1. Action points from the last meeting

- ► FSAC partners are kindly requested to take immediate action and provide/mobilize much-needed resources to cover food gaps of people affected by floods in both Saáda and Al Jawf governorates

2. Response follow-up of the flood-affected people

- In response to the reported heavy rains, SCI provided food assistance (Cash modality) to 194 affected households in Sahar and Saáda districts during August 2022. SCI is conducting the verification exercise for 42 affected households and will assist with food during Sep 2022.
- YRC assisted 250 flood-affected households with food basket in Al Jawf governorate in August 2022
- According to available information, the flood-response gap of food needs is 162 households in Saáda governorate and 558 households in Al Jawf governorate

Action points

• FSAC partners are kindly requested to address food needs and provide/mobilize much-needed resources to cover food gaps of people affected by floods in both Saáda and Al Jawf governorates

3. Updates on IDPs (response and challenges)

- SCI distributed the August food cycle to 274 households in Sahar, As Safra, and Saáda districts, Saáda governorate. 169 households in Sahar, As Safra, Saáda, Majz, and Haydan will start receiving food aid in September 2022. SCI plans to provide IDPs with three rounds of assistance
- RRM accumulative list (Dec 2021 –August 2, 2022)has recorded 4,611 new IDP HHs in Saáda and Al Jawf governorates as non-beneficiaries of WFP's regular food assistance

- SCI:- completed the distribution of unconditional cash assistance (RFA) to 2,129 HHs of IDPs in As Safra and Sahar districts, July round (1328 1st round and 801 2nd round)
 - SCI supported 33 HHs of flood- affected HHs and 193 IDPs in Saadah and Sahar with RRA August round
 - SCI started the veterinary training course for 70 Participants of five district (Razih, Saqayn, Majz, As Safra, Haydan)
 - SCI completed the distribution of second round of conditional cash assistance to 242 HHs in Saqayn and Razih , July round
- Oxfam:- will train 444 households this week on related livelihoods activities and distribute 60% of the total entitled amount to the beneficiaries next week in Majz district, Saáda governorate
