

In October 2022, the food security sector assisted 1.7 million people with food assistance and 1 million people with agriculture and livelihoods, of which 67 percent (1,129,879) and 15 percent (153,252) respectively received support, through cash voucher assistance (CVA). A total of 31 organizations, national, and international non-governmental organizations, and UN agencies used various delivery mechanisms such as cash payments, mobile money transfers, paper vouchers, and electronic vouchers. Borno state hosts 91 percent of the CVA beneficiaries, with Yobe state hosting 7 percent and Adamawa state 2 percent.

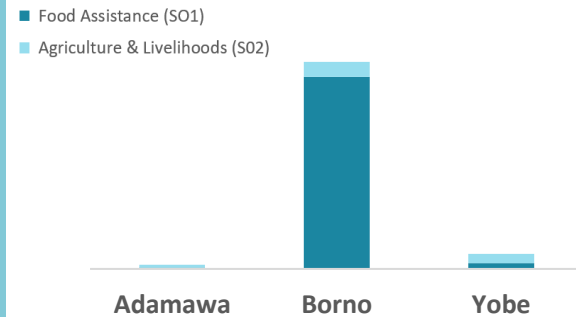

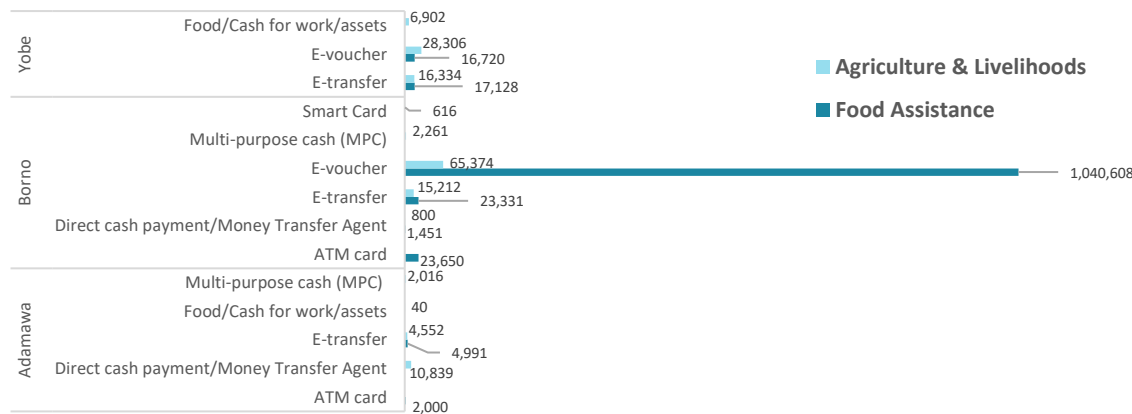

### Cash & Voucher Assistance at State Level

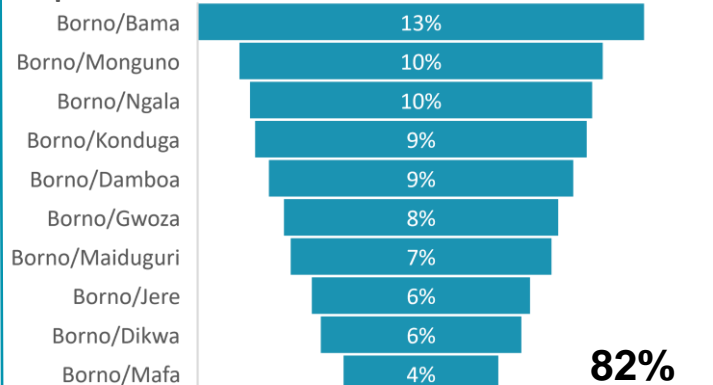

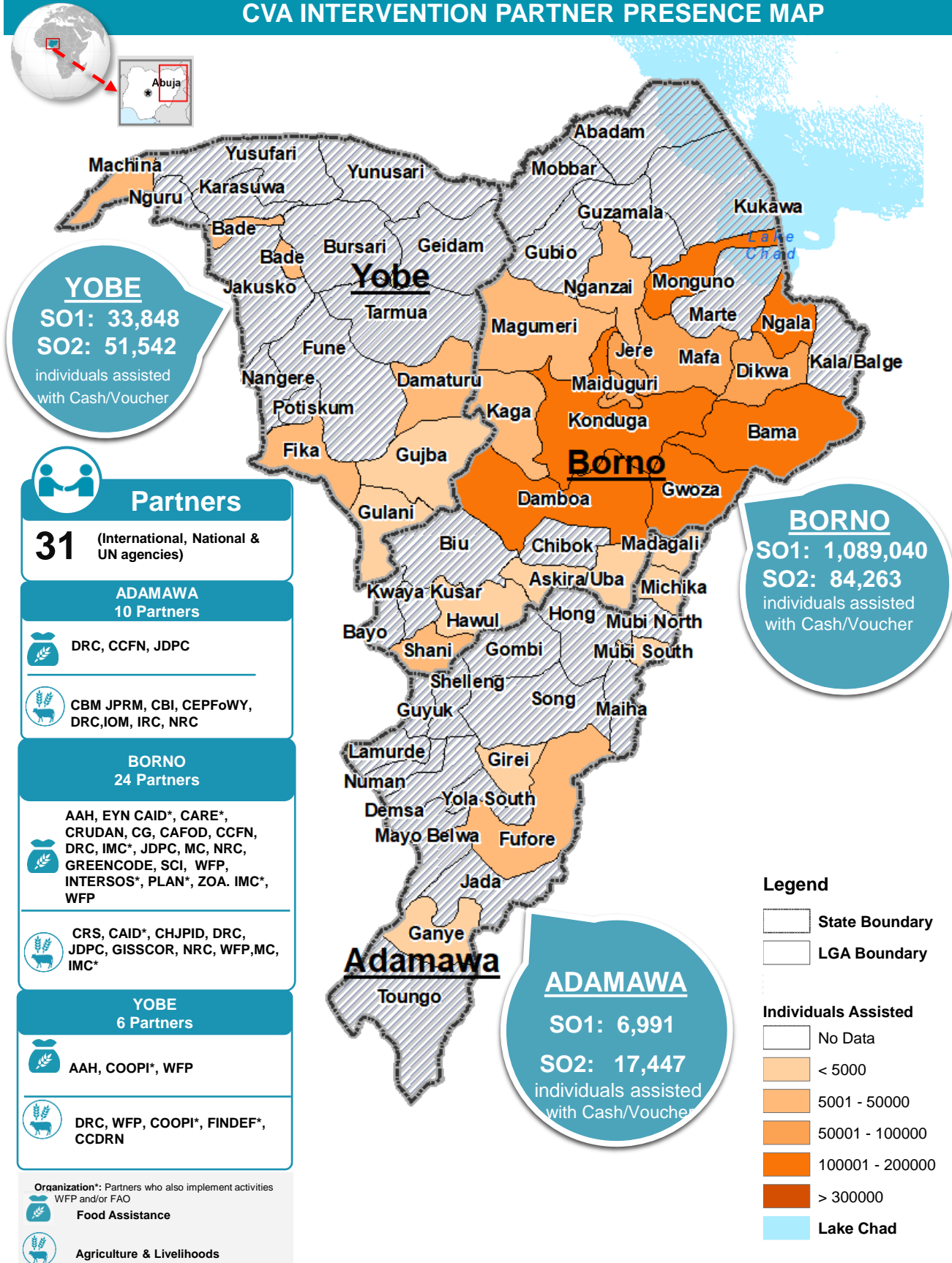
