
The May meeting minutes was then adopted and validated.

3 FSC Response Overview – April 2023

The Food Security Cluster response for the reporting month of April 2023 was presented by the different strategic objectives and by district. A total of 17 partners collectively assisted about 216K people under SO1 while 6 partners assisted 90K people under SO2. Areas of gap and/or overreach were also highlighted and the FSC Coordinator requested partners to support in newly liberated areas.

4 Weather Forecast and Floods Update in Hirshabelle State – FAO SWALIM

SWALIM team presented the current weather forecast and rainfall conditions for Hirshabelle State also highlighting evolving flood events that have occurred in both Beletweyne and Jowhar districts.

Rainfall Forecast for 6 – 13 June 2023:


- Moderate rainfall was expected over southern coastal regions with light rains likely over some areas in the North.
- Dry conditions were forecast over much of Hiraan (light rains of less than 20 mm over northern parts of Belet Weyne District.
- Light rains of about 30 mm were expected over some areas in Middle Shabelle region.

Rainfall Forecast for 12 - 18 June 2023:

Dry conditions are forecast over the entire country.

5 WFP Response and Planning in Hirshabelle State – WFP

WFP gave a presentation on their current response and planning of activities in Hirshabelle State, highlighting key achievements and challenges. Below are some of the key notes of the speaker.

Emergency Relief Programme

- WFP is operating in all the districts of Hirshabelle State.
- WFP has 08 implementing partners (04 international NGOs and 04 National NGOs)
- WFP is currently providing life-saving humanitarian assistance to 291,888 people across the state, most of the response is provided through cash and voucher with only about 34,740 people assisted through in-Kind modality.

Baxnaano Drought Horizontal Expansion Project

- This project was initially developed to respond to the drought however this has been redesigned to meet other priority areas within the state.
- The project targets 59,772 people across 06 districts; Jowhar, Balcad, Cadale, Beletweyne, Bulo Burte and Jalalqsi.
- Government and community engagement, beneficiary registration have all been completed for this project.
