1. "Best practice on Strengthening Seed Systems – 6 varieties of Sorghum through Crop Adaptive Trials" – Abrham Agilo (WVSS)

WVI South Sudan shared its experience on seed system development in collaboration with MAFs through crop adaptive trials (CATs) and seed multiplication (SM) program. CATs carried out in eight counties using improved varieties of sorghum, pearl millets and sesame. Seed multiplication approach was done through training producer groups, providing technical support, constructing seed storage on cost sharing basis and facilitating market linkages. The program achieved to release six varieties of sorghum, increase in production including capacity building as well as expansion of the program to other areas. <u>Presentation</u>

2. FSNMS Round 28 Planning – Bakri Osman (VAM Unit, WFP)

WFP, FAO and Unicef with continue the FSNMS survey as in the past without the plus (+) part. Preparation going on, data collection will start on 1 July – 15 September 2022. Face to face training will be conducted for enumerators and ToT.

3. Agriculture Extension Services & Annual Training Calendar – Morris Tabiano (FAO)

Sharing of series of ToT Trainings to be conducted during Agricultural Technical Working Group (ATWG) meetings from June to December 2022. The trainings are intended to enhancing knowledge and skills, changing attitude and transfer of knowledge. The training needs were identified through the survey conducted in September 2022. - Updates from Information Management FSLC CO1 (Food Assistance) and CO2 (Livelihoods Support) dashboards presented that show food and livelihood responses from January to April 2022. Gaps in food assistance and livelihood support noted in the first quarter at the county level.
