

#### 3 FSC Response Overview – March 2023

The Food Security Cluster response for the reporting month of February 2023 was presented by the different strategic objectives and by district. A total of 21 partners collectively assisted about 431K people under SO1 while 5 partners assisted 55K people under SO2. Areas of gap and/or overreach were also highlighted and the FSC Coordinator requested partners to support in newly liberated areas.






## 4 Weather Forecast and Floods Update in Hirshabelle State – FAO SWALIM

SWALIM team presented the current weather forecast and rainfall conditions for Hirshabelle State also highlighting evolving flood events that have occurred in both Beletweyne and Jowhar districts.

FSC to share FAO SWALIM's presentation.



- The rainfall forecast for the next three days (8<sup>th</sup> 10<sup>th</sup> May) indicates light cumulative rain of about 10 mm over isolated areas in Hirshabelle (Map 1)
- Rains of similar amounts (about 20 mm) are expected over Shebelle River catchment in the Ethiopian Highlands
- Although Shabelle River at Belet Weyne is bankful with a high risk of flooding currently,
- ... river levels are expected to stabilize below moderate flood risk levels in the coming days given the above light to moderate forecast rainfall conditions.

# 5 Floods Preparedness and Update – FSC

The FSC Coordinator presented the recent updates regarding the floods in Beletweyne and across the Shabelle river in Hirshabelle State.

- Floodings have occurred in Beletweyne Town as of yesterday due to spill over from the river channel.
- FAO SWALIM weather forecast indicates low rainfall across Hirshabelle State between 3-9 May 2023.
- However, the Shabelle River level has been on the rise again since 28th April due to the heavy rainfalls received in Ethiopian highlands.
- River levels in Beletweyne in Beletweyne this morning is at bank full (8.3m) and about 15 riverine communities have been displaced.
- A government-led flood impact assessment will be conducted on 10th and 11th May.

FSC to share consolidated partners' flood response plan



- 20 FSC partners will join the assessment team with 10 vehicles contributed by their organizations.
- FSC partners are urged to kindly provide urgent mitigation measures (e.g sandbags, inlet/outlet rehabilitation) to prevent further floods into Beletweyne Town

The Cluster has also been engaging with partners to consolidate available resources and plans to respond to the flood emergency, while partners have started to stock food items, high energy biscuits and cash/voucher assistance, other partners have also been supporting through resilience based activities like canal rehabilitation, distribution of sandbags to close-up some breakages along the river. Below is the consolidated preparedness and is being updated as more partners are able to mobilize resources to respond.

## 6 OPZ geo-coordination and partner plans Q2

The FSC Coordinator presented an update regarding the OPZ planning which allows for better coordination and understanding gaps and overlaps, this process will involve a series of joint meetings with partners who shared plans to be in the same OPZ location. Coordination meetings will be held to seek solutions for deduplication to maximize the limited resources available to partners.

#### Why OPZ Mapping?

- Improve local coordination and partner engagement.
- Minimize duplication of resources.
- More realistic gap analysis and presence mapping.
- Improved resource allocation and fair distribution of humanitarian assistance.
- Monitor and predict partner performance to easily identify areas in need of attention and advocacy.
