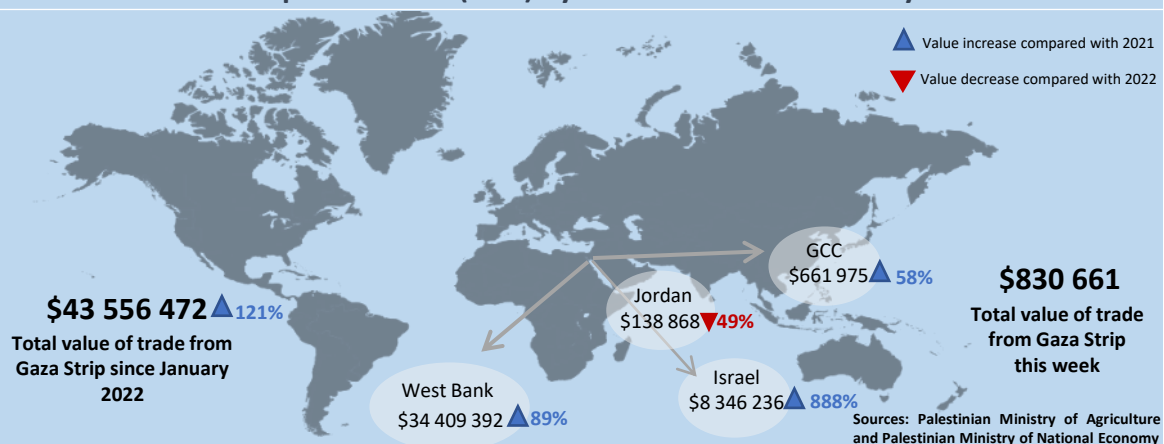


Total exported value (USD) by destination since January 2022



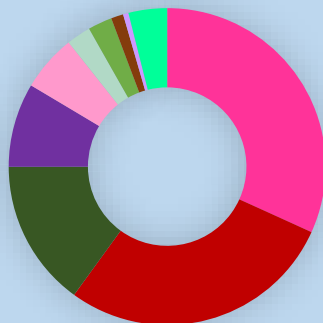

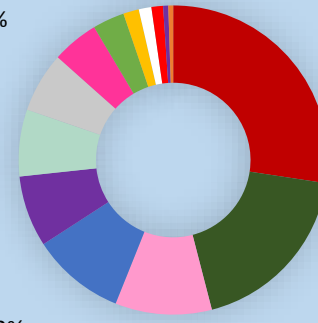

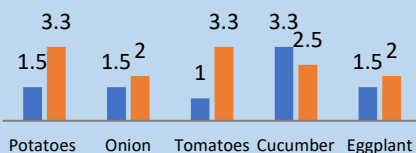

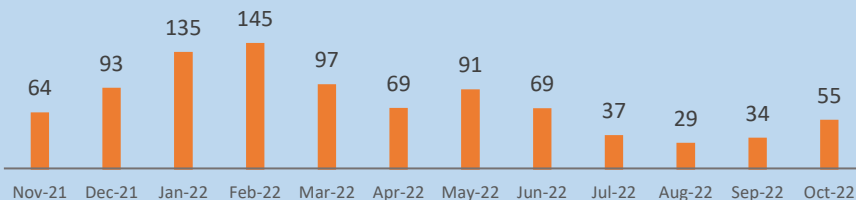


Main crops prices (NIS/KG) this week 2021 vs. 2022

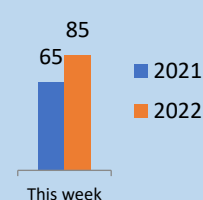

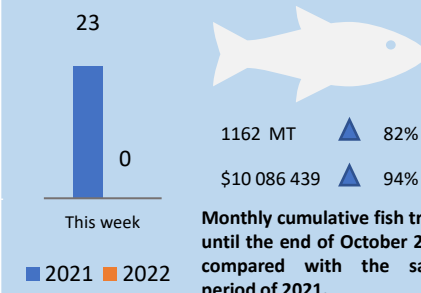
