Area/population coverage

- Rohingya
 - 3,600 HH in Cox's bazar
 - 370 HH in Bhasan char
- Host communities
 - 1,200 HH in Cox's Bazar Sadar, Ramu, Chakaria, Ukhia, Teknaf, Maheshkhali, Kutubdia, Pekua

Modules to cover

- Demographics (inc disability)
- Food security
 - Food consumption
 - Coping strategies
- Access to basic services /sectoral needs
- Assets
- Social safety nets/ Assistance
- Adaptive capacity
 - Skill and training
- Income/expenditure
 - Production
- Shocks
