FAO's context-sensitive programming approach

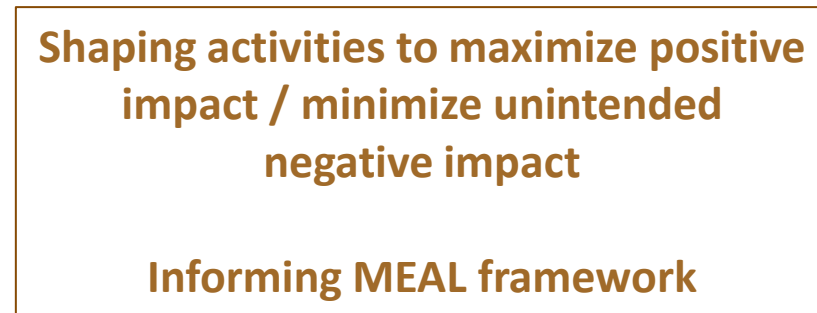

Context-sensitive programming requires:

1. Understanding the interaction between the local context and FAO projects;
2. Incorporating this understanding into the projects' life-cycle; and
3. Orienting activities towards the reduction of potentially negative impacts in the community, while accentuating the positive ones.

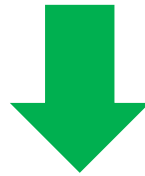
FAO's context-sensitive programming approach

- Programme Clinic to develop context-sensitive programming recommendations to the identified issues



- Survey process to understand food security and agriculture sector related dynamics in project implementation areas
- Specific focus also on direct support project components (e.g. cash interventions, vouchers, agricultural inputs, etc.)
