This map indicates the Non-HRP areas where FSC partners supported acute food insecure people on Food assistance, livelihoods and agriculture inputs.

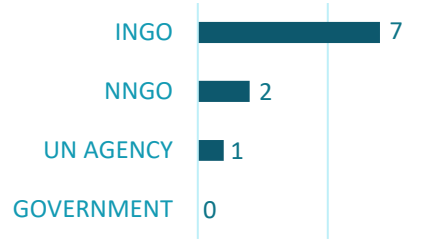
FSL partners supported affected communities by Cyclone Eloise in Sofala and Manica province, COVID19 response in Tete and Refugees in Nampula.

FSL Partners provided food and agriculture inputs through In-kind, voucher, cash transfer modalities and service delivery/support.

4 Lead organizations reported assistance, where WFP was the leader with the highest beneficiaries reached, followed by Tzu Chi Foundation, ADRA and Action Aid.

The information is based on the FSC 5W matrix, hence it reflects only the activities of the organizations that have agreed to share their 5W info with the cluster.

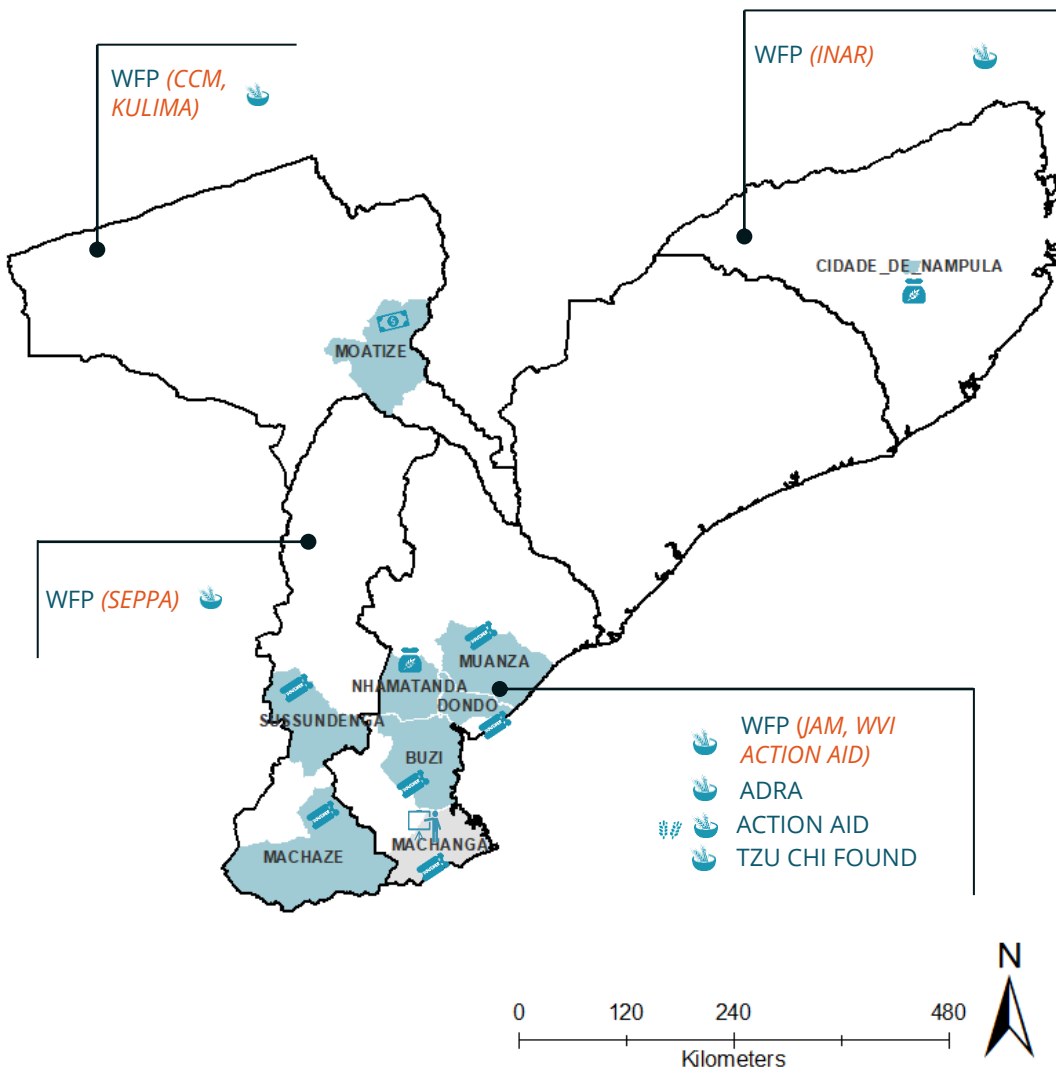
Partners by type of organization










