4. Partner updates (response activities, challenges, gaps and 2023 plans)

Islamic Relief

- Micro finance cash distribution to 75 HHs (\$440/HH) in Tuulohiran village of Beledweyn
- Ramadan Cash distribution to 771 HHs (\$85 /HH) for one round in Beledweyn

DAN

- WFP Project: Targeted in Mataban district 1500 HHs received 70\$ per month from January untill March 23'.
- **WFP Project**: targeted in Mahas district 2000 HHs who received 70\$ per month from January untill March 23'.
- WFP project:600 newly registered HHs to supported for unconditional cash transfer at Rate of \$70 in Hawo tako and Bundowayn targeted in 6 IDP in Hawo Tako and Bundoweyn villages under Beletweyne District

Save The Children

- **ECHO Project**: Provision of UCT for 825HHs @ rate of \$100 for 3 months from January —March in Mahas district Hiran region .
- WFP Project: 2259 households targeted in Beledweyne for 38 villages.
- Provision of MMT to 1455 Beneficiaries who received \$70 through in Febroury202
- WFP Project: SCI did top up for 940 Beneficiaries food voucher through top up and redemption of \$70 which they issued the retailer's shop.

 ADSOM Implementing Baxnaano Drought Horizontal Expansion Project funded by WFP Targeted 2569 in Beletweyne district while jalalaqsi district targeted 891 HHs and will Receive 180 for quarterly basis Jan-March).

DRC

 Implementing Segal Project funded by EU the project targeted 3490 PLW in Beletweyne and Jowhar. Beletweyne targeted 1930 PLw while Jowhar targeted 1560 and they will receive \$20 per each month for 20 months from number 2021 Partners to coordinate with the FSC before they start implementation to overcome resource overlap/duplication



• Providing vocational training skills to 730 youth trainees registered form jowhar and Beletweyne. The duration of the training is 8 months form December2022-july 2023 and they will receive \$20 per month.

Mercy USA

- Distribution of relief program assistant to 2953 HHs in Bulo Burte funded by WFP.
- Implementing Baxanaano Project targeted 6077 in Bulo Distirct,
- Implementing Baxnaano Drought Horizontal Expansion Project funded by WFP Targeted 607 in Bul Burte district while Mahas district targeted 400 HHs and will Receive 180 for quarterly basis Jan-March.

SOMRELIEF

- Provision of 4888 HHs for both MMT and Voucher targeted 4 IDPS in Beletweyne district the project funded by WFP.
- Provision of 1649 HHs for IK targeted in Beletweyne District.

 Currently implementing Relief program in Beletweyne caseload of 7562 both CPT and Voucher targeted by 43 IDPs in Beletweyne district the project funded by WFP

Action for Relief

 Targeted 11912 HHs for both MMT and Voucher in Jalalaqsi district from january to March 2023 funded by WFPThe beneficiaries are categorized Nutrition referrals as well as First line response.

HDO

- Distribution of 736 HHs for CPT targeted in Mataban district under WFP project.
- Provision of 500 HHs for IK targeted in mataban District funded by WFP.

Intellectuals for Charity and Development (ICD)

• Provided UCT to 600 households in Beletweyne district with a rate of \$35 per each from September2022 – August 223 the project funded by FOA.

Action Against Hunger

- Planning to target 2625 HHs in Beletweyne district and 350 HHs in Bulo Bulo Burte district who will work Canal rehabilitation and Water catchments through cash for work and they will received 84 Dollar oneoff payment in March2023.
- Planing to distribute Seeds to 3020 HHs in Beletweyne and Bulo district in March2023.

Challenges

 Limited presence of humanitarian agencies as well as funding gap is also one of pressing challenges. Also security assessments is very vital especially the newly liberated areas before delivering lifesaving assistance.



	GAPs Action against Hunger Reported an outbreak of unknown disease along some of the Outlying villages under Beledweyne district (Dusmo, Jawil and Shirkaneco) and the disease affected species of livestock including shoats. Camel The outbreak of the disease not yet established and livestock professionals in Beledweyne not yet confirmed the outbreak of the disease. There are a huge gap for the region and particularly new liberated area, while the government and the humanitarian partners are responding to the needs of the ground by delivering urgent humanitarian assistance to the affected population across the districts.	
5	De-duplication exercise Food Security Cluster coordinator encouraged the partners fill their ongoing response in the 5W Matrix template so that they can be able to see themselves in the mirror during the presentation. It has been noted that some of agencies are doing interventions across the districts but their support didn't include the national food security cluster dashboard.	All Humanitarian Partners
