2- Regular response updates (achievements, gaps, and challenges):

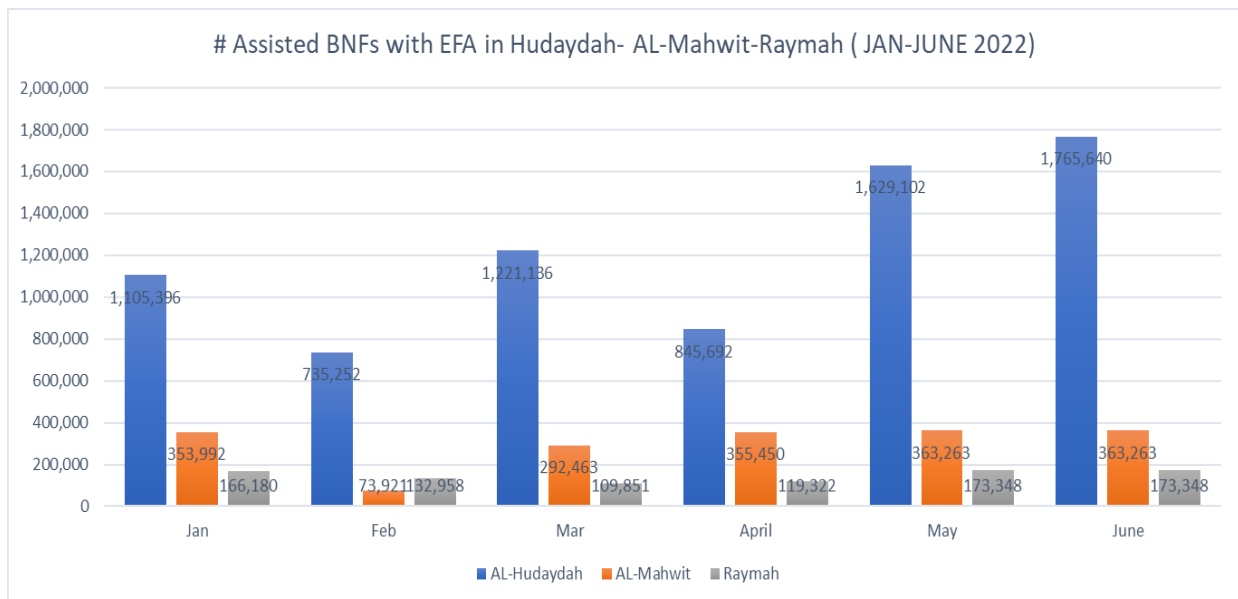
A- Emergency Food Assistance:

Hudaydah: In June, 1,765,640 individuals have been assisted with monthly emergency food assistance within 25 districts of Hudaydah. This is implemented by 10 active FSAC partners provided emergency food assistance in June 2022. The key active partners implementing EFA in June are WFP, IRY,VHI, DRC, NFDHR, SFHRP BFD, and None WFP are (CARE-- SCI and LMMPO).

AL-Mahwit: In June, 363,263 individuals have been assisted with monthly emergency food assistance within 9 districts of AL-Mahwit. This is implemented by 4 active FSAC partners provided emergency food assistance 2022. The key active partners implementing EFA are WFP, YFCA, SFHRP, (CARE internal funds).

Raymah: In June, 173,348 individuals have been assisted with monthly emergency food assistance within 6 districts of Raymah. This is implemented by 2 active FSAC partners provided emergency food assistance 2022. The key active partners implementing EFA are WFP, IRY and RI.

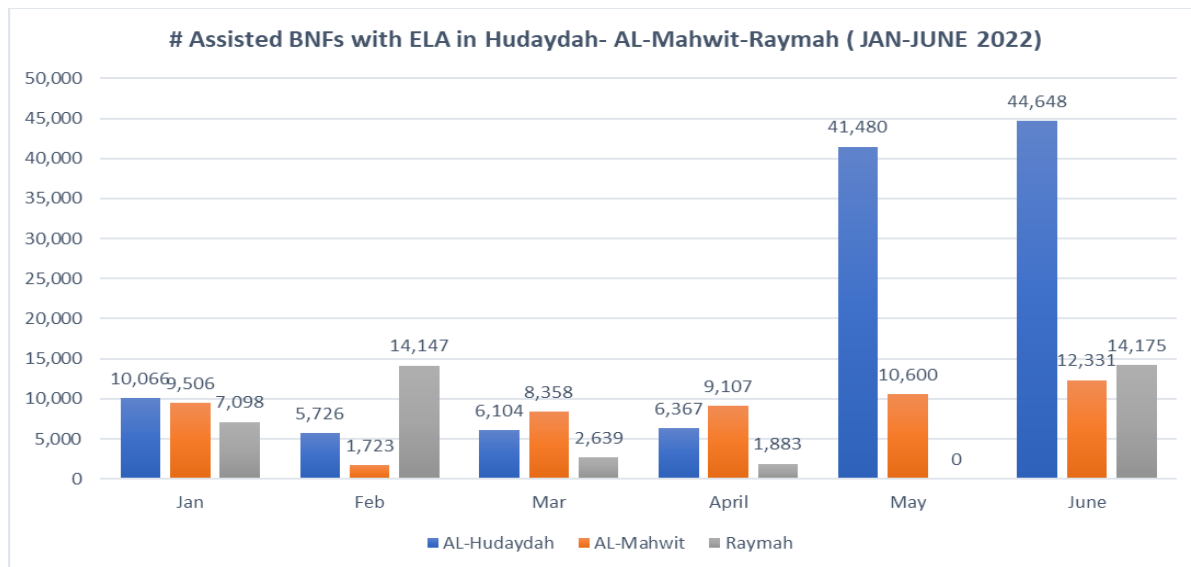
b. Livelihoods Assistance:

Hudaydah: In June, 44,648 individuals have been supported by livelihoods- CFW and Assets Restorations (23,598 individuals have been assisted with emergency livelihoods assistance, 16,837 individuals supported with CFW and 4,213 individuals with livelihoods assets restoration support. As accumulative from JAN to JUNE 114,391 individuals reached with livelihoods. Key FSAC partners are , FAO/MOZN, UNDP/SMEPS, IRY, NFDHR, BFD, and UNDP/SFD.

AL-Mahwit: In June, 12,331 individuals have been assisted with CFW and assets restoration assistance (12016 assisted with CFW, and 315 with livelihoods restoration. As of June, 51,625 individuals have been supported with livelihoods and CFW assistance accumulative from JAN to June 2022. Three partners only were involved in implementing livelihoods assistance; are UNDP, SFD and CARE. In AL-Mahwit, 5 districts Ar Rujum- At Tawilah- AL-Mahwit- Milhan and Bani Sa`ad districts,

Raymah: In June, 14,175 individuals have been assisted with CFW assistance. As of June, 39,942 individuals have been supported with CFW assistance accumulative from JAN to JUNE 2022. Key active partner involved in implementing livelihoods assistance are UNDP/SFD.

C. Gaps in both Livelihoods and Emergency Food Assistance:

The monthly FSAC response and gap analysis up to July 2022 showed that. In Hudaydah 16 districts with food gaps for (Individuals 575,535), In AL-Mahwit 8 districts with food gaps for (Individuals 140,663) and in Raymah 6 districts with food gaps for (Individuals 193,985). 3. Update FSAC Partners Mapping EFA and Livelihoods

FSAC S.N.C.C. explained the importance on sharing the updated mapping for the three governorates Hudaydah- Raymah and AL-Mahwit governorates. This is a key for the FSAC in the hub to have full picture and overall understanding on who is doing what- where and how.

Action Point:

- FSAC will share the updated matrix and all respective INGOs-NNGOs are to fill the matrix and re-send it by 15 September 2022.

4. Updates on Flood Response-Plans and Gaps

The discussion is focused on the response to affected families in onset emergency context like flooding and natural disasters preparedness plans. The rainy season start in near by mountainous districts that a clear alert for a good preparation. FSAC partners are to be ready with available resources and advocate resources. Consider the main steps in response the flood affecting e.g. Assessment- Verification – cross check process and immediately timely response.

The heavy rains and flooding persisted causing injuries and damage to houses and other infrastructure such as roads thus limiting access affected areas. By 20 August, 113 schools, 10 health facilities, 94 water sources and over 1,500 latrines were affected in Al Hodiedah hub, incl. 42 health facilities and 86 schools in Raymah. The table in bellow shows more information for the three governorates:

Chart 1 Ongoing- reached- planned and gaps to the flood affected HHs

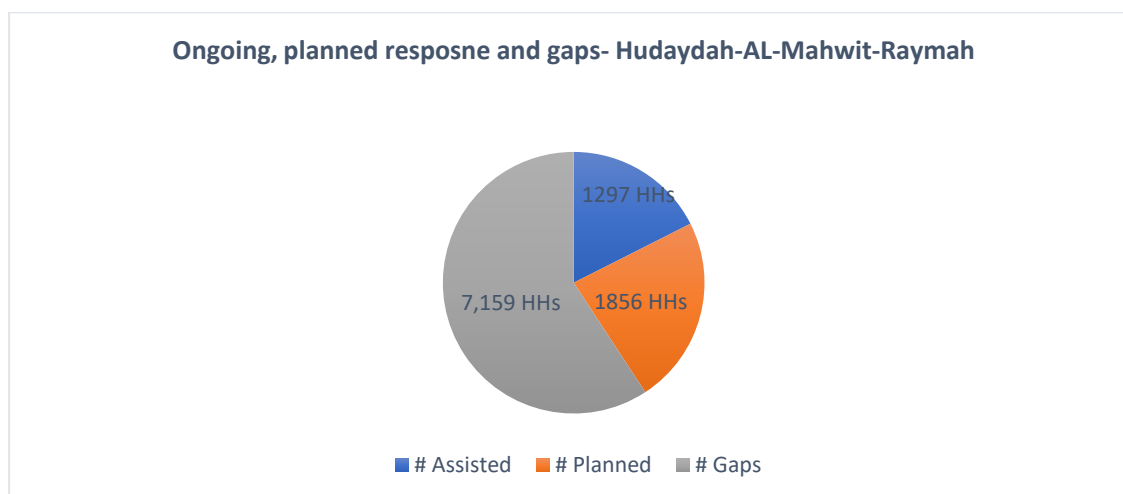
