WFP response to Sudan Crises

- WFP estimated and planned to respond to 240,000 people affected by Sudan crises (60,000 Refugees & 180,000 Returnees)
- A total of 9,372 MT for GFD and nutrition.
- Returnees will receive 3 months response while Refugees response will be for 8 months(Refugees will be incorporated into the existing Camps.
- Most returnees are projected to settle in Unity, Upper Nile, Warrap, Northern and Western Bahr- El ghazal States.
- As of 15th of May 55,426 arrived from Sudan (84% in Renk)
- Cumulatively, 368 MAM cases for children aged 6-59 months and 41 MAM cases from PBW/G enrolled in the treatment programme so far.
- cumulatively a total of 18.468 mts plus for hot meal and 0.366 wet feeding/ CSB++ have been utilized so far.
