Partner Updates (Flood preparedness, challenges and gaps)

Islamic Relief

- 100 people will work for flood barrier construction through Cash For Work (CFW) for two months in Balcad, and the process is under procurement and will be started/conducted in April and May 2023.
- 12 main or primary canals are to be rehabilitated in Balcad area, thus will reduce the high flow of the river and the process is under procurement and will be started/conducted in April and May 2023.

Solution For Humanitarian

SHF is planning to conduct Rapid Assessment to Jowhar and Balcad, and after assessment will do a response accordingly.

Aid Vision

Team from Aid Vision is on the ground to assess the primary needs to the flood affected area/villages of Buurfule nad Raqeyle villages of Jowhar, and Aid Vision will provide 1,000 empty bags to Raqeyle and Burfule villagers for strengthening the closure of creak points where the river water is coming out.

ORDO sent a team to the flood affected areas to assess the damage of the flooding. On other hand ORDO provided 1,000 empty bags to Raqele and Burfule villagers to help close the breakage of the river and prevent the flooding.

OCHA

According to the information received from flood affected areas, there are people who left their homes due to the flooding impacts, and these people are now living with their relatives on the high ground areas. These people are without shelter and other basic needs. Partners are encouraged to focus on supporting these flooded families. There is a need of Inter Cluster assessment to the affected areas raised by OCHA, and they had area humanitarian coordination meeting to know the situation. Before going with this assessment OCHA is planning to reach Hirshabelle state level and Middle Shabelle regional administration to discuss how this assessment can go ahead.

OCHA also confirmed that there are two additional villages under Mahaday district affected by the floods, these two villages are called Kulmis and Calaag. Both villages were affected in the settlements and farming lands.

Hirshabelle FSC Coordinator:

As FSC, we are on standby with all standardized assessment tools, once confirmed, we are ready to share with FSC assessment documents. And Also inform you that there are partners in Middle Shabelle who are ready to join in the assessment waiting your outcomes with meetings.

4 Flood alert updates in Middle Shabelle – FAO SWALIM

Rainfall and Flood Update in Jowhar and Somalia in General

Last week weather:

- Several parts of the country received moderate to heavy rains during the second half of March making as an early start of GU long rainy season in Somalia.
- Jowhar station has recorded 48.5 mm of rainfall during last two weeks of march.

Forecast:

Moderate to light rainfall is predicted over Middle Shabelle region from 4 -

11 April

- Currently river level along Shabelle are moderate/average for this period over the year with low risk of flooding
- Levels along the Shabelle river is expected to raise in the coming days or weeks given the ongoing rains within Ethiopian highlands.
- As late March, 62 breakage points have been identified in Shabelle and Juba rivers which pose great risk of flooding.

Jowhar Flood Update

- On 1st April around, river Shabelle flooded at Raqeyle village which 8 km to southeastern of Jowhar, there are other two villages named Burfulle and Bulo Ahmed which are also flooded as the report indicates. The flood has affected farms destroying the growing crops. The river level has subsequently droped down from 4.85m to 4.30m.
- FAO, SWALIM are following the developments keenly and promised will keep updated.
