

In June 2023, the food security sector assisted around 2.1 million people with food assistance and around 142 thousand people with agriculture and livelihoods, of which 66 percent (1,394,497) and 28 percent (40,539) respectively received support, through cash voucher assistance (CVA). A total of 24 organizations, national, and international non-governmental organizations, and UN agencies used various delivery mechanisms such as cash payments, mobile money transfers, paper vouchers, and electronic vouchers. Borno state hosts 75 percent of the CVA beneficiaries, with Yobe state hosting 24 percent and Adamawa state has 1 percent.

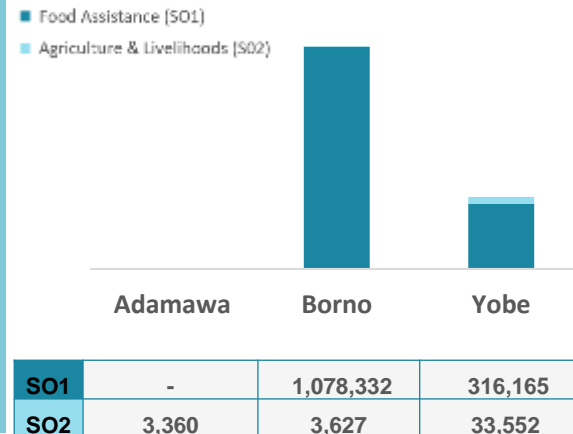

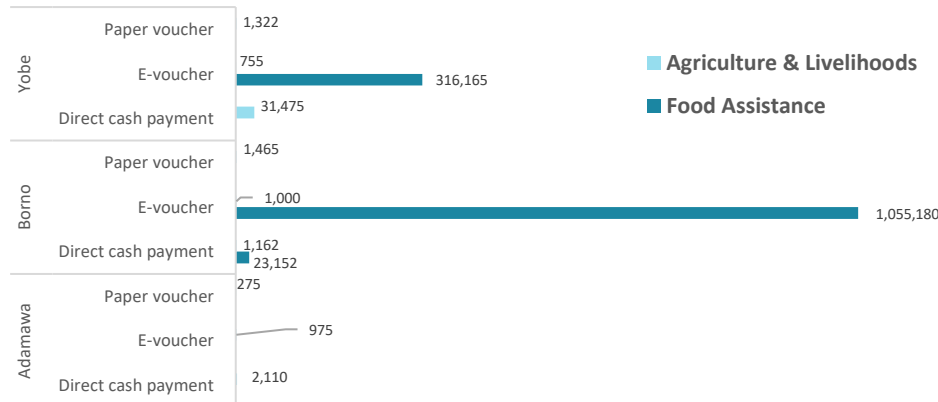

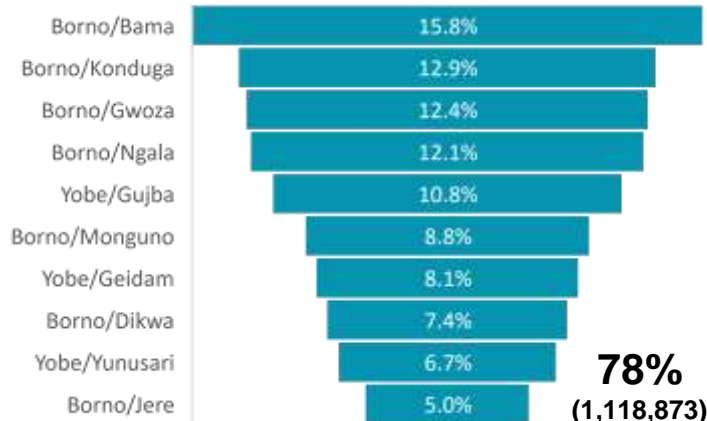
Cash & Voucher Assistance at State Level
