Achievements

In response to the Government's emergency appeal, provided to affected population by in new liberated settlements:

- **165,054** food rations,
- **54,575** bread loafs,
- **740** complementary serials for kids
- Established coordination with authorities and partners for scale-up of food assistance in Kherson Oblast. Aside from supporting rural areas, WFP now also starting food distribution inside the Kherson City at the request of the authorities

CHALLENGES

- Widespread damage, lack of basic services in the entire oblast.
- Road infrastructure was damaged, though there was significant presence of unexploded ordnance (UXOs)
- Lack of heating, shelter, basic services for returnees.
- No access to harvesting on land this season due to landmines,
- Lack of markets to meet the needs of the populations as access, price and availability concerns are significant
- Shelling at regular intervals during the day
- No ATM or Banks operational yet and Mobile network/internet

ACTIONS

- Provision of GFD distributions to the entire population and augment this distribution with bread.
- Consistent Market monitoring tracking market developments.
- assessment of the process of purchasing bread and / or other resources from Kherson, which will accelerate the recovery of the economy in the region
- Assessing livelihood restoration opportunities for smallholder farmers
