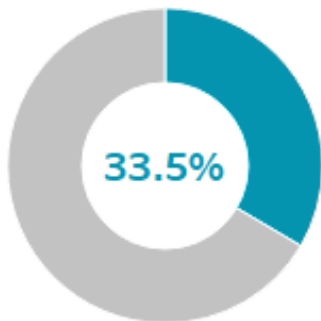

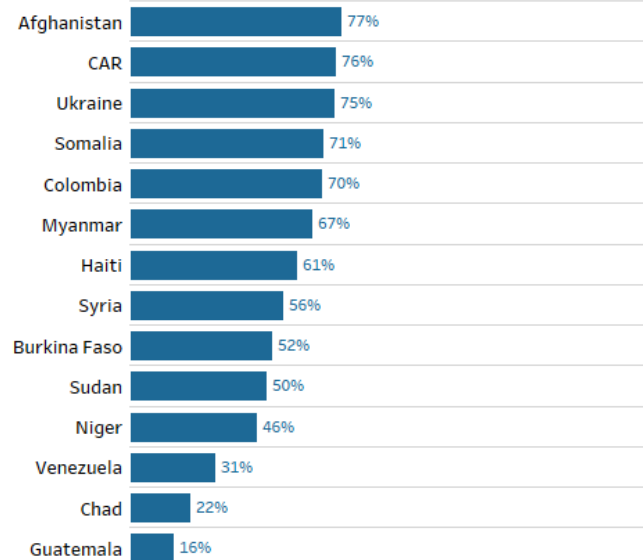

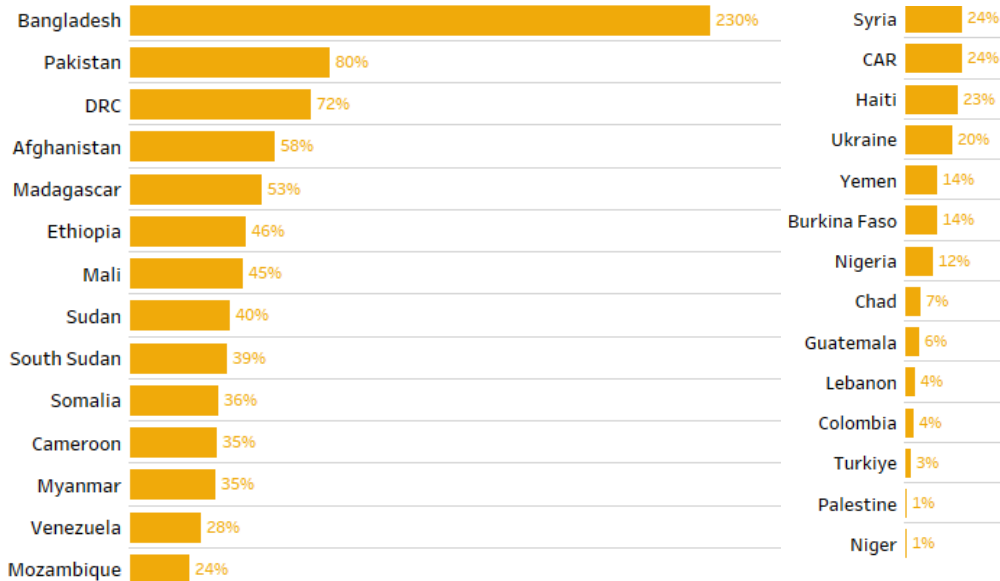

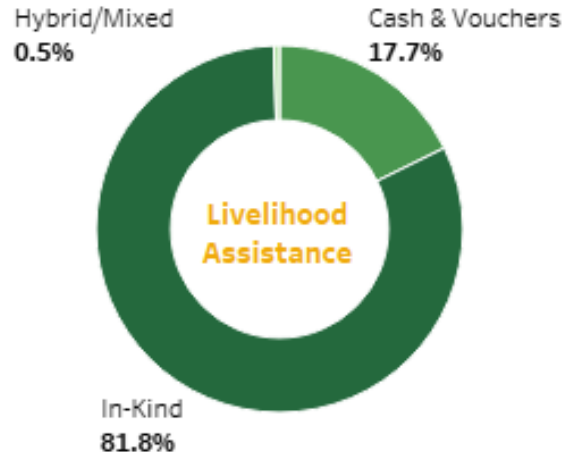


# Overview of Reach by modality

Percent of people reached with Food Assistance by modality

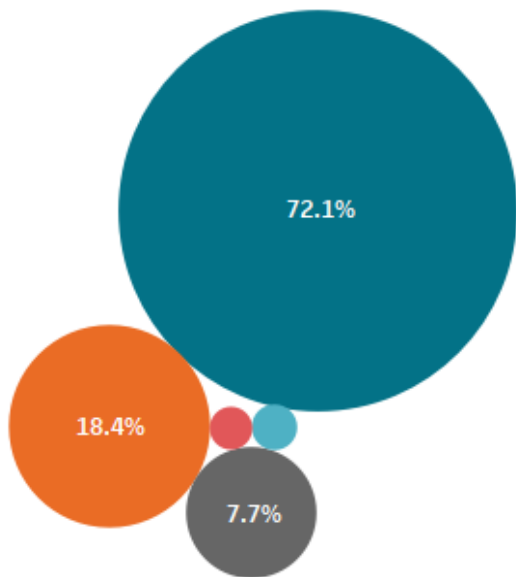


Percent of people reached with Livelihood Assistance by modality

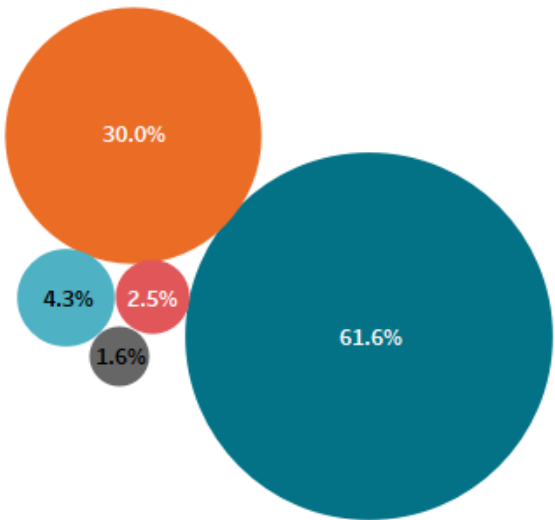

# Joint Intersectoral Analysis Framework (JIAF)

- **Launch and roll out of JIAF 2.0**
- **Prior to launch:** extensive ToT training
- **Over 800 field staff** trained in **22 countries**
- Inter-Agency training complemented by **global clusters' internal trainings**
- JIAF 2.0 implementation in **25 countries** of 26
- **Quality assurance:** OCHA and cluster focal point support line
