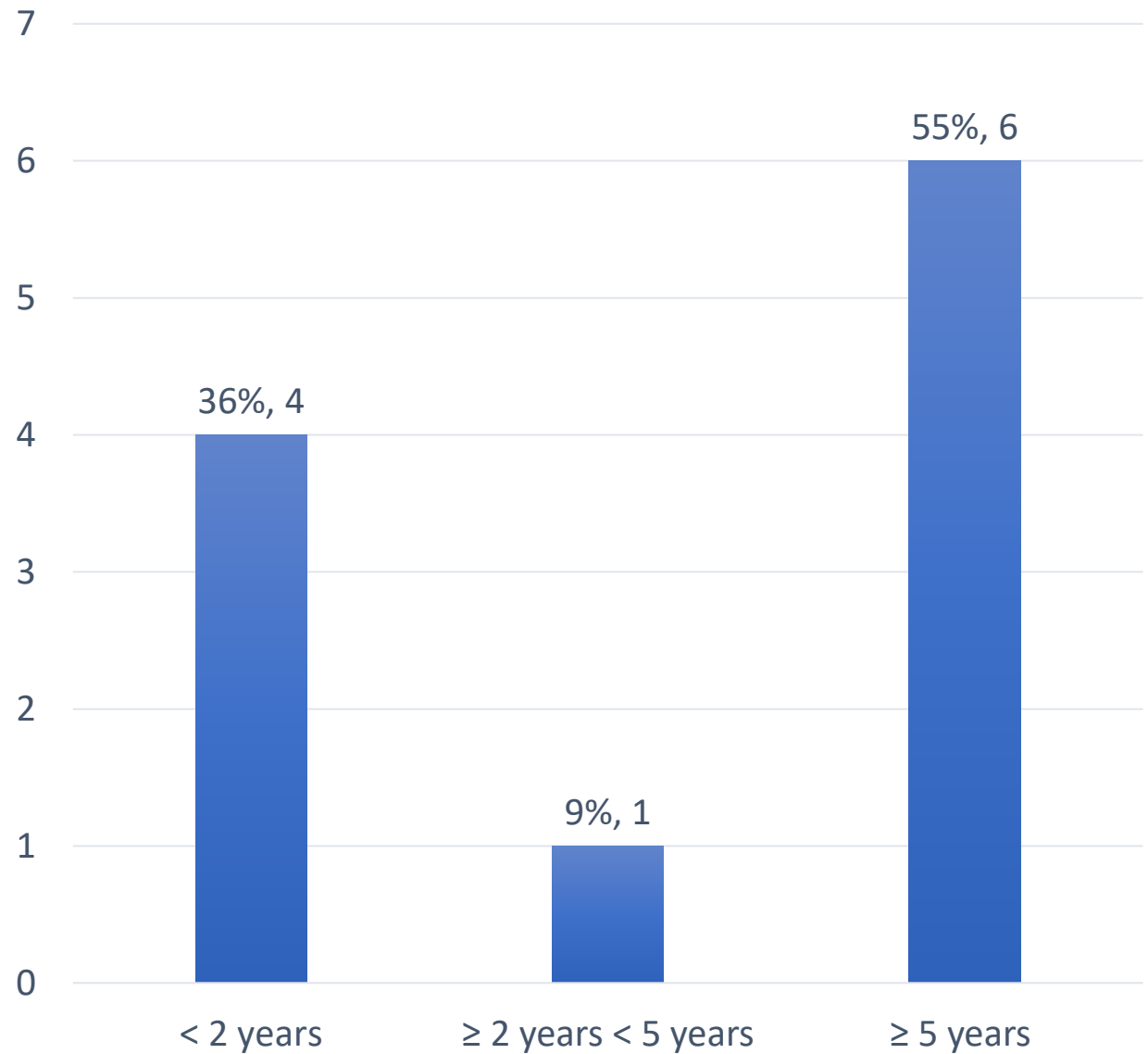




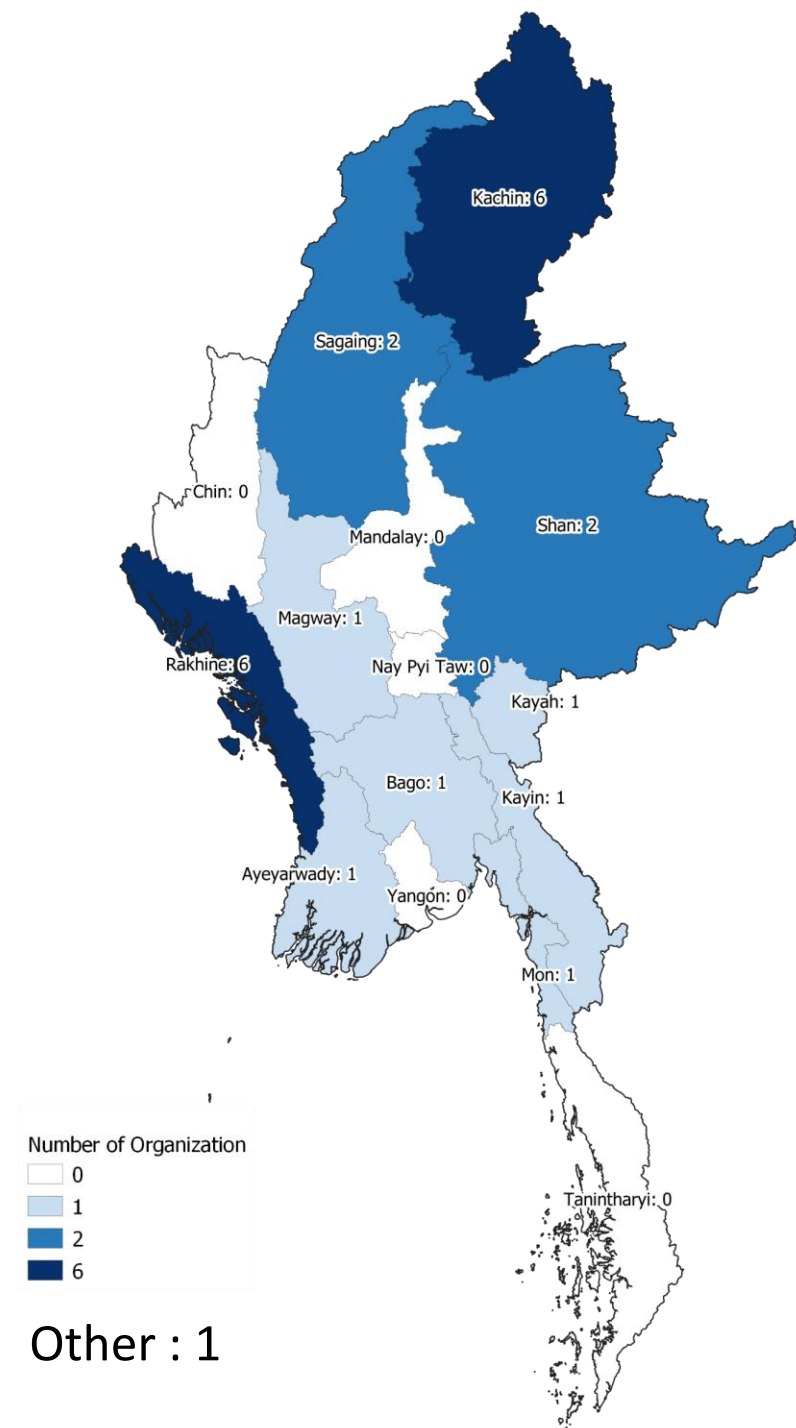
# **Myanmar Food Security Sector Satisfaction Survey**

How long your organization has been a members of the food Security Sector in Myanmar? (n=11)

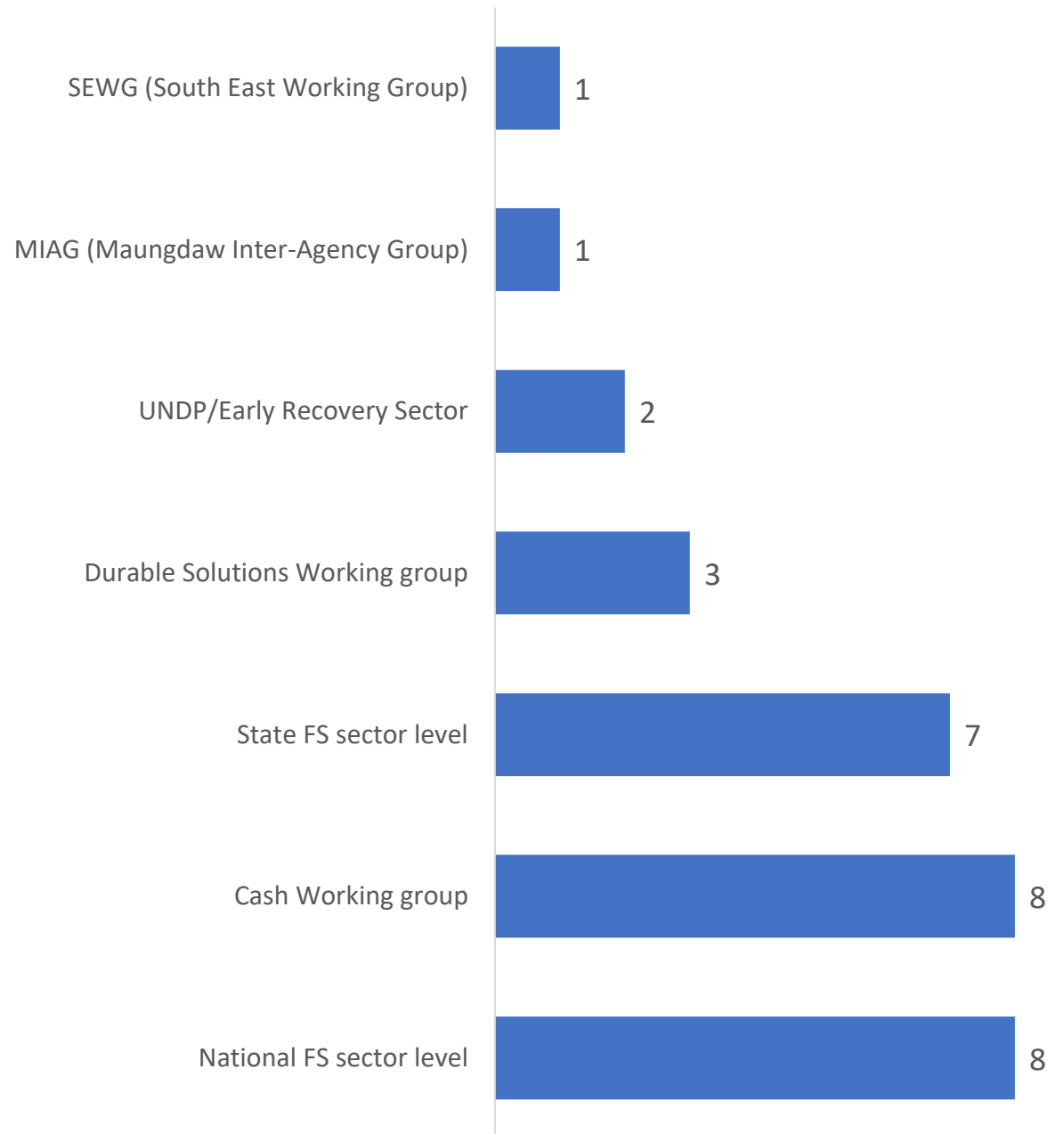


In what States of Myanmar,

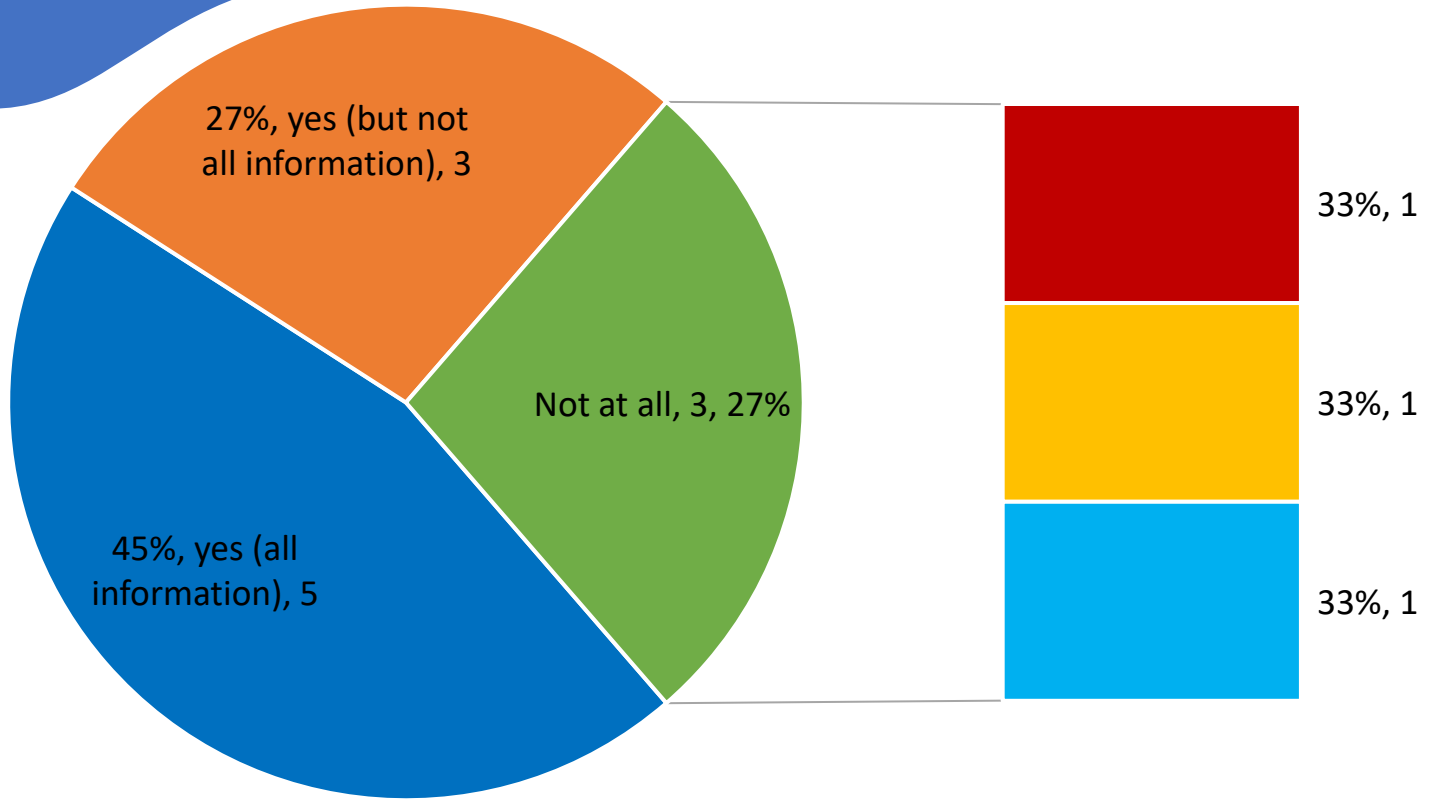
Who does your organization coordinate with in term of Food Security?

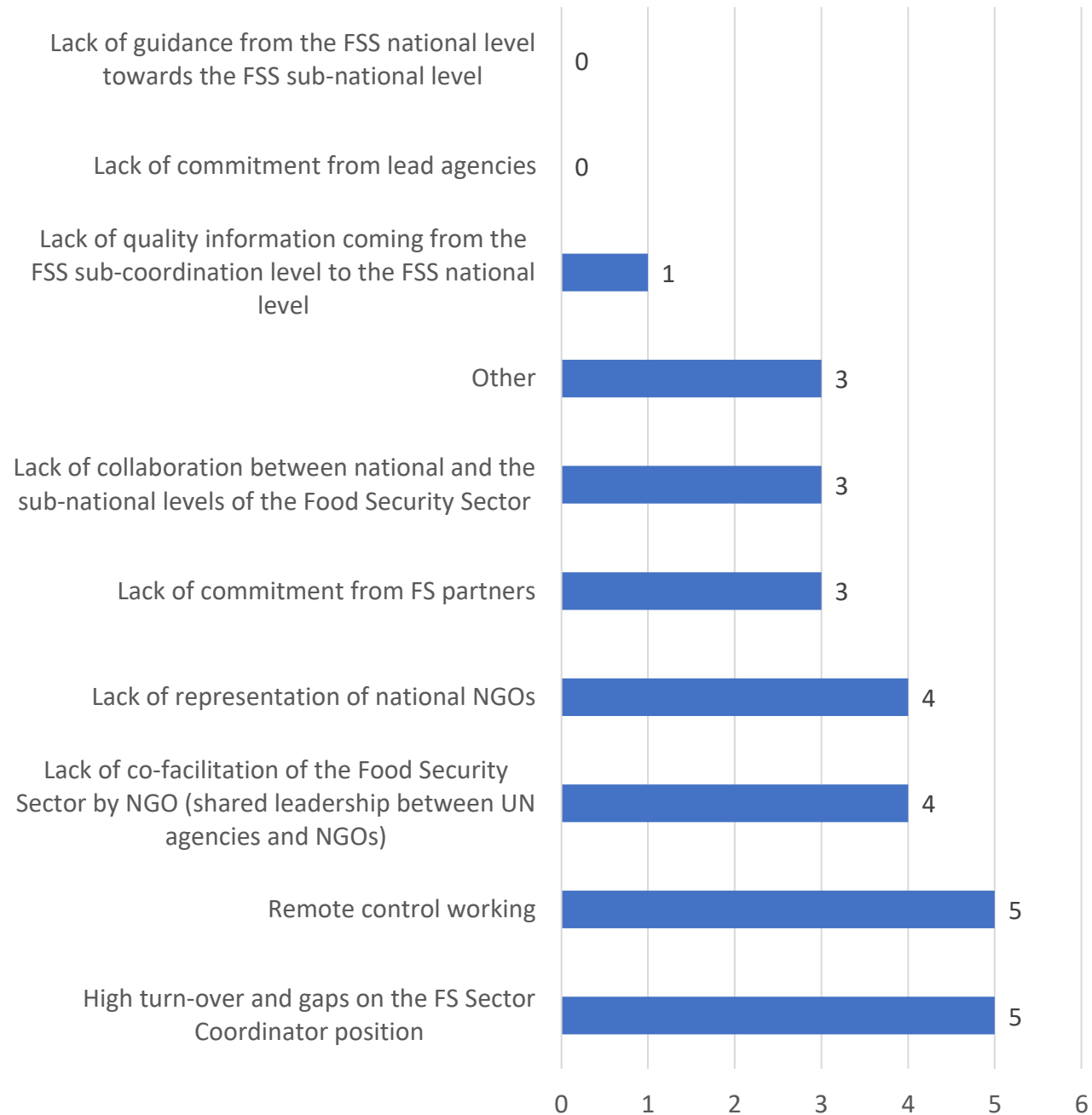


How would you rate the performance of the Food Security Sector to provide accurate analysis of the food security situation in Myanmar? (n=11)

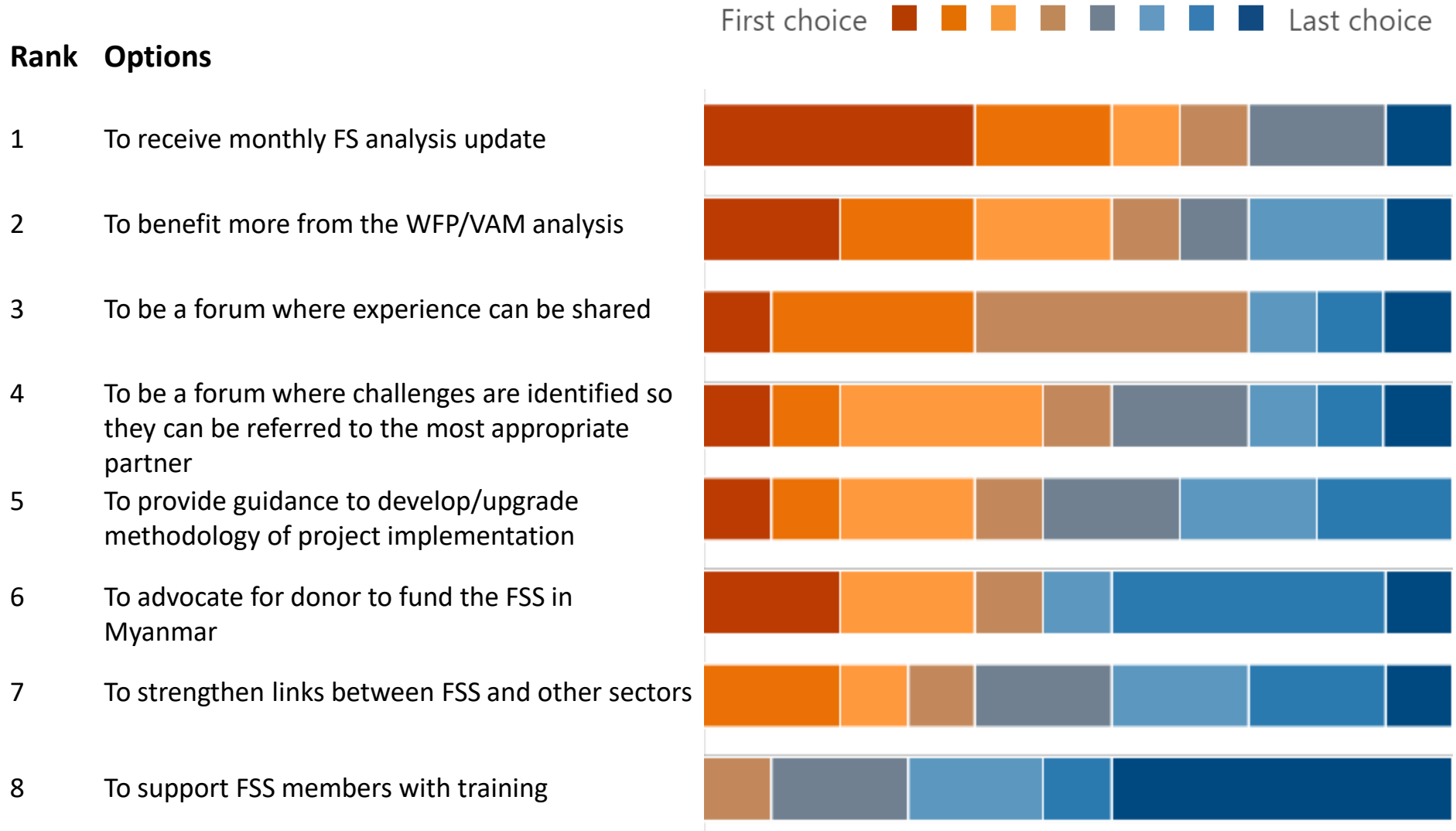

# According to you, what are the main limitations of the FSS? (n=11)

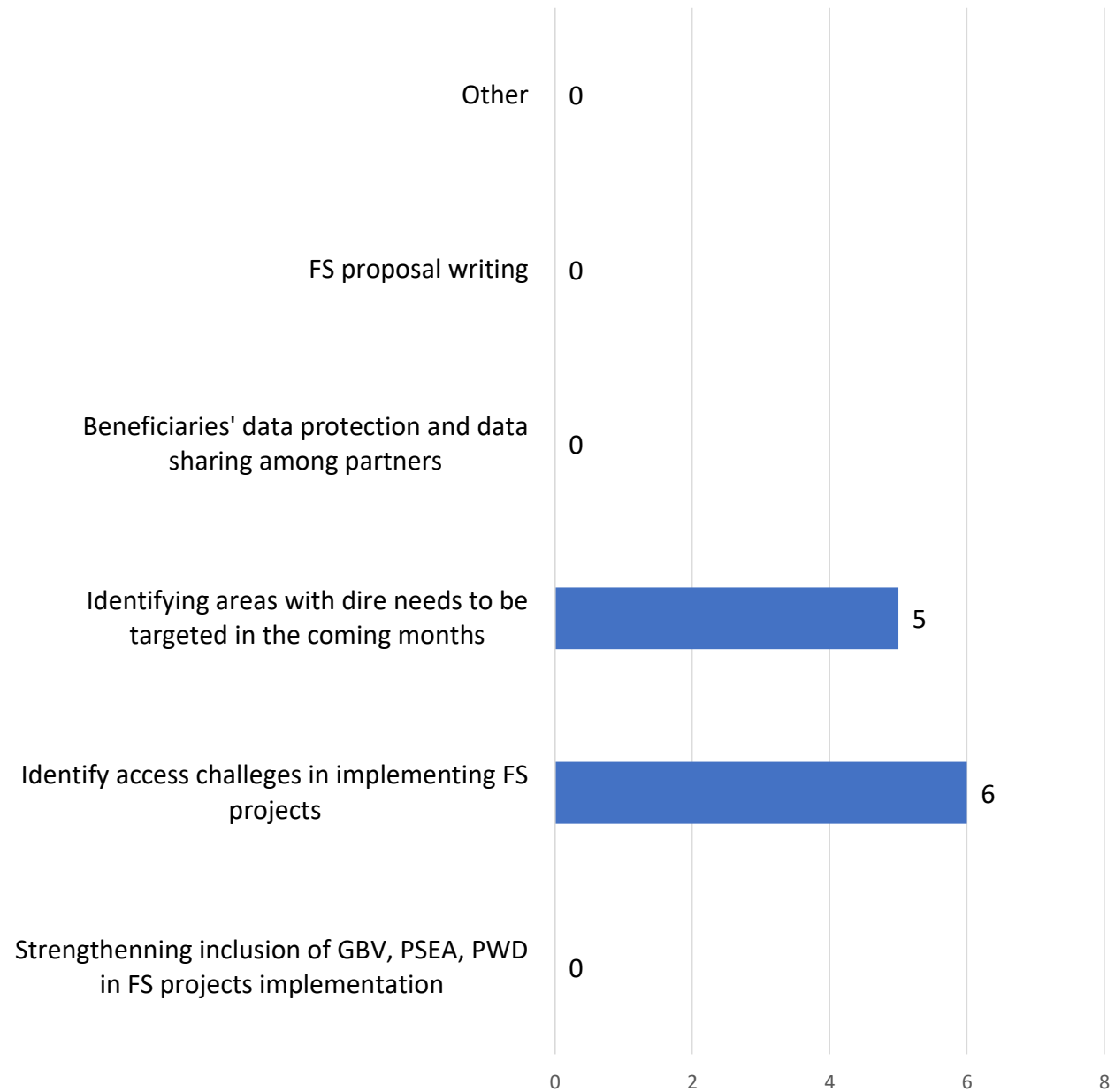

## 11 Réponses

1	anonymous	monthly meetings. But currently, there is too high of a reporting and input burden on partners to feed into various monitoring, coordination, and other mechanisms.
2	anonymous	Collection of FS data, sharing back analysis and relevant information, facilitate coordination between different actors
3	anonymous	Provide information updates on food security interventions, gaps, share experiences, and lessons to avoid duplication of activities
4	anonymous	share lessons learnt, raise question/issues
5	anonymous	Monthly FSS/CWG meeting should be continue held and sharing information of all sector for no gap information.
6	anonymous	Active participation: regularly sharing updates and information, providing requested information (i.e., 5Ws), active in regular meeting, promote collabs
7	anonymous	FFS members playing the contributor role typically propose ideas, initiate discussions and explore options
8	anonymous	Full participation, updating and contribution to the sector objective and coordinated efforts
9	anonymous	Update information data collecting based on the ground situation and analysis the data to be confirmed
10	anonymous	Well coordinated, efficient logistic responses, sharing FS related issues on strategic, analytical and operational areas.
11	anonymous	Regular participation and sharing of update information
