

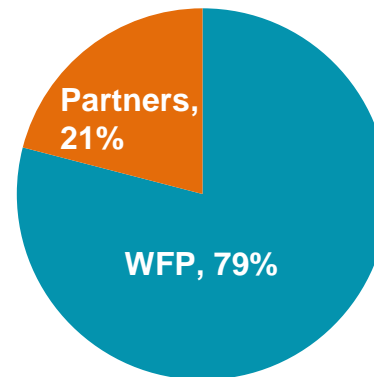
## COUNTRY RESPONSE UPDATE

As of April 2019, FSL cluster partners assisted a total 553,381 people through cash-based transfer programs (cash and vouchers). Beneficiaries received support through cluster objective 1 (unconditional food assistance) and cluster objective 3 (transitional food assistance) as provided for in the HRP 2019. 18% of the response modality was covered through cash while 82% was provided through vouchers.

As per HRP 2019, FSL cluster partners are targeting a total of 1.6 million people with a funding request of 105 million (USD) across all clusters providing humanitarian support in South Sudan through cash/voucher as a modality. WFP and 37 FSL Cluster operational partners have so far raised USD 15m\* for CBT programming across South Sudan. This represents a total of 11% of the entire budgeted amount for CBT related programming. Additionally, cluster partners have reached over 500,000 people based on the current funding received as of April.

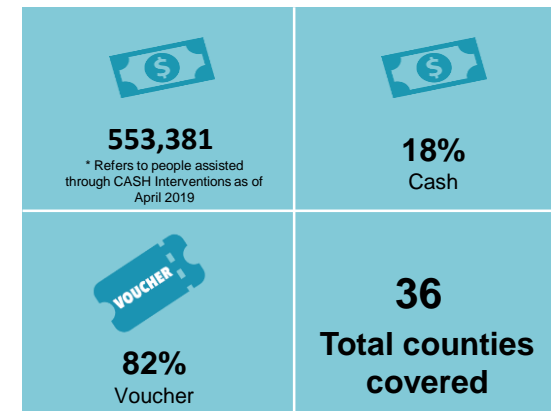
#### FUNDING STATUS



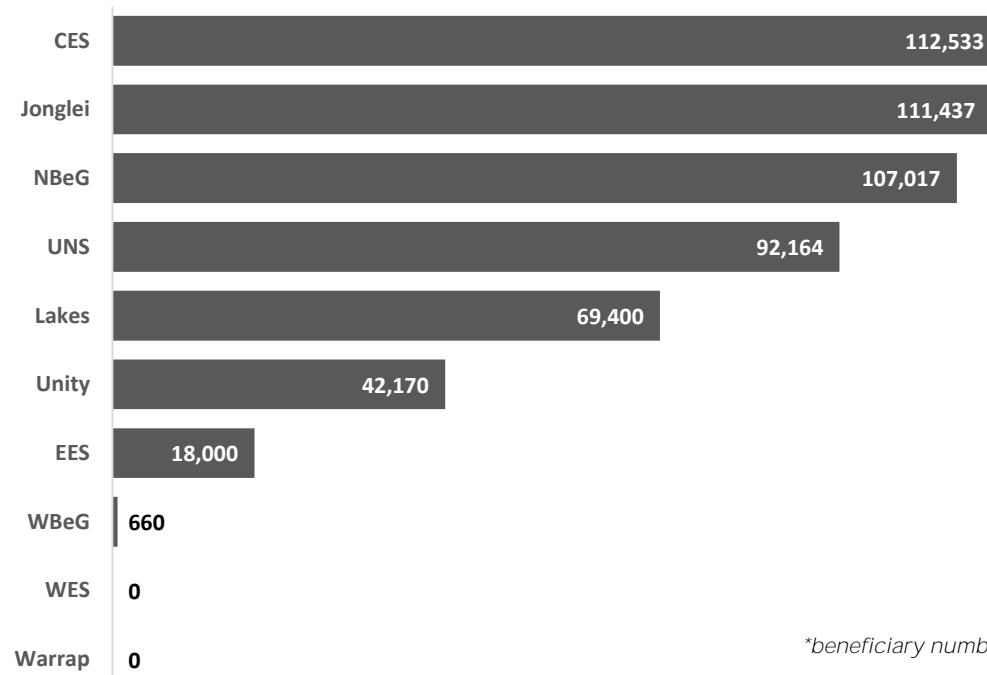

### RESPONSE BY ACTIVITY

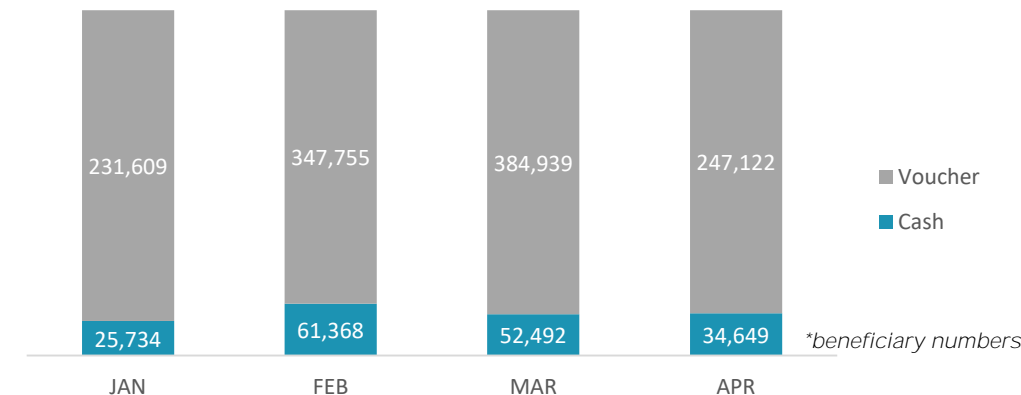


### JANUARY TO APRIL RESPONSE BY STATE
