Flood Response Update – FSC

Flood Response Update – FSC

- 1. Water level in Beletweyne is has been continually decreasing in the past 3 days and it is currently 5.25m which is below moderate risk.
- 2. FAO-SWALIM reported significantly reduced rains in Ethiopian highlands therefore less chances of another flood in Beletweyne.
- 3. 09 partners were able to mobilize emergency assistance for about 234,000 people representing 94% of the flood affected population out of which 53% are one-off assistance.
- 4. About 14,000 people were also affected by the floods in Bulo Burte; WFP, AAH, SCI and FAO are already providing assistance.
- 5. An OCHA-led multi-cluster post-flood assessment is being planned in this week, thanks to FSC partners who have provided support so far.

Programs

- General Food Distribution (Relief Program)
- Project Location: Beledweyn & Mataban Districts
 Hiran Region
- Project Duration: 9 Months
- Target Beneficiaries: 9,355 HHs
- Project Modality: CASH BASED TRANSFER CBT.
- MEB VALUE: 70 DOLLARS PER BENEFCIARY



Programs

- "Baxnano Drought Response: Horizontal Expansion"
- Project Location: Buloburte & Mahas Districts Hiran Region
- Project Duration: 6 Months
- Target Beneficiaries: 1007 HHs
- Project Modality : Mobile Money
- Entitlement: 60\$/Beneficiary payable quarterly for two quarters



Programs

- Safety Net for Human Capital Project "Baxnano"
- Project Location: Buloburte District Hiran Region
- Project Duration: 12 Months
- Target Beneficiaries: 6,077 HHs
- Project Modality : Mobile Money
- Entitlement: 20\$/Beneficiary payable quarterly for four quarters



Achievements

- 5,352 beneficiaries were supported through relief project in Beledweyn and Mataban Districts.
- 1,007 HHs received their entitlements 180\$ for the first quarter in the Baxnano Drought horizontal expansion project in Buloburte and Mahas Districts.
- 6,072 HHs received Q10 transfers 60% through Baxnano project in Buloburte District.
- 300 HHs received emergency cash transfers 100\$/HHs for one month in response to the floods in Beledweyn.
- 6,027 Baxnano HHs received training on financial inclusion and women economic empowerment through mobile money training.



Challenges

- Scope registration related issues.
- IDP gate keepers interference and manipulation.
- Insecurity and accessibility challenges
- Lack and week preparedness of shocks and emergencies
- Limited resilience intervention in Hiran regions



Recommendations

- Comprehensive solutions on duplication issues is must to enable all beneficiaries receive their monthly entitlements
- Government and Humanitarian actors must come strong recommendations to stop gate keepers manipulations.
- Long term resilience programs and productive intervention are best way to minimize the impacts of shocks and emergencies.
