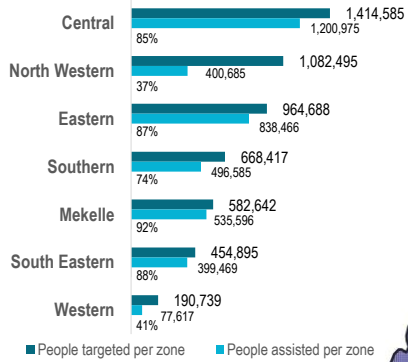


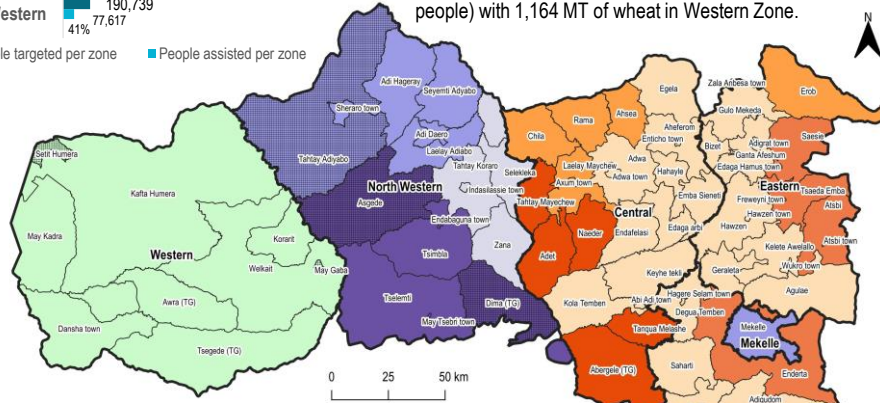
## FOUR MILLION PEOPLE ASSISTED SINCE LATE DECEMBER 2022

5.4 million people targeted for Round 3



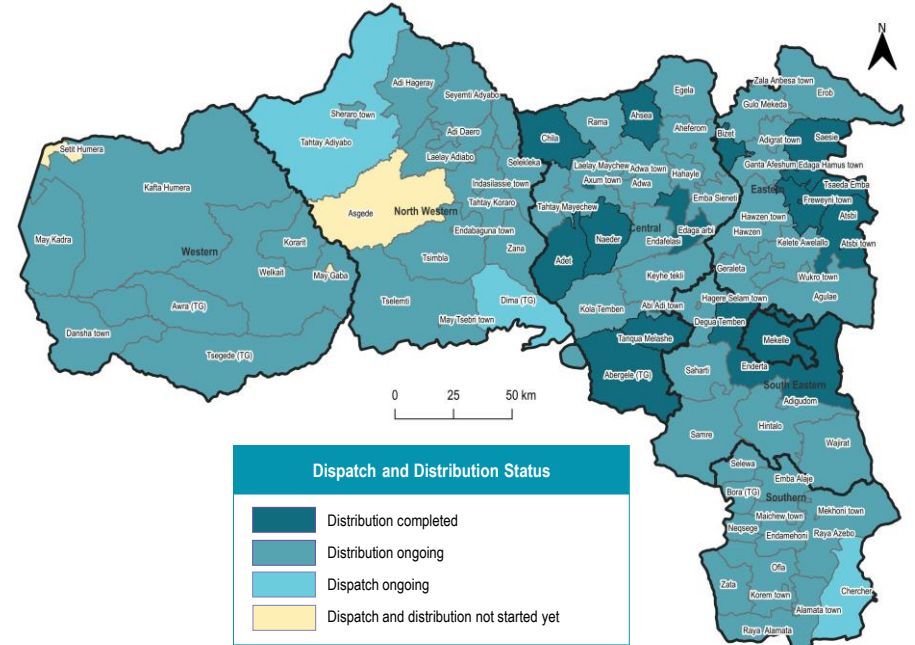
During Round 3 distribution of 2022, which was launched in late December 2022, partners have assisted 3,949,393 people (73% of the total planned caseload of 5.4 million people for the region, including Western Zone) with 66,720 MT of food as of 08 March. Out of the four million assisted, more than 314,000 people are IDPs.

Among the main partners, JEOP partners assisted 2,696,333 people (87% of its planned caseload of 3.1 million people) with 45,703 MT of food; WFP and its partners assisted 1,175,443 people (56% of its planned caseload of 2.1 million people) with 19,853 MT of food; and it was reported that EDRMC assisted 77,617 people (41% of its planned caseload of 0.2 million people) with 1,164 MT of wheat in Western Zone.

## FOOD DISPATCH AND DISTRIBUTION AS OF 08 MARCH 2023

Since mid-November 2022 when humanitarian food supplies resumed to enter Tigray, more than 166,000 MT of food has been brought into the region as of 16 March; and around 138,000 MT of food (for Round 2 and 3 of 2022) has been distributed to five million people as of 08 March. Between 02 - 08 March, a total of 1,294,650 people were assisted with 21,871 MT of food in Tigray under Round 3.

Some kebelles in Erob (Eastern), Zala Anbesa town (Eastern), Egela (Central), Gulo Mekeda (Central), Rama (Central), Dima (North Western), Tahtay Adiyabo (North Western), Ofra (Southern) and Zata (Southern) remain inaccessible.

- In Central and Eastern zones, due to access constraints and infrastructural damages resulted from previous conflicts at some food distribution points, distribution for around 116,000 people of Egela, Zala Anbesa town, Gulo Mekeda and some kebelles in Erob took place in neighboring woredas, including Adigrat town, Ahferom and Enticho town.
- In Southern and North Western zones, partners have not been able to assist around 42,000 people in some kebelles in Ofra, Zata and Dima due to access challenges.
