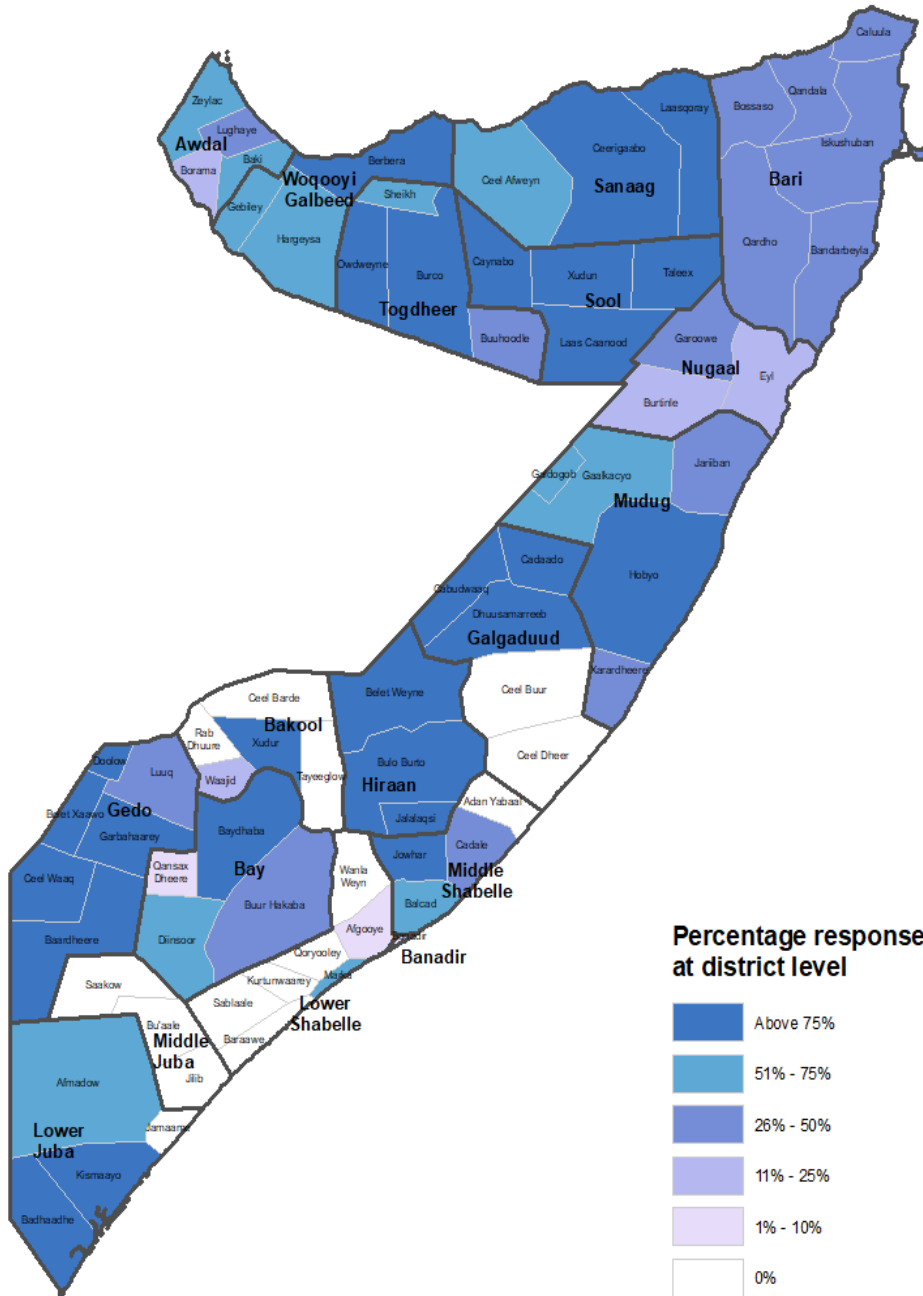
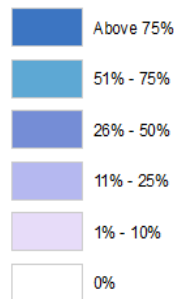


NUMBER OF BENEFICIARIES TARGETED VS ASSISTED BY DISTRICT

Strategic objective 1 update



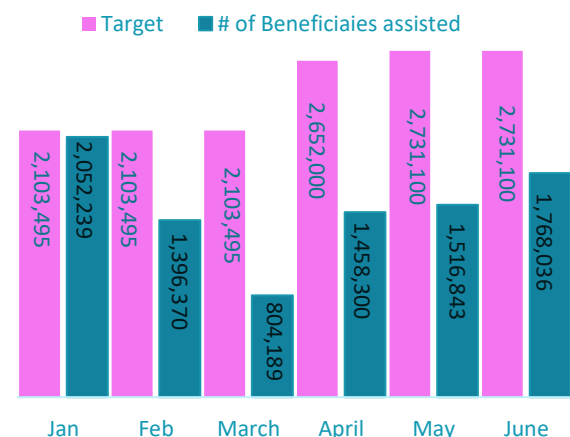
In June, WFP responses constituted 79%, CARE 7%, ACTED 4%, FAO, WVI & ACF contributed 2% each, and the remaining 3% was provided by NRC, DRC, Candlelight, SOS, SIF, CPD, IRC, AADSOM, CESVI, WHH, CODHNET, Mercy corps and ADO combined.

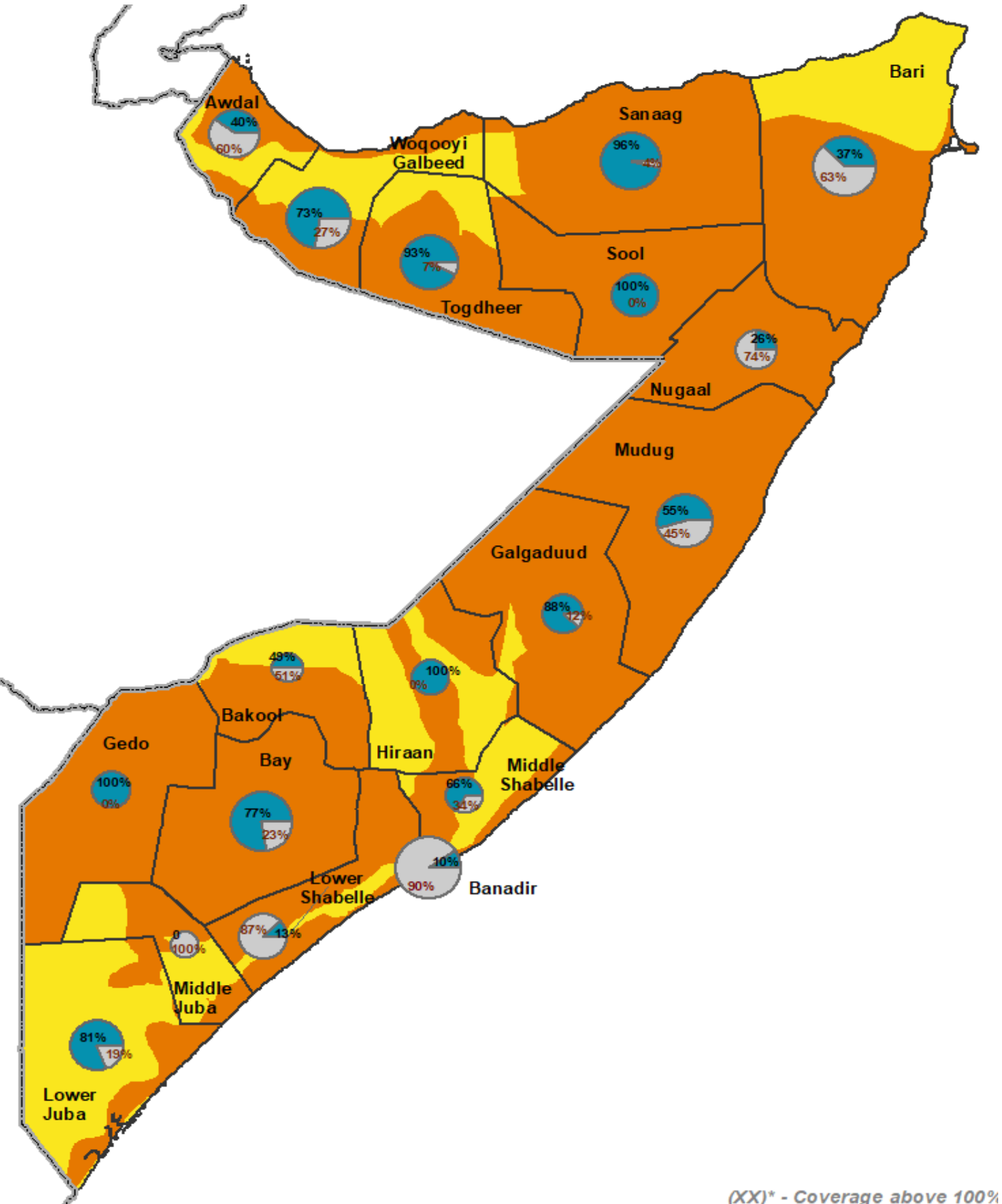
Responses in Banadir, Lower Shabelle, Middle Juba and Nugaal are less than 30% of the target. Over 1 million people are excluded from assistance due to funding shortfalls. Notably, people assisted with unconditional transfers are mostly those in IPC 3 or worse who experience significant consumption gaps.

Under objective 1 (Improving Access to Food through Conditional and Unconditional Transfers (Cash, Vouchers and In-Kind), FSC partners assisted 1,768,036 people out of 2,731,100 targeted (65% achievement).

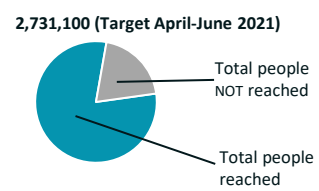
Monthly response Jan-June 2021: Beneficiaries assisted
