		which is (Hawotako, Howlwadag, Koshin and Bundowwyn) who will receive three	
		months from August-October 2023.	
	*	SYPD Planning to Rehabilitate canals through CFW for the riverine communities of	
		Macruuf and Dolo Madow, which are in the Beledweyne district. SYPD also plans to	
		distribute seeds to these communities.	
		Challenges, and gaps	
	*	DAN presented that they have met challenge about 10 beneficiaries on the July voucher	
		payment list who do not have Scope cards These beneficiaries were unable to receive	
		their payments due to the lack of Scope cards. DAN is currently working on finding a	
		solution to ensure that these individuals can access their funds in a timely manner as	
		they already communicated information of those beneficiaries with WFP so that they can	
		have their Scope cards before the next cycle Payment.	
	*	COOPI NGO, which is implementing WFP-funded relief projects, stated that there are	
		beneficiaries who were registered in June 2023 and were supposed to receive their	
		entitlement in July, but they are on the approved list shared by WFP, and their voucher	
		cards read no voucher card, as the communicated with WFP.
