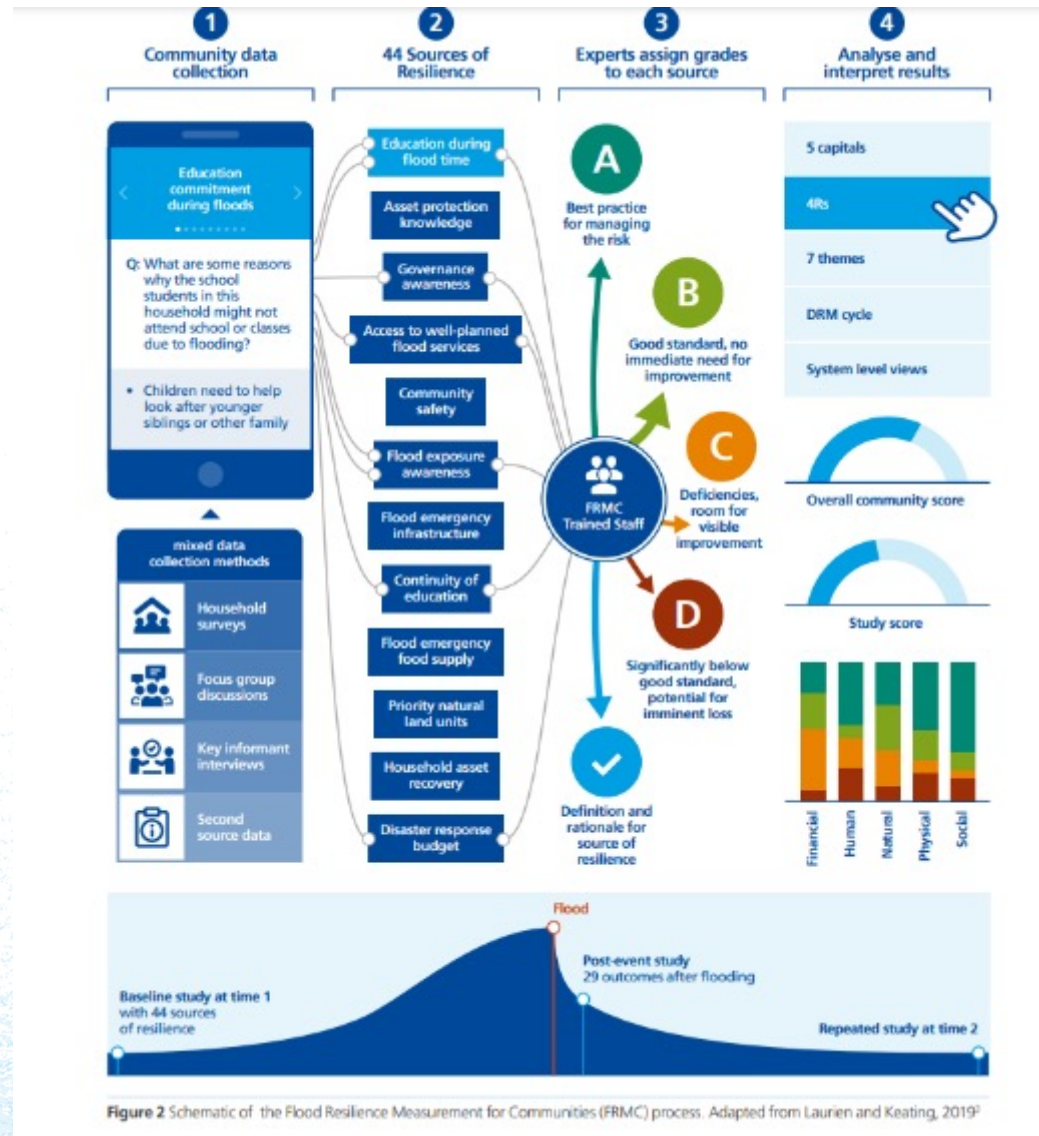
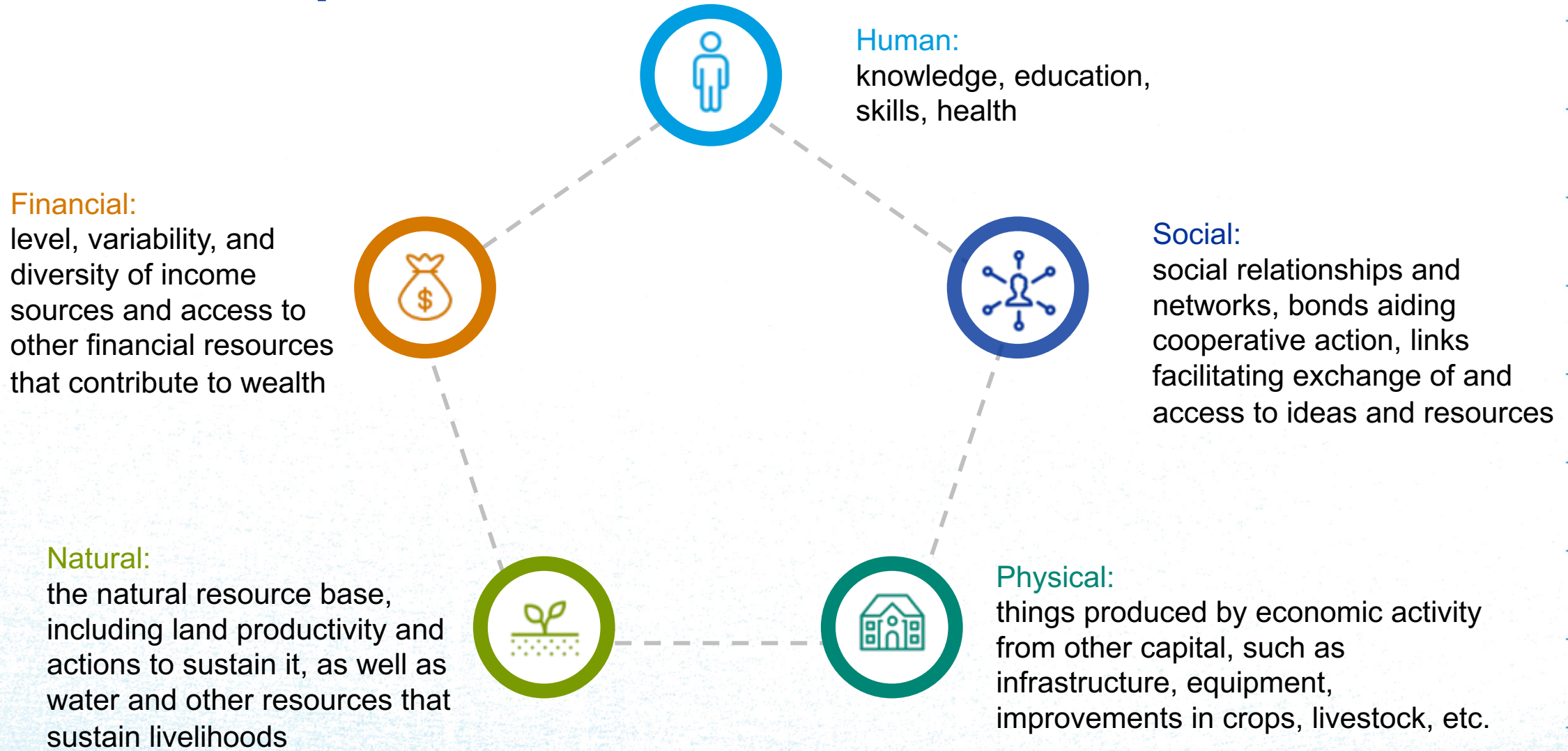


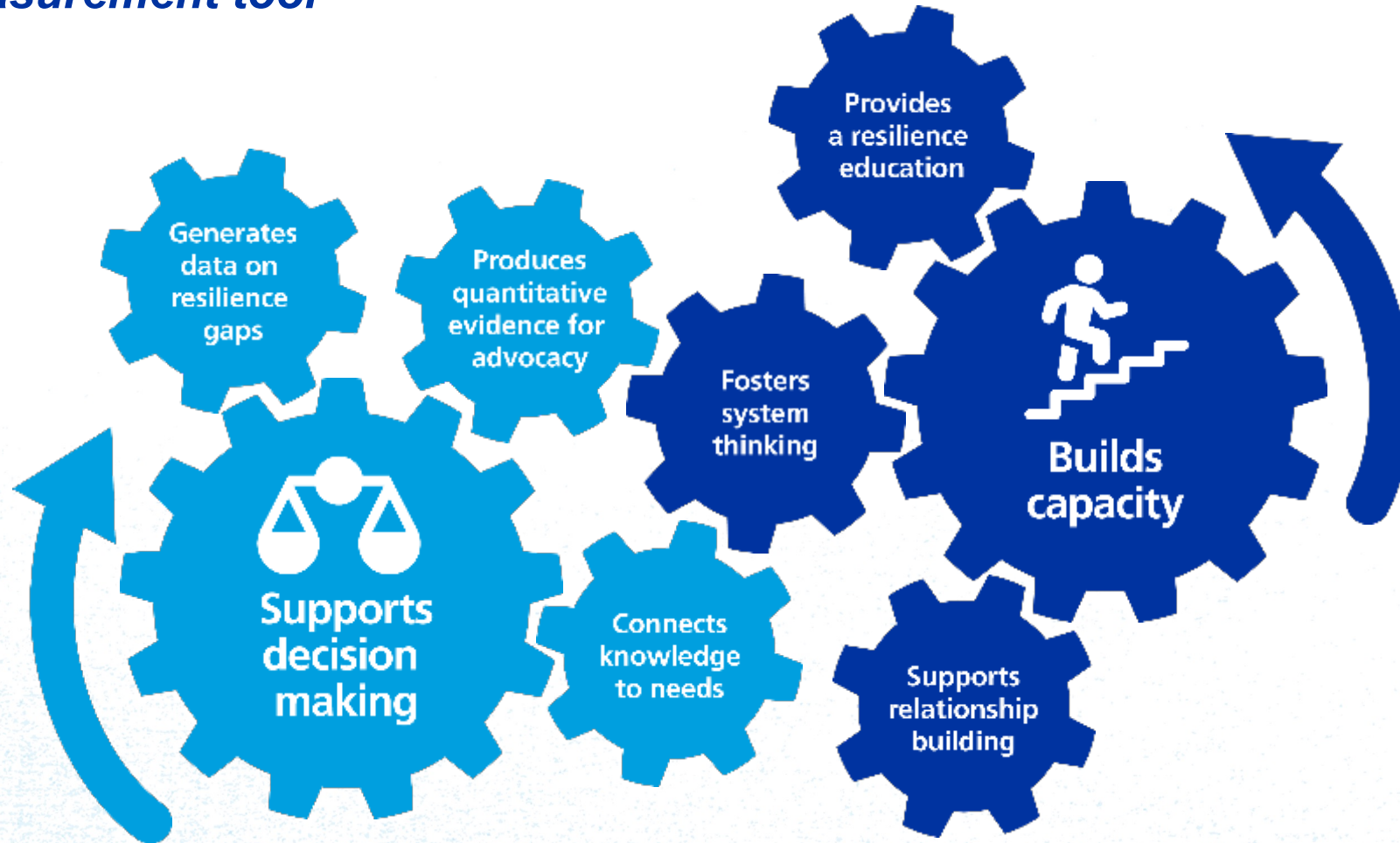
Figure 2 Schematic of the Flood Resilience Measurement for Communities (FRMC) process. Adapted from Laurien and Keating, 2019<sup>9</sup>

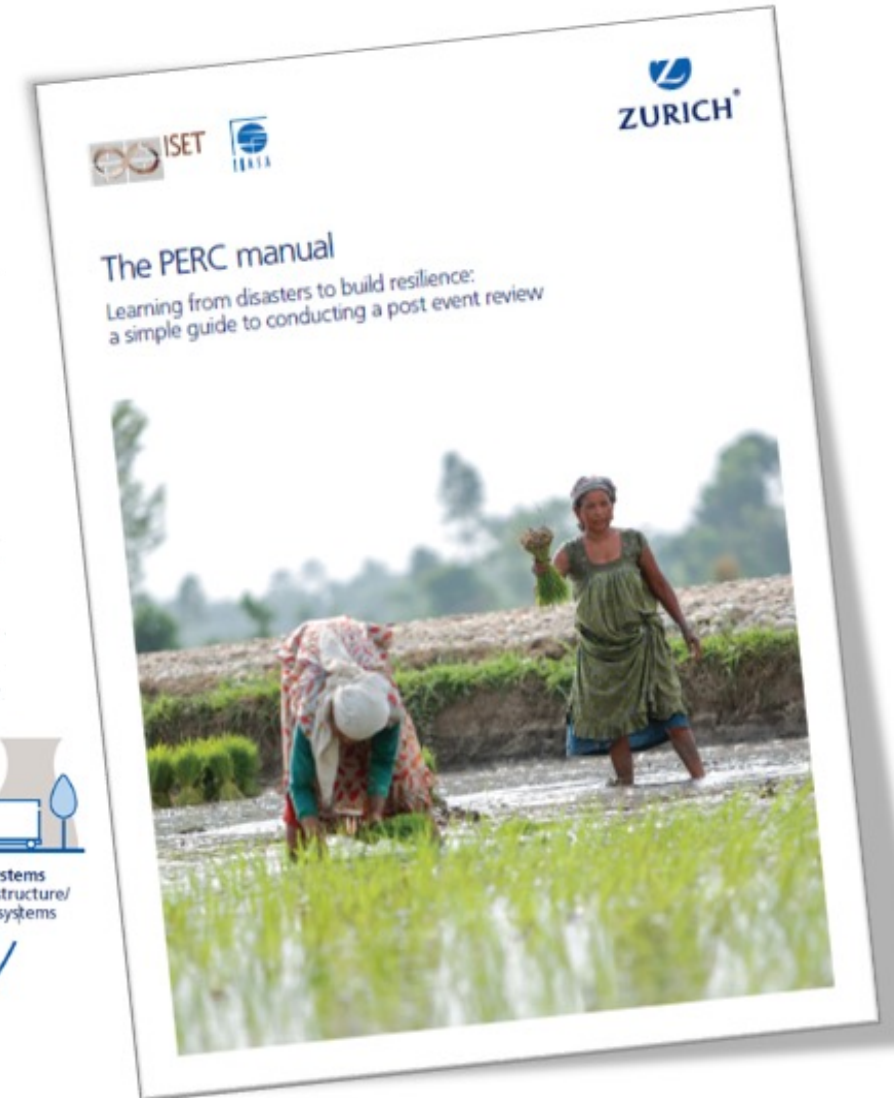
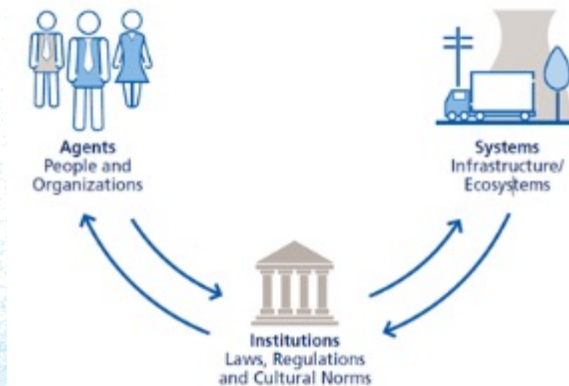


## Our Post Event Review Capability (PERC)

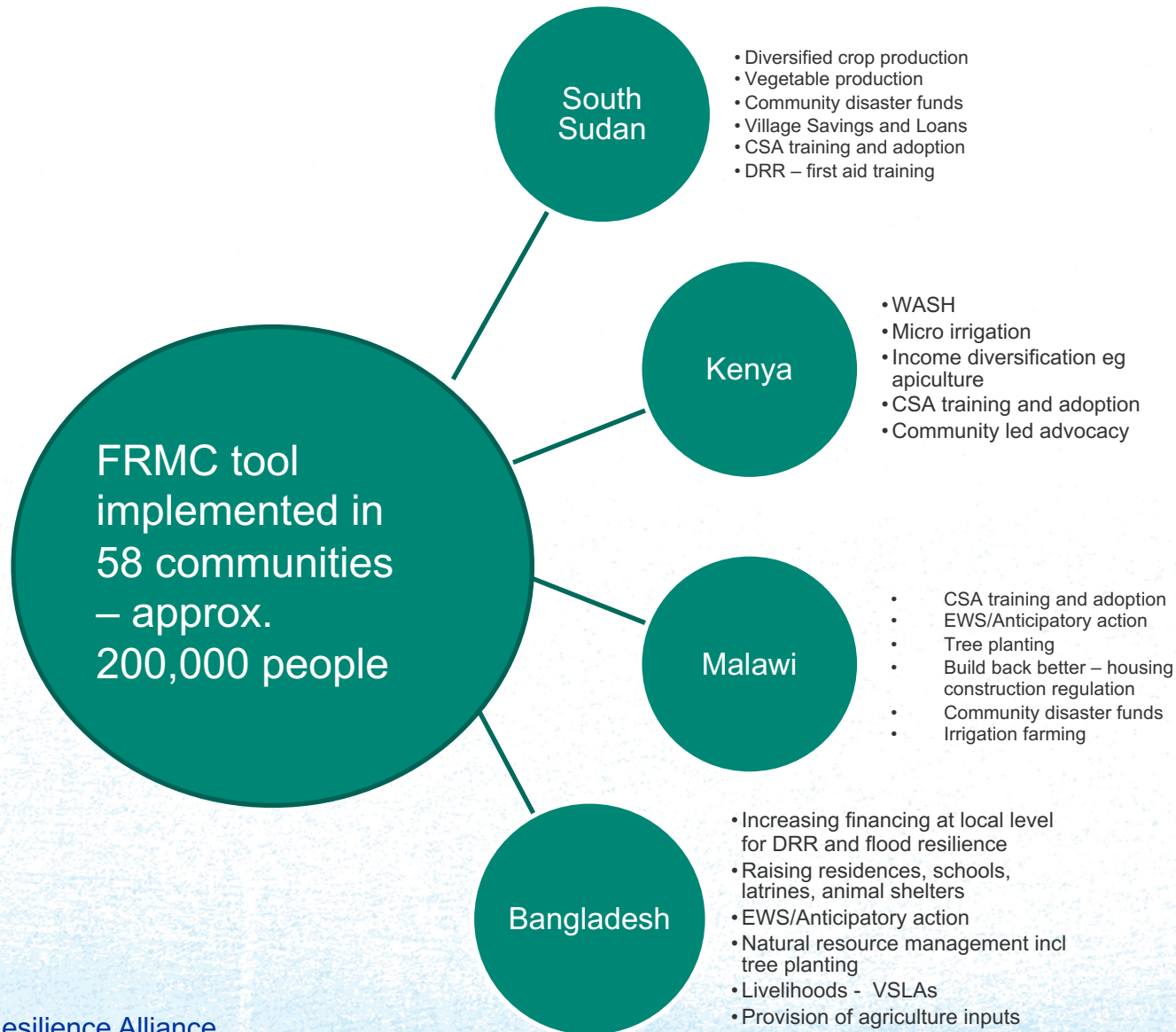
- A unique forensic methodology
