




FOOD DISPATCH AND DISTRIBUTION AS OF 08 FEBRUARY 2023



Since mid-November 2022 when humanitarian food supplies resumed to enter Tigray, more than 132,800 MT of food has been brought into the region as of 14 February; and around 80,977 MT of food has been distributed to 4,628,611 people.

- Between 02 08 February, a total of 298,001 people were assisted with 5,068 MT of food 56,294 people with 954 MT of food under Round 3 and 241,707 people with 4,114 MT of food under Round 2.
- During the month of January 2023, around 2.3 million people received food assistance in the region.

Although the humanitarian space continues to improve in Tigray, some woredas (for instance, Egela (Central), Erob and Gulo Mekeda (Eastern); Dima, May Tsebri town, Tahtay Adiyabo and Tselemti (North Western) remain partially inaccessible with access to/from some pocket areas continuing to be challenging for partners and communities due to armed actors' presence and movements in contested areas along the international and regional borders. In newly accessible areas, partners are working to rehabilitate the food distribution and storage facilities that were destroyed during the conflict so that communities can receive their food closer to home without taking risks and traveling long distance to alternative food distribution points.
