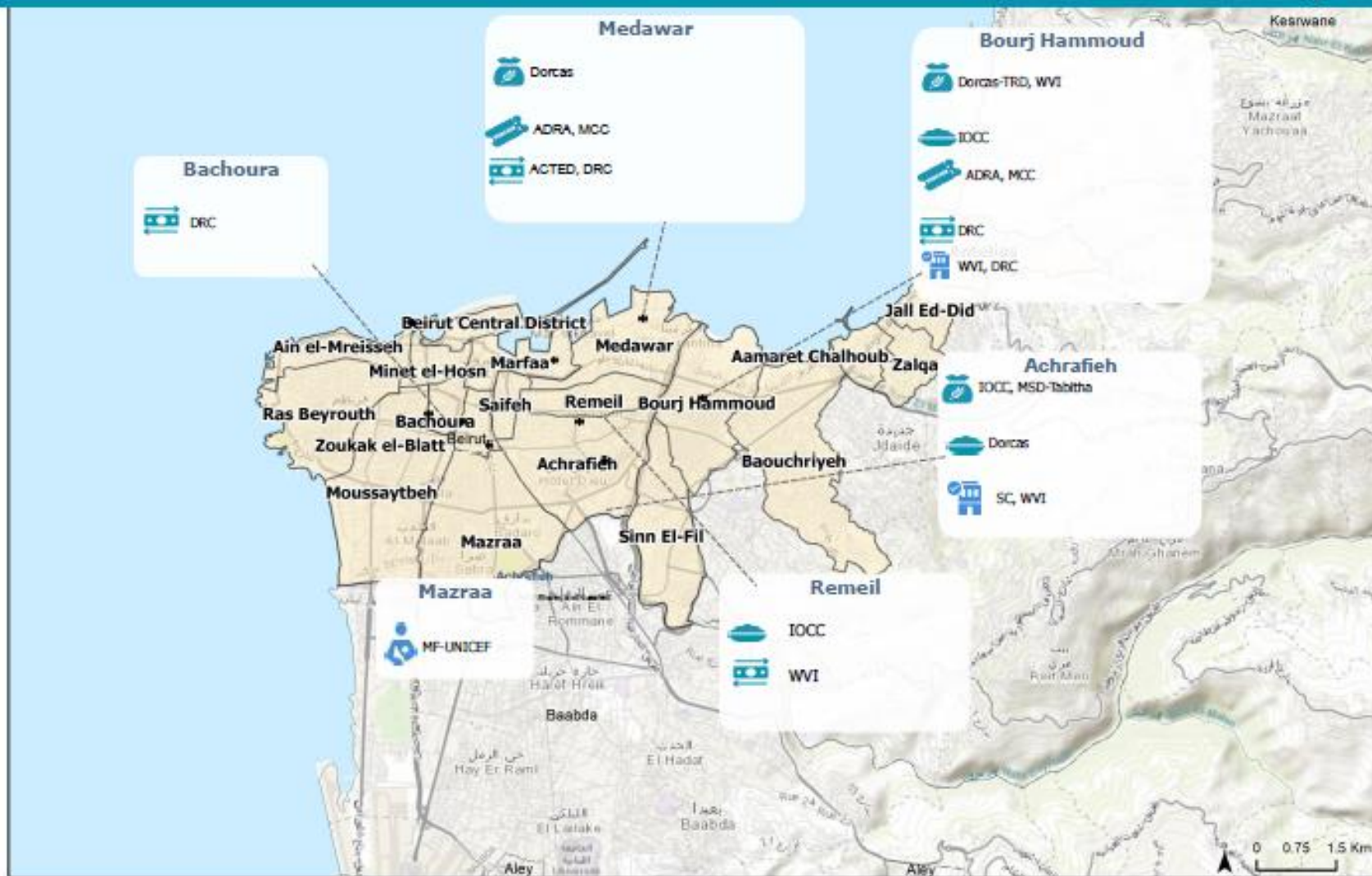

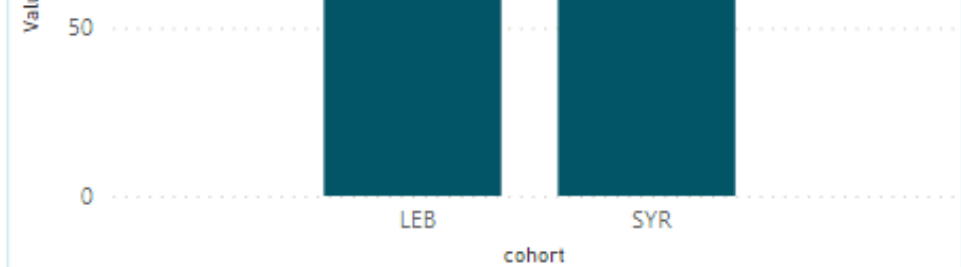
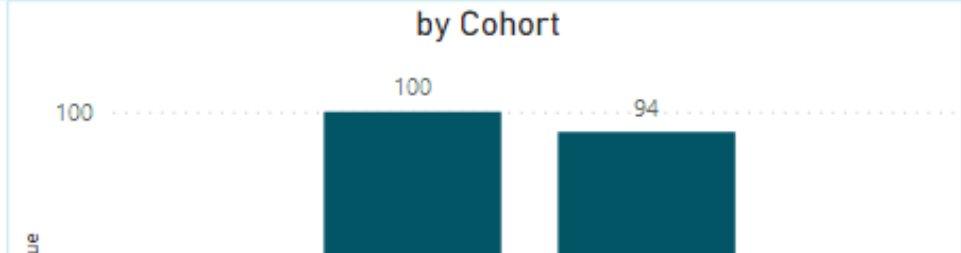
of individuals **gaining access to temporary/casual agricultural labor** 194
