






Figure 2 Schematic of the Flood Resilience Measurement for Communities (FRMC) process. Adapted from Laurien and Keating, 2019<sup>2</sup>

## **The Five Capitals**




Human:

#### Financial:

level, variability, and diversity of income sources and access to other financial resources that contribute to wealth





#### Social:

social relationships and networks, bonds aiding cooperative action, links facilitating exchange of and access to ideas and resources Flood Resilience

#### Natural:


the natural resource base, including land productivity and actions to sustain it, as well as water and other resources that sustain livelihoods





#### Physical:

things produced by economic activity from other capital, such as infrastructure, equipment, improvements in crops, livestock, etc.



#### **Our Post Event Review Capability (PERC)**


- A unique forensic methodology






