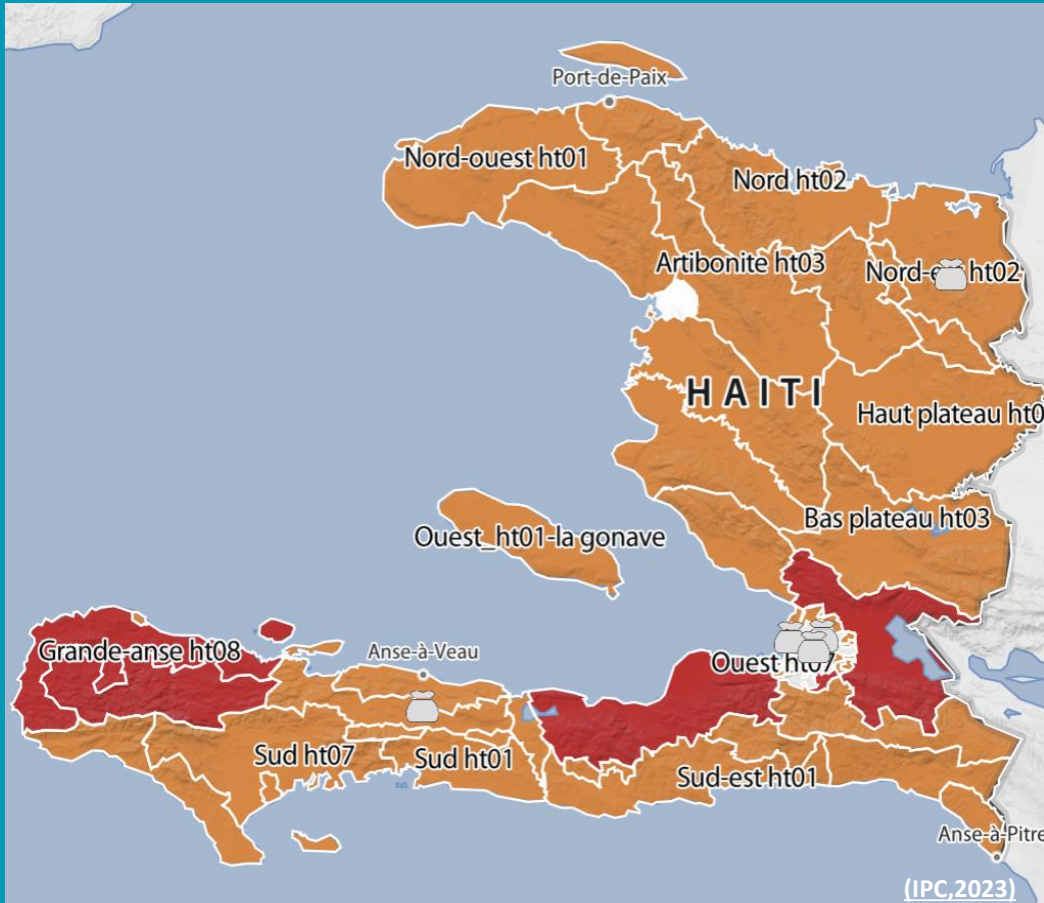

# THE STATE OF FOOD SECURITY IN HAITI

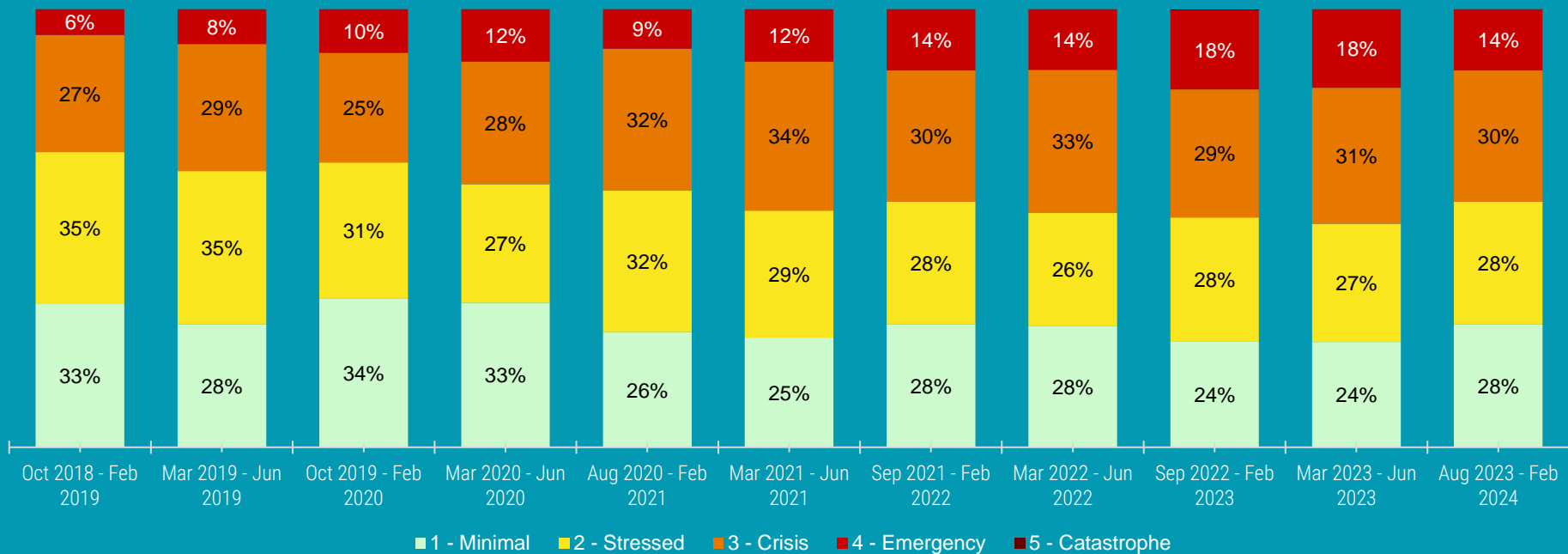


- Over 4.4 million individuals currently in a severe state of food crisis
- Majority of the population is classified within the IPC stages 3-4
- 2024 projections anticipate an increase totaling 45% of the population in need for urgent humanitarian assistance

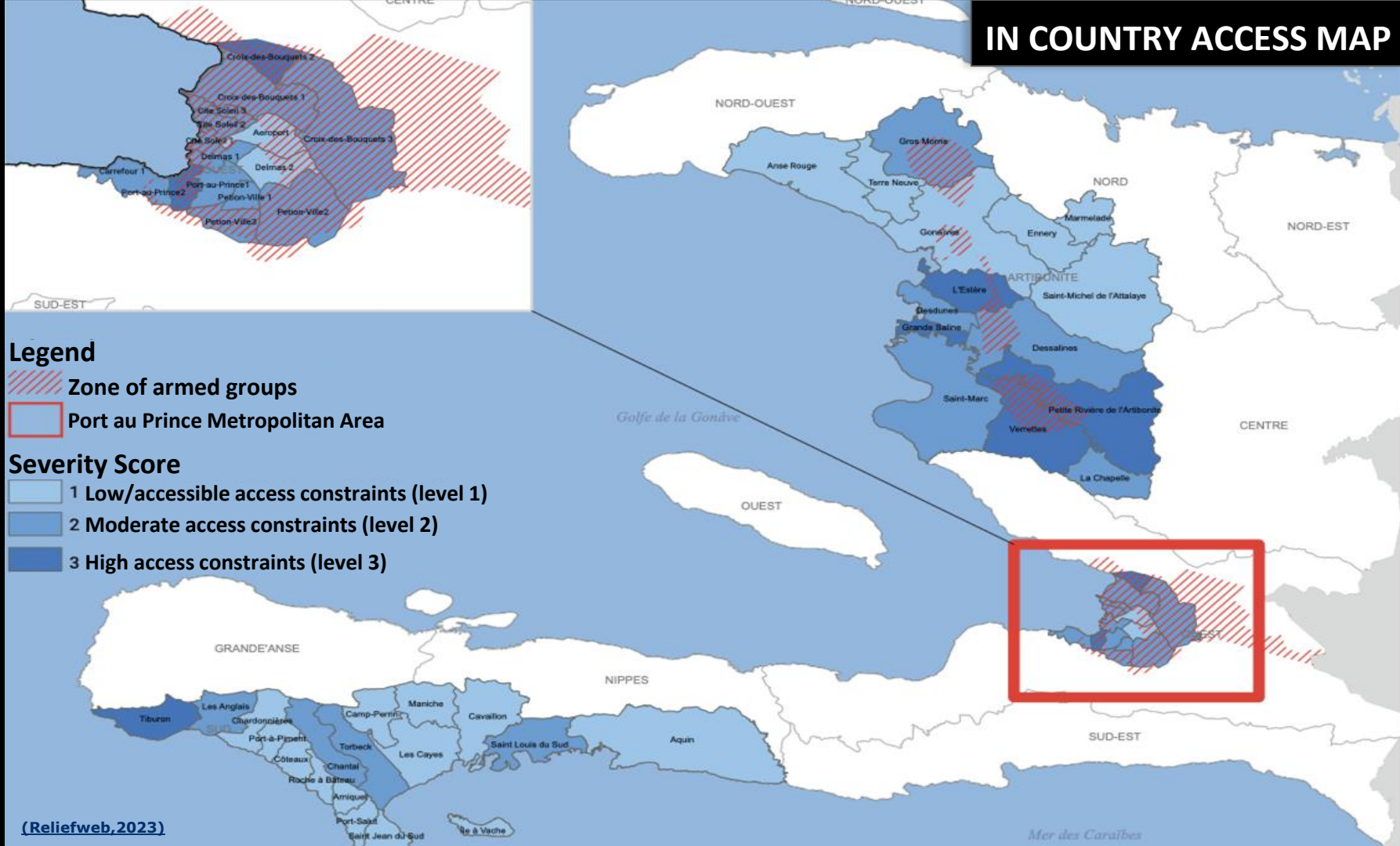

## Haiti Acute Food Insecurity Trends 2018-2024




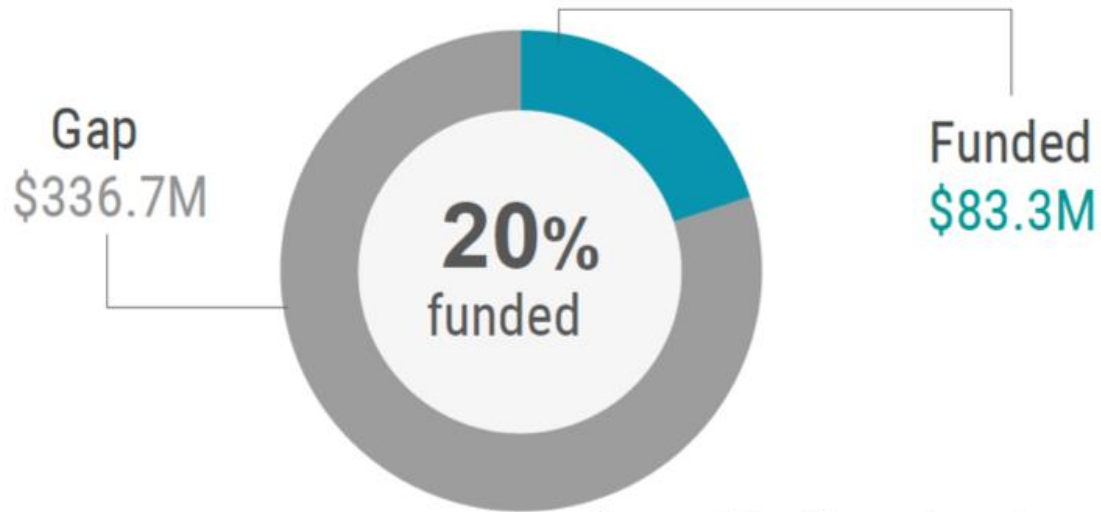

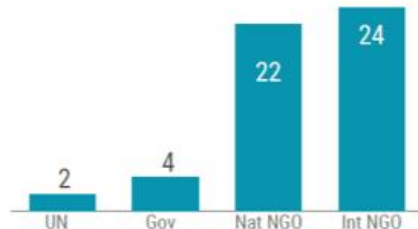
